

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

wayfaring man ceaseth <u>23\_ISA\_33\_08</u> # The highways lie waste, the wayfaring man ceaseth: he hath broken the covenant, he hath despised the cities, he regardeth no man.

wayfaring man in <u>07\_JUD\_19\_17</u> # And when he had lifted up his eyes, he saw a wayfaring man in the street of the city: and the old man said, Whither goest thou? and whence comest thou?

wayfaring man that <u>10\_2SA\_12\_04</u> # And there came a traveller unto the rich man, and he spared to take of his own flock and of his own herd, to dress for the wayfaring man that was come unto him; but took the poor man's lamb, and dressed it for the man that was come to him.

wayfaring man that <u>24\_JER\_14\_08</u> # O the hope of Israel, the saviour thereof in time of trouble, why shouldest thou be as a stranger in the land, and as a wayfaring man [that] turneth aside to tarry for a night?

wayfaring men that <u>24\_JER\_09\_02</u># Oh that I had in the wilderness a lodging place of wayfaring men; that I might leave my people, and go from them! for they [be] all adulterers, an assembly of treacherous men.

wayfaring men though <u>23\_ISA\_35\_08</u> # And an highway shall be there, and a way, and it shall be called The way of holiness; the unclean shall not pass over it; but it [shall be] for those: the wayfaring men, though fools, shall not err [therein].
