forswear thyself but <u>40_MAT_05_33</u># Again, ye have heard that it hath been said by them of old time, Thou shalt not forswear thyself, but shalt perform unto the Lord thine oaths:

swear again because <u>09_1SA_20_17</u># And Jonathan caused David to swear again, because he loved him: for he loved him as he loved his own soul.

swear an oath <u>04_NUM_30_02</u> # If a man vow a vow unto the LORD, or swear an oath to bind his soul with a bond; he shall not break his word, he shall do according to all that proceedeth out of his mouth.

swear and the 11_1KI_08_31# If any man trespass against his neighbour, and an oath be laid upon him to cause him to swear, and the oath come before thine altar in this house:

swear and the 14_2CH_06_22 # If a man sin against his neighbour, and an oath be laid upon him to make him swear, and the oath come before thine altar in this house;

swear by Baal 24 JER_12 16 # And it shall come to pass, if they will diligently learn the ways of my people, to swear by my name, The LORD liveth; as they taught my people to swear by Baal; then shall they be built in the midst of my people.

swear by God <u>14_2CH_36_13</u># And he also rebelled against king Nebuchadnezzar, who had made him swear by God: but he stiffened his neck, and hardened his heart from turning unto the LORD God of Israel.

swear by God 16_NEH_13_25 # And I contended with them, and cursed them, and smote certain of them, and plucked off their hair, and made them swear by God, [saying], Ye shall not give your daughters unto their sons, nor take their daughters unto your sons, or for yourselves.

swear by my <u>03_LEV_19_12</u> # And ye shall not swear by my name falsely, neither shalt thou profane the name of thy God: I [am] the LORD.

swear by the <u>58_HEB_06_16</u># For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation [is] to them an end of all strife.

swear by the <u>23_ISA_48_01</u># Hear ye this, O house of Jacob, which are called by the name of Israel, and are come forth out of the waters of Judah, which swear by the name of the LORD, and make mention of the God of Israel, [but] not in truth, nor in righteousness.

Swear now therefore <u>09_1SA_24_21</u># Swear now therefore unto me by the LORD, that thou wilt not cut off my seed after me, and that thou wilt not destroy my name out of my father's house.

swear pronouncing with <u>03_LEV_05_04</u># Or if a soul swear, pronouncing with [his] lips to do evil, or to do good, whatsoever [it be] that a man shall pronounce with an oath, and it be hid from him; when he knoweth [of it], then he shall be guilty in one of these.

swear saying I <u>23_ISA_03_07</u> # In that day shall he swear, saying, I will not be an healer; for in my house [is] neither bread nor clothing: make me not a ruler of the people.

swear saying I <u>41_MAR_14_71</u># But he began to curse and to swear, [saying], I know not this man of whom ye speak.

swear saying I <u>40_MAT_26_74</u># Then began he to curse and to swear, [saying], I know not the man. And immediately the cock crew.

swear The LORD <u>24_JER_04_02</u># And thou shalt swear, The LORD liveth, in truth, in judgment, and in righteousness; and the nations shall bless themselves in him, and in him shall they glory.

swear to give <u>02_EXO_06_08</u># And I will bring you in unto the land, concerning the which I did swear to give it to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob; and I will give it you for an heritage: I [am] the LORD.

Swear to me <u>01_GEN_25_33</u># And Jacob said, Swear to me this day; and he sware unto him: and he sold his birthright unto Jacob.

swear to the <u>23_ISA_19_18</u># In that day shall five cities in the land of Egypt speak the language of Canaan, and swear to the LORD of hosts; one shall be called, The city of destruction.

swear to their 24_JER_32_22 # And hast given them this land, which thou didst swear to their fathers to

give them, a land flowing with milk and honey;

swear unto me <u>11_1KI_01_51</u># And it was told Solomon, saying, Behold, Adonijah feareth king Solomon: for, lo, he hath caught hold on the horns of the altar, saying, Let king Solomon swear unto me to day that he will not slay his servant with the sword.

Swear unto me <u>09 1SA 30 15</u> # And David said to him, Canst thou bring me down to this company? And he said, Swear unto me by God, that thou wilt neither kill me, nor deliver me into the hands of my master, and I will bring thee down to this company.

swear unto me <u>01_GEN_21_23</u># Now therefore swear unto me here by God that thou wilt not deal falsely with me, nor with my son, nor with my son's son: [but] according to the kindness that I have done unto thee, thou shalt do unto me, and to the land wherein thou hast sojourned.

Swear unto me <u>01_GEN_47_31</u># And he said, Swear unto me. And he sware unto him. And Israel bowed himself upon the bed's head.

swear unto me <u>06_JOS_02_12</u> # Now therefore, I pray you, swear unto me by the LORD, since I have showed you kindness, that ye will also show kindness unto my father's house, and give me a true token:

Swear unto me <u>07_JUD_15_12</u># And they said unto him, We are come down to bind thee, that we may deliver thee into the hand of the Philistines. And Samson said unto them, Swear unto me, that ye will not fall upon me yourselves.

swear unto thine <u>11_1KI_01_13</u># Go and get thee in unto king David, and say unto him, Didst not thou, my lord, O king, swear unto thine handmaid, saying, Assuredly Solomon thy son shall reign after me, and he shall sit upon my throne? why then doth Adonijah reign?

swear 01_GEN_21_24 # And Abraham said, I will swear.

swear 01_GEN_50_06 # And Pharaoh said, Go up, and bury thy father, according as he made thee swear.

swear <u>23_ISA_45_23</u># I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth [in] righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.

swear <u>06_JOS_02_17</u># And the men said unto her, We [will be] blameless of this thine oath which thou hast made us swear.

swear <u>06_JOS_02_20</u> # And if thou utter this our business, then we will be quit of thine oath which thou hast made us to swear.

swearers and against <u>39_MAL_03_05</u># And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in [his] wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger [from his right], and fear not me, saith the LORD of hosts.

sweareth to his <u>19_PSA_15_04</u># In whose eyes a vile person is contemned; but he honoureth them that fear the LORD. [He that] sweareth to [his own] hurt, and changeth not.

swearing and is <u>03_LEV_05_01</u> # And if a soul sin, and hear the voice of swearing, and [is] a witness, whether he hath seen or known [of it]; if he do not utter [it], then he shall bear his iniquity.

swearing and lying <u>28_HOS_04_02</u> # By swearing, and lying, and killing, and stealing, and committing adultery, they break out, and blood toucheth blood.

swearing falsely in <u>28_HOS_10_04</u> # They have spoken words, swearing falsely in making a covenant: thus judgment springeth up as hemlock in the furrows of the field.

swearing the land <u>24_JER_23_10</u># For the land is full of adulterers; for because of swearing the land mourneth; the pleasant places of the wilderness are dried up, and their course is evil, and their force [is] not right.

wear a garment <u>05_DEU_22_11</u># Thou shalt not wear a garment of divers sorts, [as] of woollen and linen together.

wear a linen <u>09_1SA_22_18</u># And the king said to Doeg, Turn thou, and fall upon the priests. And Doeg the Edomite turned, and he fell upon the priests, and slew on that day fourscore and five persons that did wear a linen ephod.

wear a rough <u>38_ZEC_13_04</u># And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] the prophets shall be ashamed every one of his vision, when he hath prophesied; neither shall they wear a rough garment to deceive:

wear an ephod <u>09_1SA_02_28</u> # And did I choose him out of all the tribes of Israel [to be] my priest, to offer upon mine altar, to burn incense, to wear an ephod before me? and did I give unto the house of thy father all the offerings made by fire of the children of Israel?

wear and the <u>17_EST_06_08</u> # Let the royal apparel be brought which the king [useth] to wear, and the horse that the king rideth upon, and the crown royal which is set upon his head:

wear that which <u>05_DEU_22_05</u> # The woman shall not wear that which pertaineth unto a man, neither shall a man put on a woman's garment: for all that do so [are] abomination unto the LORD thy God.

wear the stones <u>18_JOB_14_19</u># The waters wear the stones: thou washest away the things which grow [out] of the dust of the earth; and thou destroyest the hope of man.

weareth the gay <u>59_JAM_02_03</u># And ye have respect to him that weareth the gay clothing, and say unto him, Sit thou here in a good place; and say to the poor, Stand thou there, or sit here under my footstool:

wearied and faint <u>58_HEB_12_03</u># For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.

wearied because of <u>24_JER_04_31</u> # For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, [and] the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, [that] bewaileth herself, [that] spreadeth her hands, [saying], Woe [is] me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.

wearied herself with <u>26_EZE_24_12</u> # She hath wearied [herself] with lies, and her great scum went not forth out of her: her scum [shall be] in the fire.

wearied him When 39_MAL_02_17 # Ye have wearied the LORD with your words. Yet ye say, Wherein have we wearied [him]? When ye say, Every one that doeth evil [is] good in the sight of the LORD, and he delighteth in them; or, Where [is] the God of judgment?

wearied in the <u>23_ISA_47_13</u># Thou art wearied in the multitude of thy counsels. Let now the astrologers, the stargazers, the monthly prognosticators, stand up, and save thee from [these things] that shall come upon thee.

wearied in the <u>23_ISA_57_10</u># Thou art wearied in the greatness of thy way; [yet] saidst thou not, There is no hope: thou hast found the life of thine hand; therefore thou wast not grieved.

wearied the LORD <u>39 MAL_02_17</u># Ye have wearied the LORD with your words. Yet ye say, Wherein have we wearied [him]? When ye say, Every one that doeth evil [is] good in the sight of the LORD, and he delighteth in them; or, Where [is] the God of judgment?

wearied thee testify <u>33_MIC_06_03</u> # O my people, what have I done unto thee? and wherein have I wearied thee? testify against me.

wearied thee then <u>24_JER_12_05</u># If thou hast run with the footmen, and they have wearied thee, then how canst thou contend with horses? and [if] in the land of peace, [wherein] thou trustedst, [they wearied thee], then how wilt thou do in the swelling of Jordan?

wearieth the thick <u>18_JOB_37_11</u># Also by watering he wearieth the thick cloud: he scattereth his bright cloud:

weariness and painfulness <u>47_2CO_11_27</u># In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness.

weariness is it <u>39 MAL_01_13</u> # Ye said also, Behold, what a weariness [is it]! and ye have snuffed at it, saith the LORD of hosts; and ye brought [that which was] torn, and the lame, and the sick; thus ye brought an offering: should I accept this of your hand? saith the LORD.

weariness of the <u>21_ECC_12_12</u># And further, by these, my son, be admonished: of making many books [there is] no end; and much study [is] a weariness of the flesh.

wearing an ephod <u>09_1SA_14_03</u># And Ahiah, the son of Ahitub, Ichabod's brother, the son of Phinehas, the son of Eli, the LORD'S priest in Shiloh, wearing an ephod. And the people knew not that Jonathan was gone.

wearing of gold <u>60_1PE_03_03</u> # Whose adorning let it not be that outward [adorning] of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel;

wearing the crown 43_JOH_19_05 # Then came Jesus forth, wearing the crown of thorns, and the purple robe. And [Pilate] saith unto them, Behold the man!

wearisome nights are <u>18_JOB_07_03</u># So am I made to possess months of vanity, and wearisome nights are appointed to me.

weary and he <u>05_DEU_25_18</u> # How he met thee by the way, and smote the hindmost of thee, [even] all [that were] feeble behind thee, when thou [wast] faint and weary; and he feared not God.

weary and his <u>10_2SA_23_10</u># He arose, and smote the Philistines until his hand was weary, and his hand clave unto the sword: and the LORD wrought a great victory that day; and the people returned after him only to spoil.

weary and refreshed 10_2SA_16_14 # And the king, and all the people that [were] with him, came weary, and refreshed themselves there.

weary and the <u>23_ISA_40_30</u># Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall:

weary beast <u>23_ISA_46_01</u> # Bel boweth down, Nebo stoopeth, their idols were upon the beasts, and upon the cattle: your carriages [were] heavy loaden; [they are] a burden to the weary [beast].

weary he wakeneth <u>23_ISA_50_04</u># The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to [him that is] weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned.

weary in well 53_2TH_03_13 # But ye, brethren, be not weary in well doing.

weary in well <u>48_GAL_06_09</u> # And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

weary land <u>23_ISA_32_02</u># And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land.

weary me <u>42_LUK_18_05</u> # Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.

weary So he <u>07_JUD_04_21</u># Then Jael Heber's wife took a nail of the tent, and took an hammer in her hand, and went softly unto him, and smote the nail into his temples, and fastened it into the ground: for he was fast asleep and weary. So he died.

weary soul and <u>24_JER_31_25</u># For I have satiated the weary soul, and I have replenished every sorrowful soul.

weary themselves for <u>35_HAB_02_13</u> # Behold, [is it] not of the LORD of hosts that the people shall labour in the very fire, and the people shall weary themselves for very vanity?

weary themselves in 24 JER 02 24 # A wild ass used to the wilderness, [that] snuffeth up the wind at her pleasure; in her occasion who can turn her away? all they that seek her will not weary themselves; in her month they shall find her.

weary themselves to <u>24_JER_09_05</u> # And they will deceive every one his neighbour, and will not speak the truth: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, [and] weary themselves to commit iniquity.

weary there is <u>23_ISA_40_28</u># Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, [that] the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? [there is] no searching of his understanding.

weary thou hast <u>18_JOB_16_07</u># But now he hath made me weary: thou hast made desolate all my company.

weary Thus far 24_JER_51_64 # And thou shalt say, Thus shall Babylon sink, and shall not rise from the evil that I will bring upon her: and they shall be weary. Thus far [are] the words of Jeremiah.

weary to bear <u>23_ISA_01_14</u># Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear [them].

weary to drink <u>18_JOB_22_07</u> # Thou hast not given water to the weary to drink, and thou hast withholden bread from the hungry.

weary to rest <u>23_ISA_28_12</u> # To whom he said, This [is] the rest [wherewith] ye may cause the weary to rest; and this [is] the refreshing: yet they would not hear.

weary with forbearing 24_JER_20_09 # Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak any more in his name. But [his word] was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not [stay].

weary with holding <u>24_JER_06_11</u># Therefore I am full of the fury of the LORD; I am weary with holding in: I will pour it out upon the children abroad, and upon the assembly of young men together: for even the husband with the wife shall be taken, the aged with [him that is] full of days.

weary with my 19_PSA_06_06 # I am weary with my groaning; all the night make I my bed to swim; I water my couch with my tears.

weary with repenting <u>24_JER_15_06</u> # Thou hast forsaken me, saith the LORD, thou art gone backward: therefore will I stretch out my hand against thee, and destroy thee; I am weary with repenting.

weary <u>24_JER_51_58</u># Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The broad walls of Babylon shall be utterly broken, and her high gates shall be burned with fire; and the people shall labour in vain, and the folk in the fire, and they shall be weary.

weary <u>07_JUD_08_15</u># And he came unto the men of Succoth, and said, Behold Zebah and Zalmunna with whom ye did upbraid me, saying, [Are] the hands of Zebah and Zalmunna now in thine hand, that we should give bread unto thy men [that are] weary?

weary 19_PSA_68_09 # Thou, O God, didst send a plentiful rain, whereby thou didst confirm thine inheritance, when it was weary.
