wearied and faint 58 HEB 12 03 # For consider him that endured such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest ye be wearied and faint in your minds.

wearied because of 24 JER 04 31 # For I have heard a voice as of a woman in travail, [and] the anguish as of her that bringeth forth her first child, the voice of the daughter of Zion, [that] bewaileth herself, [that] spreadeth her hands, [saying], Woe [is] me now! for my soul is wearied because of murderers.
