weary and he [05 DEU 25 18](#) # How he met thee by the way, and smote the hindmost of thee, [even] all [that were] feeble behind thee, when thou [wast] faint and weary; and he feared not God.

weary and his [10 2SA 23 10](#) # He arose, and smote the Philistines until his hand was weary, and his hand clave unto the sword: and the LORD wrought a great victory that day; and the people returned after him only to spoil.

weary and refreshed [10 2SA 16 14](#) # And the king, and all the people that [were] with him, came weary, and refreshed themselves there.

weary and the [23 ISA 40 30](#) # Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall:

weary beast [23 ISA 46 01](#) # Bel boweth down, Nebo stoopeth, their idols were upon the beasts, and upon the cattle: your carriages [were] heavy loaden; [they are] a burden to the weary [beast].

weary he wakeneth [23 ISA 50 04](#) # The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to [him that is] weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned.

weary in well [53 2TH 03 13](#) # But ye, brethren, be not weary in well doing.

weary of me [23 ISA 43 22](#) # But thou hast not called upon me, O Jacob; but thou hast been weary of me, O Israel.

weary to rest [23 ISA 28 12](#) # To whom he said, This [is] the rest [wherewith] ye may cause the weary to rest; and this [is] the refreshing: yet they would not hear.

weary with forbearing [24 JER 20 09](#) # Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak any more in his name. But [his word] was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not [stay].

weary with holding [24 JER 06 11](#) # Therefore I am full of the fury of the LORD; I am weary with holding in: I will pour it out upon the children abroad, and upon the assembly of young men together: for even the husband with the wife shall be taken, the aged with [him that is] full of days.

weary with my [19 PSA 06 06](#) # I am weary with my groaning; all the night make I my bed to swim; I water my couch with my tears.
