weary and he <u>05\_DEU\_25\_18</u># How he met thee by the way, and smote the hindmost of thee, [even] all [that were] feeble behind thee, when thou [wast] faint and weary; and he feared not God.

weary and his <u>10\_2SA\_23\_10</u># He arose, and smote the Philistines until his hand was weary, and his hand clave unto the sword: and the LORD wrought a great victory that day; and the people returned after him only to spoil.

weary and refreshed 10\_2SA\_16\_14 # And the king, and all the people that [were] with him, came weary, and refreshed themselves there.

weary and the <u>23\_ISA\_40\_30</u># Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall:

weary and they <u>23\_ISA\_40\_31</u> # But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew [their] strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; [and] they shall walk, and not faint.

weary and thirsty <u>10\_2SA\_17\_29</u># And honey, and butter, and sheep, and cheese of kine, for David, and for the people that [were] with him, to eat: for they said, The people [is] hungry, and weary, and thirsty, in the wilderness.

weary and weak 10\_2SA\_17\_02 # And I will come upon him while he [is] weary and weak handed, and will make him afraid: and all the people that [are] with him shall flee; and I will smite the king only:

weary be at 18\_JOB\_03\_17 # There the wicked cease [from] troubling; and there the weary be at rest.

weary beast 23\_ISA\_46\_01 # Bel boweth down, Nebo stoopeth, their idols were upon the beasts, and upon the cattle: your carriages [were] heavy loaden; [they are] a burden to the weary [beast].

weary he wakeneth <u>23\_ISA\_50\_04</u> # The Lord GOD hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to [him that is] weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned.

weary in well 53\_2TH\_03\_13 # But ye, brethren, be not weary in well doing.

weary in well <u>48\_GAL\_06\_09</u> # And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

weary land 23\_ISA\_32\_02 # And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land.

weary me <u>42\_LUK\_18\_05</u> # Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.

weary men but <u>23\_ISA\_07\_13</u> # And he said, Hear ye now, O house of David; [Is it] a small thing for you to weary men, but will ye weary my God also?

weary nor stumble <u>23\_ISA\_05\_27</u> # None shall be weary nor stumble among them; none shall slumber nor sleep; neither shall the girdle of their loins be loosed, nor the latchet of their shoes be broken:

weary of his <u>20\_PRO\_03\_11</u># My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD; neither be weary of his correction:

weary of me <u>23\_ISA\_43\_22</u> # But thou hast not called upon me, O Jacob; but thou hast been weary of me, O Israel.

weary of my <u>01\_GEN\_27\_46</u># And Rebekah said to Isaac, I am weary of my life because of the daughters of Heth: if Jacob take a wife of the daughters of Heth, such as these [which are] of the daughters of the land, what good shall my life do me?

weary of my <u>18\_JOB\_10\_01</u> # My soul is weary of my life; I will leave my complaint upon myself; I will speak in the bitterness of my soul.

weary of my 19\_PSA\_69\_03 # I am weary of my crying: my throat is dried: mine eyes fail while I wait for my God.

weary of thee <u>20\_PRO\_25\_17</u># Withdraw thy foot from thy neighbour's house; lest he be weary of thee, and [so] hate thee.

weary on the <u>23\_ISA\_16\_12</u># And it shall come to pass, when it is seen that Moab is weary on the high place, that he shall come to his sanctuary to pray; but he shall not prevail.

weary So he <u>07\_JUD\_04\_21</u> # Then Jael Heber's wife took a nail of the tent, and took an hammer in her hand, and went softly unto him, and smote the nail into his temples, and fastened it into the ground: for he was fast asleep and weary. So he died.

weary soul and **24\_JER\_31\_25** # For I have satiated the weary soul, and I have replenished every sorrowful soul.

weary themselves for <u>35\_HAB\_02\_13</u> # Behold, [is it] not of the LORD of hosts that the people shall labour in the very fire, and the people shall weary themselves for very vanity?

weary themselves in <u>24 JER\_02\_24</u># A wild ass used to the wilderness, [that] snuffeth up the wind at her pleasure; in her occasion who can turn her away? all they that seek her will not weary themselves; in her month they shall find her.

weary themselves to <u>24\_JER\_09\_05</u> # And they will deceive every one his neighbour, and will not speak the truth: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, [and] weary themselves to commit iniquity.

weary there is <u>23\_ISA\_40\_28</u> # Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, [that] the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? [there is] no searching of his understanding.

weary thou hast <u>18\_JOB\_16\_07</u># But now he hath made me weary: thou hast made desolate all my company.

weary Thus far 24\_JER\_51\_64 # And thou shalt say, Thus shall Babylon sink, and shall not rise from the evil that I will bring upon her: and they shall be weary. Thus far [are] the words of Jeremiah.

weary to bear <u>23\_ISA\_01\_14</u> # Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear [them].

weary to drink <u>18\_JOB\_22\_07</u> # Thou hast not given water to the weary to drink, and thou hast withholden bread from the hungry.

weary to rest <u>23\_ISA\_28\_12</u> # To whom he said, This [is] the rest [wherewith] ye may cause the weary to rest; and this [is] the refreshing: yet they would not hear.

weary with forbearing 24\_JER\_20\_09 # Then I said, I will not make mention of him, nor speak any more in his name. But [his word] was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with forbearing, and I could not [stay].

weary with holding 24\_JER\_06\_11# Therefore I am full of the fury of the LORD; I am weary with holding in: I will pour it out upon the children abroad, and upon the assembly of young men together: for even the husband with the wife shall be taken, the aged with [him that is] full of days.

weary with my 19\_PSA\_06\_06 # I am weary with my groaning; all the night make I my bed to swim; I water my couch with my tears.

weary with repenting <u>24\_JER\_15\_06</u> # Thou hast forsaken me, saith the LORD, thou art gone backward: therefore will I stretch out my hand against thee, and destroy thee; I am weary with repenting.

weary 24\_JER\_51\_58 # Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The broad walls of Babylon shall be utterly broken, and her high gates shall be burned with fire; and the people shall labour in vain, and the folk in the fire, and they shall be weary.

weary <u>07\_JUD\_08\_15</u># And he came unto the men of Succoth, and said, Behold Zebah and Zalmunna with whom ye did upbraid me, saying, [Are] the hands of Zebah and Zalmunna now in thine hand, that we should give bread unto thy men [that are] weary?

weary 19\_PSA\_68\_09 # Thou, O God, didst send a plentiful rain, whereby thou didst confirm thine inheritance, when it was weary.
