weave networks shall <u>23\_ISA\_19\_09</u># Moreover they that work in fine flax, and they that weave networks, shall be confounded.

weave the spider's <u>23\_ISA\_59\_05</u> # They hatch cockatrice' eggs, and weave the spider's web: he that eateth of their eggs dieth, and that which is crushed breaketh out into a viper.

weaver even of <u>02\_EXO\_35\_35</u> # Them hath he filled with wisdom of heart, to work all manner of work, of the engraver, and of the cunning workman, and of the embroiderer, in blue, and in purple, in scarlet, and in fine linen, and of the weaver, [even] of them that do any work, and of those that devise cunning work.

weaver my life <u>23\_ISA\_38\_12</u> # Mine age is departed, and is removed from me as a shepherd's tent: I have cut off like a weaver my life: he will cut me off with pining sickness: from day [even] to night wilt thou make an end of me.

weaver's beam and <u>13\_1CH\_11\_23</u># And he slew an Egyptian, a man of [great] stature, five cubits high; and in the Egyptian's hand [was] a spear like a weaver's beam; and he went down to him with a staff, and plucked the spear out of the Egyptian's hand, and slew him with his own spear.

weaver's beam and <u>09\_1SA\_17\_07</u># And the staff of his spear [was] like a weaver's beam; and his spear's head [weighed] six hundred shekels of iron: and one bearing a shield went before him.

weaver's beam <u>13\_1CH\_20\_05</u># And there was war again with the Philistines; and Elhanan the son of Jair slew Lahmi the brother of Goliath the Gittite, whose spear staff [was] like a weaver's beam.

weaver's beam <u>10\_2SA\_21\_19</u> # And there was again a battle in Gob with the Philistines, where Elhanan the son of Jaareoregim, a Bethlehemite, slew [the brother of] Goliath the Gittite, the staff of whose spear [was] like a weaver's beam.

weaver's shuttle and <u>18\_JOB\_07\_06</u># My days are swifter than a weaver's shuttle, and are spent without hope.

weavest the seven <u>07\_JUD\_16\_13</u> # And Delilah said unto Samson, Hitherto thou hast mocked me, and told me lies: tell me wherewith thou mightest be bound. And he said unto her, If thou weavest the seven locks of my head with the web.
