

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

wheat and barley <u>10\_2SA\_17\_28</u> # Brought beds, and basins, and earthen vessels, and wheat, and barley, and flour, and parched [corn], and beans, and lentiles, and parched [pulse],

wheat and barley <u>05\_DEU\_08\_08</u> # A land of wheat, and barley, and vines, and fig trees, and pomegranates; a land of oil olive, and honey;

wheat and barley <u>26\_EZE\_04\_09</u> # Take thou also unto thee wheat, and barley, and beans, and lentiles, and millet, and fitches, and put them in one vessel, and make thee bread thereof, [according] to the number of the days that thou shalt lie upon thy side, three hundred and ninety days shalt thou eat thereof.

wheat and beasts <u>66\_REV\_18\_13</u># And cinnamon, and odours, and ointments, and frankincense, and wine, and oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and beasts, and sheep, and horses, and chariots, and slaves, and souls of men.

wheat and cockle <u>18\_JOB\_31\_40</u># Let thistles grow instead of wheat, and cockle instead of barley. The words of Job are ended.

wheat and for <u>24\_JER\_31\_12</u> # Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Zion, and shall flow together to the goodness of the LORD, for wheat, and for wine, and for oil, and for the young of the flock and of the herd: and their soul shall be as a watered garden; and they shall not sorrow any more at all.

wheat and for <u>29\_JOE\_01\_11</u># Be ye ashamed, O ye husbandmen; howl, O ye vinedressers, for the wheat and for the barley; because the harvest of the field is perished.

wheat And he <u>42\_LUK\_16\_07</u> # Then said he to another, And how much owest thou? And he said, An hundred measures of wheat. And he said unto him, Take thy bill, and write fourscore.

wheat and of <u>24\_JER\_41\_08</u> # But ten men were found among them that said unto Ishmael, Slay us not: for we have treasures in the field, of wheat, and of barley, and of oil, and of honey. So he forbare, and slew them not among their brethren.

wheat and ten <u>14\_2CH\_27\_05</u># He fought also with the king of the Ammonites, and prevailed against them. And the children of Ammon gave him the same year an hundred talents of silver, and ten thousand measures of wheat, and ten thousand of barley. So much did the children of Ammon pay unto him, both the second year, and the third.

wheat and the <u>14\_2CH\_02\_15</u># Now therefore the wheat, and the barley, the oil, and the wine, which my lord hath spoken of, let him send unto his servants:

wheat and the <u>02\_EXO\_09\_32</u># But the wheat and the rie were not smitten: for they [were] not grown up.

wheat and the <u>23\_ISA\_28\_25</u># When he hath made plain the face thereof, doth he not cast abroad the fitches, and scatter the cummin, and cast in the principal wheat and the appointed barley and the rie in their place?

wheat and the <u>29\_JOE\_02\_24</u> # And the floors shall be full of wheat, and the vats shall overflow with wine and oil.

wheat and they <u>10\_2SA\_04\_06</u> # And they came thither into the midst of the house, [as though] they would have fetched wheat; and they smote him under the fifth [rib]: and Rechab and Baanah his brother escaped.

wheat and thou <u>05\_DEU\_32\_14</u># Butter of kine, and milk of sheep, with fat of lambs, and rams of the breed of Bashan, and goats, with the fat of kidneys of wheat; and thou didst drink the pure blood of the grape.

wheat and to <u>15 EZR 07 22</u> # Unto an hundred talents of silver, and to an hundred measures of wheat, and to an hundred baths of wine, and to an hundred baths of oil, and salt without prescribing [how much].

wheat and twenty <u>14\_2CH\_02\_10</u> # And, behold, I will give to thy servants, the hewers that cut timber, twenty thousand measures of beaten wheat, and twenty thousand measures of barley, and twenty thousand baths of wine, and twenty thousand baths of oil.

wheat and went <u>40\_MAT\_13\_25</u># But while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went his way.

wheat and with <u>19\_PSA\_81\_16</u># He should have fed them also with the finest of the wheat: and with honey out of the rock should I have satisfied thee.

wheat and ye <u>26\_EZE\_45\_13</u># This [is] the oblation that ye shall offer; the sixth part of an ephah of an homer of wheat, and ye shall give the sixth part of an ephah of an homer of barley:

wheat but shall <u>24\_JER\_12\_13</u># They have sown wheat, but shall reap thorns: they have put themselves to pain, [but] shall not profit: and they shall be ashamed of your revenues because of the fierce anger of the LORD.

wheat by the <u>07\_JUD\_06\_11</u> # And there came an angel of the LORD, and sat under an oak which [was] in Ophrah, that [pertained] unto Joash the Abiezrite: and his son Gideon threshed wheat by the winepress, to hide [it] from the Midianites.

wheat fall into <u>43\_JOH\_12\_24</u> # Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

wheat for a <u>66\_REV\_06\_06</u># And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and [see] thou hurt not the oil and the wine.

wheat for food <u>11\_1KI\_05\_11</u># And Solomon gave Hiram twenty thousand measures of wheat [for] food to his household, and twenty measures of pure oil: thus gave Solomon to Hiram year by year.

wheat for the <u>13\_1CH\_21\_23</u># And Ornan said unto David, Take [it] to thee, and let my lord the king do [that which is] good in his eyes: lo, I give [thee] the oxen [also] for burnt offerings, and the threshing instruments for wood, and the wheat for the meat offering; I give it all.

wheat harvest and <u>02\_EXO\_34\_22</u> # And thou shalt observe the feast of weeks, of the firstfruits of wheat harvest, and the feast of ingathering at the year's end.

wheat harvest and <u>01\_GEN\_30\_14</u> # And Reuben went in the days of wheat harvest, and found mandrakes in the field, and brought them unto his mother Leah. Then Rachel said to Leah, Give me, I pray thee, of thy son's mandrakes.

wheat harvest and <u>08\_RUT\_02\_23</u># So she kept fast by the maidens of Boaz to glean unto the end of barley harvest and of wheat harvest; and dwelt with her mother in law.

wheat harvest in <u>09\_1SA\_06\_13</u># And [they of] Bethshemesh [were] reaping their wheat harvest in the

valley: and they lifted up their eyes, and saw the ark, and rejoiced to see [it].

wheat harvest that <u>07\_JUD\_15\_01</u> # But it came to pass within a while after, in the time of wheat harvest, that Samson visited his wife with a kid; and he said, I will go in to my wife into the chamber. But her father would not suffer him to go in.

wheat harvest to <u>09\_1SA\_12\_17</u># [Is it] not wheat harvest to day? I will call unto the LORD, and he shall send thunder and rain; that ye may perceive and see that your wickedness [is] great, which ye have done in the sight of the LORD, in asking you a king.

wheat into his <u>42\_LUK\_03\_17</u># Whose fan [is] in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and will gather the wheat into his garner; but the chaff he will burn with fire unquenchable.

wheat into my <u>40\_MAT\_13\_30</u># Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.

wheat into the <u>44\_ACT\_27\_38</u> # And when they had eaten enough, they lightened the ship, and cast out the wheat into the sea.

wheat into the <u>40\_MAT\_03\_12</u># Whose fan [is] in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

wheat making the <u>30\_AMO\_08\_05</u># Saying, When will the new moon be gone, that we may sell corn? and the sabbath, that we may set forth wheat, making the ephah small, and the shekel great, and falsifying the balances by deceit?

wheat of Minnith <u>26\_EZE\_27\_17</u># Judah, and the land of Israel, they [were] thy merchants: they traded in thy market wheat of Minnith, and Pannag, and honey, and oil, and balm.

wheat or of <u>46\_1CO\_15\_37</u> # And that which thou sowest, thou sowest not that body that shall be, but bare grain, it may chance of wheat, or of some other [grain]:

wheat saith the <u>24\_JER\_23\_28</u># The prophet that hath a dream, let him tell a dream; and he that hath my word, let him speak my word faithfully. What [is] the chaff to the wheat? saith the LORD.

wheat salt wine <u>15\_EZR\_06\_09</u> # And that which they have need of, both young bullocks, and rams, and lambs, for the burnt offerings of the God of heaven, wheat, salt, wine, and oil, according to the appointment of the priests which [are] at Jerusalem, let it be given them day by day without fail:

wheat set about <u>22\_SON\_07\_02</u> # Thy navel [is like] a round goblet, [which] wanteth not liquor: thy belly [is like] an heap of wheat set about with lilies.

wheat the firstfruits <u>04\_NUM\_18\_12</u> # All the best of the oil, and all the best of the wine, and of the wheat, the firstfruits of them which they shall offer unto the LORD, them have I given thee.

wheat with a <u>20\_PRO\_27\_22</u> # Though thou shouldest bray a fool in a mortar among wheat with a pestle, [yet] will not his foolishness depart from him.

wheat with them <u>40\_MAT\_13\_29</u># But he said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the tares, ye root up also the wheat with them.

wheat ye have <u>30\_AMO\_05\_11</u># Forasmuch therefore as your treading [is] upon the poor, and ye take from him burdens of wheat: ye have built houses of hewn stone, but ye shall not dwell in them; ye have planted pleasant vineyards, but ye shall not drink wine of them. wheat <u>13\_1CH\_21\_20</u># And Ornan turned back, and saw the angel; and his four sons with him hid themselves. Now Ornan was threshing wheat.

wheat <u>30\_AMO\_08\_06</u> # That we may buy the poor for silver, and the needy for a pair of shoes; [yea], and sell the refuse of the wheat?

wheat <u>42\_LUK\_22\_31</u> # And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired [to have] you, that he may sift [you] as wheat:

wheat <u>19\_PSA\_147\_14</u> # He maketh peace [in] thy borders, [and] filleth thee with the finest of the wheat.

wheaten flour shalt <u>02\_EXO\_29\_02</u> # And unleavened bread, and cakes unleavened tempered with oil, and wafers unleavened anointed with oil: [of] wheaten flour shalt thou make them.
