whose altars Hezekiah <u>12\_2KI\_18\_22</u> # But if ye say unto me, We trust in the LORD our God: [is] not that he, whose high places and whose altars Hezekiah hath taken away, and hath said to Judah and Jerusalem, Ye shall worship before this altar in Jerusalem?

whose belly thou <u>19\_PSA\_17\_14</u># From men [which are] thy hand, O LORD, from men of the world,

whose blood is <u>58\_HEB\_13\_11</u># For the bodies of those beasts, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned without the camp.

Whose daughter art <u>01\_GEN\_24\_47</u># And I asked her, and said, Whose daughter [art] thou? And she said, The daughter of Bethuel, Nahor's son, whom Milcah bare unto him: and I put the earring upon her face, and the bracelets upon her hands.

whose daughters ye <u>60\_1PE\_03\_06</u># Even as Sara obeyed Abraham, calling him lord: whose daughters ye are, as long as ye do well, and are not afraid with any amazement.

whose day is <u>26\_EZE\_21\_25</u> # And thou, profane wicked prince of Israel, whose day is come, when iniquity [shall have] an end,

whose day is <u>26\_EZE\_21\_29</u> # Whiles they see vanity unto thee, whiles they divine a lie unto thee, to bring thee upon the necks of [them that are] slain, of the wicked, whose day is come, when their iniquity [shall have] an end.

whose house is <u>44\_ACT\_10\_06</u># He lodgeth with one Simon a tanner, whose house is by the sea side: he shall tell thee what thou oughtest to do.

whose house joined <u>44\_ACT\_18\_07</u> # And he departed thence, and entered into a certain [man's] house, named Justus, [one] that worshipped God, whose house joined hard to the synagogue.

whose I am <u>44\_ACT\_27\_23</u> # For there stood by me this night the angel of God, whose I am, and whom I serve,

Whose image and <u>42\_LUK\_20\_24</u># Show me a penny. Whose image and superscription hath it? They answered and said, Caesar's.

whose iniquities are <u>45\_ROM\_04\_07</u> # [Saying], Blessed [are] they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered.

Whose is the <u>10\_2SA\_03\_12</u> # And Abner sent messengers to David on his behalf, saying, Whose [is] the land? saying [also], Make thy league with me, and, behold, my hand [shall be] with thee, to bring about all Israel unto thee.

Whose is this <u>41\_MAR\_12\_16</u># And they brought [it]. And he saith unto them, Whose [is] this image and superscription? And they said unto him, Caesar's.

Whose is this <u>40\_MAT\_22\_20</u># And he saith unto them, Whose [is] this image and superscription?

whose issue is <u>26\_EZE\_23\_20</u># For she doted upon their paramours, whose flesh [is as] the flesh of asses, and whose issue [is like] the issue of horses.

whose it shall <u>43\_JOH\_19\_24</u> # They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. Whose mouths must <u>56\_TIT\_01\_11</u># Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching

things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake.

whose name alone <u>19\_PSA\_83\_18</u> # That [men] may know that thou, whose name alone [is] JEHOVAH, [art] the most high over all the earth.

whose name he <u>07\_JUD\_08\_31</u> # And his concubine that [was] in Shechem, she also bare him a son, whose name he called Abimelech.

whose name in <u>66\_REV\_09\_11</u># And they had a king over them, [which is] the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue [is] Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath [his] name Apollyon.

whose name is <u>13\_1CH\_13\_06</u> # And David went up, and all Israel, to Baalah, [that is], to Kirjathjearim, which [belonged] to Judah, to bring up thence the ark of God the LORD, that dwelleth [between] the cherubims, whose name is called [on it].

whose name was <u>09\_1SA\_09\_02</u># And he had a son, whose name [was] Saul, a choice young man, and a goodly: and [there was] not among the children of Israel a goodlier person than he: from his shoulders and upward [he was] higher than any of the people.

whose name was <u>09\_1SA\_17\_12</u> # Now David [was] the son of that Ephrathite of Bethlehemjudah, whose name [was] Jesse; and he had eight sons: and the man went among men [for] an old man in the days of Saul.

whose name was <u>14\_2CH\_28\_09</u> # But a prophet of the LORD was there, whose name [was] Oded: and he went out before the host that came to Samaria, and said unto them, Behold, because the LORD God of your fathers was wroth with Judah, he hath delivered them into your hand, and ye have slain them in a rage [that] reacheth up unto heaven.

whose name was <u>01\_GEN\_22\_24</u># And his concubine, whose name [was] Reumah, she bare also Tebah, and Gaham, and Thahash, and Maachah.

whose name was <u>01\_GEN\_38\_01</u> # And it came to pass at that time, that Judah went down from his brethren, and turned in to a certain Adullamite, whose name [was] Hirah.

whose name was <u>01\_GEN\_38\_02</u># And Judah saw there a daughter of a certain Canaanite, whose name [was] Shuah; and he took her, and went in unto her.

whose name was 01\_GEN\_38\_06 # And Judah took a wife for Er his firstborn, whose name [was] Tamar.

whose name was <u>42\_LUK\_02\_25</u> # And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name [was] Simeon; and the same man [was] just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was

upon him.

whose name was <u>42\_LUK\_24\_18</u># And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?
