wide against me <u>19_PSA_35_21</u> # Yea, they opened their mouth wide against me, [and] said, Aha, aha, our eye hath seen [it].

wide and I <u>19_PSA_81_10</u># I [am] the LORD thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt: open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it.

wide and quiet <u>13_1CH_04_40</u> # And they found fat pasture and good, and the land [was] wide, and quiet, and peaceable; for [they] of Ham had dwelt there of old.

wide as for <u>18_JOB_29_23</u> # And they waited for me as for the rain; and they opened their mouth wide [as] for the latter rain.

wide breaking in <u>18_JOB_30_14</u> # They came [upon me] as a wide breaking in [of waters]: in the desolation they rolled themselves [upon me].

wide his lips <u>20_PRO_13_03</u># He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: [but] he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.

wide house and <u>24_JER_22_14</u># That saith, I will build me a wide house and large chambers, and cutteth him out windows; and [it is] ceiled with cedar, and painted with vermilion.

wide house <u>20_PRO_21_09</u> # [It is] better to dwell in a corner of the housetop, than with a brawling woman in a wide house.

wide house <u>20_PRO_25_24</u> # [It is] better to dwell in the corner of the housetop, than with a brawling woman and in a wide house.

wide is the <u>40_MAT_07_13</u># Enter ye in at the strait gate: for wide [is] the gate, and broad [is] the way, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat:

wide mouth and <u>23_ISA_57_04</u> # Against whom do ye sport yourselves? against whom make ye a wide mouth, [and] draw out the tongue? [are] ye not children of transgression, a seed of falsehood,

wide open unto <u>34_NAH_03_13</u># Behold, thy people in the midst of thee [are] women: the gates of thy land shall be set wide open unto thine enemies: the fire shall devour thy bars.

wide sea wherein <u>19_PSA_104_25</u># [So is] this great and wide sea, wherein [are] things creeping innumerable, both small and great beasts.

wide unto him <u>05_DEU_15_08</u> # But thou shalt open thine hand wide unto him, and shalt surely lend him sufficient for his need, [in that] which he wanteth.

wide unto thy <u>05_DEU_15_11</u># For the poor shall never cease out of the land: therefore I command thee, saying, Thou shalt open thine hand wide unto thy brother, to thy poor, and to thy needy, in thy land.

wideness of twenty <u>26_EZE_41_10</u> # And between the chambers [was] the wideness of twenty cubits round about the house on every side.
