wilderness a dry <u>24\_JER\_50\_12</u> # Your mother shall be sore confounded; she that bare you shall be ashamed: behold, the hindermost of the nations [shall be] a wilderness, a dry land, and a desert.

wilderness a lamentation 24\_JER\_09\_10 # For the mountains will I take up a weeping and wailing, and for the habitations of the wilderness a lamentation, because they are burned up, so that none can pass through [them]; neither can [men] hear the voice of the cattle; both the fowl of the heavens and the beast are fled; they are gone.

wilderness which ye <u>05\_DEU\_01\_19</u> # And when we departed from Horeb, we went through all that great and terrible wilderness, which ye saw by the way of the mountain of the Amorites, as the LORD our God commanded us; and we came to Kadeshbarnea.

wilderness with her <u>13\_1CH\_06\_78</u> # And on the other side Jordan by Jericho, on the east side of Jordan, [were given them] out of the tribe of Reuben, Bezer in the wilderness with her suburbs, and Jahzah with her suburbs,

wilderness with manna <u>05\_DEU\_08\_16</u> # Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end;

wilderness with the <u>44\_ACT\_07\_38</u> # This is he, that was in the church in the wilderness with the angel which spake to him in the mount Sina, and [with] our fathers: who received the lively oracles to give unto us:

wilderness yea and <u>29\_JOE\_02\_03</u># A fire devoureth before them; and behind them a flame burneth: the land [is] as the garden of Eden before them, and behind them a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing shall escape them.

wilderness yieldeth food <u>18\_JOB\_24\_05</u> # Behold, [as] wild asses in the desert, go they forth to their work; rising betimes for a prey: the wilderness [yieldeth] food for them [and] for [their] children.

wilderness your clothes <u>05\_DEU\_29\_05</u> # And I have led you forty years in the wilderness: your clothes are not waxen old upon you, and thy shoe is not waxen old upon thy foot.

wilderness Zion is <u>23\_ISA\_64\_10</u># Thy holy cities are a wilderness, Zion is a wilderness, Jerusalem a desolation.

wilderness <u>46\_1CO\_10\_05</u> # But with many of them God was not well pleased: for they were overthrown in

the wilderness.

wilderness <u>09\_1SA\_04\_08</u> # Woe unto us! who shall deliver us out of the hand of these mighty Gods? these [are] the Gods that smote the Egyptians with all the plagues in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>09\_1SA\_13\_18</u> # And another company turned the way [to] Bethhoron: and another company turned [to] the way of the border that looketh to the valley of Zeboim toward the wilderness.

wilderness <u>09\_1SA\_26\_03</u> # And Saul pitched in the hill of Hachilah, which [is] before Jeshimon, by the way. But David abode in the wilderness, and he saw that Saul came after him into the wilderness.

wilderness <u>10\_2SA\_15\_23</u># And all the country wept with a loud voice, and all the people passed over: the king also himself passed over the brook Kidron, and all the people passed over, toward the way of the wilderness.

wilderness <u>10\_2SA\_17\_29</u># And honey, and butter, and sheep, and cheese of kine, for David, and for the people that [were] with him, to eat: for they said, The people [is] hungry, and weary, and thirsty, in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>44\_ACT\_07\_42</u> # Then God turned, and gave them up to worship the host of heaven; as it is written in the book of the prophets, O ye house of Israel, have ye offered to me slain beasts and sacrifices [by the space of] forty years in the wilderness?

wilderness <u>44\_ACT\_13\_18</u> # And about the time of forty years suffered he their manners in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>30\_AMO\_06\_14</u> # But, behold, I will raise up against you a nation, O house of Israel, saith the LORD the God of hosts; and they shall afflict you from the entering in of Hemath unto the river of the wilderness.

wilderness <u>05\_DEU\_09\_28</u> # Lest the land whence thou broughtest us out say, Because the LORD was not able to bring them into the land which he promised them, and because he hated them, he hath brought them out to slay them in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>02\_EXO\_05\_01</u> # And afterward Moses and Aaron went in, and told Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Let my people go, that they may hold a feast unto me in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>02\_EXO\_13\_20</u># And they took their journey from Succoth, and encamped in Etham, in the edge of the wilderness.

wilderness <u>02\_EXO\_14\_12</u> # [Is] not this the word that we did tell thee in Egypt, saying, Let us alone, that we may serve the Egyptians? For [it had been] better for us to serve the Egyptians, than that we should die in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>02\_EXO\_16\_02</u># And the whole congregation of the children of Israel murmured against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness:

wilderness <u>26\_EZE\_20\_10</u> # Wherefore I caused them to go forth out of the land of Egypt, and brought them into the wilderness.

wilderness <u>26\_EZE\_20\_17</u># Nevertheless mine eye spared them from destroying them, neither did I make an end of them in the wilderness.

wilderness 26\_EZE\_20\_21 # Notwithstanding the children rebelled against me: they walked not in my statutes, neither kept my judgments to do them, which [if] a man do, he shall even live in them; they polluted my sabbaths: then I said, I would pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>01\_GEN\_14\_06</u> # And the Horites in their mount Seir, unto Elparan, which [is] by the wilderness.

wilderness <u>58\_HEB\_03\_08</u> # Harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness:

wilderness <u>58\_HEB\_03\_17</u> # But with whom was he grieved forty years? [was it] not with them that had sinned, whose carcases fell in the wilderness?

wilderness <u>24\_JER\_12\_10</u> # Many pastors have destroyed my vineyard, they have trodden my portion under foot, they have made my pleasant portion a desolate wilderness.

wilderness <u>24\_JER\_13\_24</u># Therefore will I scatter them as the stubble that passeth away by the wind of the wilderness.

wilderness <u>24\_JER\_48\_06</u> # Flee, save your lives, and be like the heath in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>29\_JOE\_01\_20</u> # The beasts of the field cry also unto thee: for the rivers of waters are dried up, and the fire hath devoured the pastures of the wilderness.

wilderness <u>06\_JOS\_08\_15</u># And Joshua and all Israel made as if they were beaten before them, and fled by the way of the wilderness.

wilderness <u>25\_LAM\_04\_03</u> # Even the sea monsters draw out the breast, they give suck to their young ones: the daughter of my people [is become] cruel, like the ostriches in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>25\_LAM\_04\_19</u> # Our persecutors are swifter than the eagles of the heaven: they pursued us upon the mountains, they laid wait for us in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>25\_LAM\_05\_09</u> # We gat our bread with [the peril of] our lives because of the sword of the wilderness.

wilderness <u>03\_LEV\_16\_10</u> # But the goat, on which the lot fell to be the scapegoat, shall be presented alive before the LORD, to make an atonement with him, [and] to let him go for a scapegoat into the wilderness.

wilderness <u>03\_LEV\_16\_21</u> # And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send [him] away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness:

wilderness <u>03\_LEV\_16\_22</u> # And the goat shall bear upon him all their iniquities unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>42\_LUK\_03\_02</u> # Annas and Caiaphas being the high priests, the word of God came unto John

the son of Zacharias in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>42\_LUK\_04\_01</u> # And Jesus being full of the Holy Ghost returned from Jordan, and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

wilderness <u>42\_LUK\_08\_29</u> # [For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.]

wilderness <u>39\_MAL\_01\_03</u># And I hated Esau, and laid his mountains and his heritage waste for the dragons of the wilderness.

wilderness <u>41\_MAR\_01\_12</u># And immediately the Spirit driveth him into the wilderness.

wilderness <u>41\_MAR\_08\_04</u> # And his disciples answered him, From whence can a man satisfy these [men] with bread here in the wilderness?

wilderness <u>04\_NUM\_14\_02</u> # And all the children of Israel murmured against Moses and against Aaron: and the whole congregation said unto them, Would God that we had died in the land of Egypt! or would God we had died in this wilderness!

wilderness <u>04\_NUM\_14\_16</u> # Because the LORD was not able to bring this people into the land which he sware unto them, therefore he hath slain them in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>04\_NUM\_14\_32</u> # But [as for] you, your carcases, they shall fall in this wilderness.

wilderness <u>04\_NUM\_14\_33</u> # And your children shall wander in the wilderness forty years, and bear your whoredoms, until your carcases be wasted in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>04\_NUM\_24\_01</u> # And when Balaam saw that it pleased the LORD to bless Israel, he went not, as at other times, to seek for enchantments, but he set his face toward the wilderness.

wilderness <u>04\_NUM\_33\_06</u># And they departed from Succoth, and pitched in Etham, which [is] in the edge of the wilderness.

wilderness <u>19\_PSA\_106\_09</u> # He rebuked the Red sea also, and it was dried up: so he led them through the depths, as through the wilderness.

wilderness <u>19\_PSA\_106\_26</u># Therefore he lifted up his hand against them, to overthrow them in the wilderness:

wilderness <u>19\_PSA\_74\_14</u> # Thou brakest the heads of leviathan in pieces, [and] gavest him [to be] meat to the people inhabiting the wilderness.

wilderness <u>19\_PSA\_78\_17</u># And they sinned yet more against him by provoking the most High in the wilderness.

wilderness <u>19\_PSA\_78\_19</u># Yea, they spake against God; they said, Can God furnish a table in the wilderness?

wilderness <u>19\_PSA\_95\_08</u># Harden not your heart, as in the provocation, [and] as [in] the day of temptation in the wilderness:

wilderness <u>36\_ZEP\_02\_13</u> # And he will stretch out his hand against the north, and destroy Assyria; and will make Nineveh a desolation, [and] dry like a wilderness.
