whirlwind among all <u>38_ZEC_07_14</u># But I scattered them with a whirlwind among all the nations whom they knew not. Thus the land was desolate after them, that no man passed through nor returned: for they laid the pleasant land desolate.

whirlwind and cold <u>18_JOB_37_09</u># Out of the south cometh the whirlwind: and cold out of the north.

whirlwind and in <u>34_NAH_01_03</u> # The LORD [is] slow to anger, and great in power, and will not at all acquit [the wicked]: the LORD hath his way in the whirlwind and in the storm, and the clouds [are] the dust of his feet.

whirlwind and said <u>18_JOB_38_01</u># Then the LORD answered Job out of the whirlwind, and said,

whirlwind and said <u>18_JOB_40_06</u># Then answered the LORD unto Job out of the whirlwind, and said,

whirlwind both living <u>19_PSA_58_09</u># Before your pots can feel the thorns, he shall take them away as with a whirlwind, both living, and in [his] wrath.

whirlwind shall be <u>24_JER_25_32</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, Behold, evil shall go forth from nation to nation, and a great whirlwind shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth.

whirlwind shall scatter <u>23_ISA_41_16</u># Thou shalt fan them, and the wind shall carry them away, and the whirlwind shall scatter them: and thou shalt rejoice in the LORD, [and] shalt glory in the Holy One of Israel.

whirlwind shall take 23_ISA_40_24 # Yea, they shall not be planted; yea, they shall not be sown: yea, their stock shall not take root in the earth: and he shall also blow upon them, and they shall wither, and the whirlwind shall take them away as stubble.

whirlwind that Elijah <u>12_2KI_02_01</u> # And it came to pass, when the LORD would take up Elijah into heaven by a whirlwind, that Elijah went with Elisha from Gilgal.

wind and followeth <u>28_HOS_12_01</u> # Ephraim feedeth on wind, and followeth after the east wind: he daily increaseth lies and desolation; and they do make a covenant with the Assyrians, and oil is carried into Egypt.

wind and I <u>26_EZE_05_02</u> # Thou shalt burn with fire a third part in the midst of the city, when the days of the siege are fulfilled: and thou shalt take a third part, [and] smite about it with a knife: and a third part thou shalt scatter in the wind; and I will draw out a sword after them.

wind I did <u>19_PSA_18_42</u># Then did I beat them small as the dust before the wind: I did cast them out as the dirt in the streets.

wind in his 20_PRO_30_04 # Who hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? what [is] his name, and what [is] his son's name, if thou canst tell?

wind in my <u>26_EZE_13_13</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; I will even rend [it] with a stormy wind in my fury; and there shall be an overflowing shower in mine anger, and great hailstones in [my] fury to consume [it].

wind in the <u>23_ISA_27_08</u> # In measure, when it shooteth forth, thou wilt debate with it: he stayeth his rough wind in the day of the east wind.

wind into the <u>32_JON_01_04</u> # But the LORD sent out a great wind into the sea, and there was a mighty tempest in the sea, so that the ship was like to be broken.

wind like dragons <u>24_JER_14_06</u> # And the wild asses did stand in the high places, they snuffed up the wind like dragons; their eyes did fail, because [there was] no grass.

wind to blow <u>19_PSA_147_18</u># He sendeth out his word, and melteth them: he causeth his wind to blow, [and] the waters flow.

wind to blow <u>19_PSA_78_26</u># He caused an east wind to blow in the heaven: and by his power he brought in the south wind.

wind to pass <u>01_GEN_08_01</u># And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that [was] with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters asswaged;

wind toucheth it <u>26_EZE_17_10</u># Yea, behold, [being] planted, shall it prosper? shall it not utterly wither, when the east wind toucheth it? it shall wither in the furrows where it grew.

wind without rain <u>20_PRO_25_14</u># Whoso boasteth himself of a false gift [is like] clouds and wind without rain.

wind <u>10_2SA_22_11</u># And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: and he was seen upon the wings of the wind.

wind <u>21_ECC_05_16</u># And this also [is] a sore evil, [that] in all points as he came, so shall he go: and what profit hath he that hath laboured for the wind?

wind <u>23_ISA_07_02</u> # And it was told the house of David, saying, Syria is confederate with Ephraim. And his heart was moved, and the heart of his people, as the trees of the wood are moved with the wind.
