wisely and dispersed 14\_2CH\_11\_23# And he dealt wisely, and dispersed of all his children throughout all the countries of Judah and Benjamin, unto every fenced city: and he gave them victual in abundance. And he desired many wives.

wisely and Saul <u>09\_1SA\_18\_05</u># And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, [and] behaved himself wisely: and Saul set him over the men of war, and he was accepted in the sight of all the people, and also in the sight of Saul's servants.

wisely concerning this <u>21\_ECC\_07\_10</u># Say not thou, What is [the cause] that the former days were better than these? for thou dost not inquire wisely concerning this.

wisely consider of 19\_PSA\_64\_09 # And all men shall fear, and shall declare the work of God; for they shall wisely consider of his doing.
