wither and the <u>23\_ISA\_40\_24</u># Yea, they shall not be planted; yea, they shall not be sown: yea, their stock shall not take root in the earth: and he shall also blow upon them, and they shall wither, and the whirlwind shall take them away as stubble.

wither and whatsoever 19\_PSA\_01\_03 # And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

wither as the 19\_PSA\_37\_02 # For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb.

wither be driven <u>23\_ISA\_19\_07</u># The paper reeds by the brooks, by the mouth of the brooks, and every thing sown by the brooks, shall wither, be driven away, and be no [more].

wither for the <u>24\_JER\_12\_04</u># How long shall the land mourn, and the herbs of every field wither, for the wickedness of them that dwell therein? the beasts are consumed, and the birds; because they said, He shall not see our last end.

wither in all <u>26\_EZE\_17\_09</u> # Say thou, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Shall it prosper? shall he not pull up the roots thereof, and cut off the fruit thereof, that it wither? it shall wither in all the leaves of her spring, even without great power or many people to pluck it up by the roots thereof.

wither in the <u>26\_EZE\_17\_10</u> # Yea, behold, [being] planted, shall it prosper? shall it not utterly wither, when the east wind toucheth it? it shall wither in the furrows where it grew.

wither it shall <u>26\_EZE\_17\_09</u> # Say thou, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Shall it prosper? shall he not pull up the roots thereof, and cut off the fruit thereof, that it wither? it shall wither in all the leaves of her spring, even without great power or many people to pluck it up by the roots thereof.

wither when the <u>26\_EZE\_17\_10</u> # Yea, behold, [being] planted, shall it prosper? shall it not utterly wither, when the east wind toucheth it? it shall wither in the furrows where it grew.

wither <u>30\_AMO\_01\_02</u> # And he said, The LORD will roar from Zion, and utter his voice from Jerusalem; and the habitations of the shepherds shall mourn, and the top of Carmel shall wither.

wither <u>23\_ISA\_19\_06</u># And they shall turn the rivers far away; [and] the brooks of defence shall be emptied and dried up: the reeds and flags shall wither.

withered and men <u>43\_JOH\_15\_06</u> # If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast [them] into the fire, and they are burned.

withered And they 40\_MAT\_12\_10# And, behold, there was a man which had [his] hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him.

withered away because <u>42\_LUK\_08\_06</u> # And some fell upon a rock; and as soon as it was sprung up, it withered away, because it lacked moisture.

withered away from 29\_JOE\_01\_12 # The vine is dried up, and the fig tree languisheth; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree, [even] all the trees of the field, are withered: because joy is withered away from the sons of men.

withered away the <u>23\_ISA\_15\_06</u> # For the waters of Nimrim shall be desolate: for the hay is withered away, the grass faileth, there is no green thing.

withered away <u>41\_MAR\_04\_06</u># But when the sun was up, it was scorched; and because it had no root, it withered away.

withered away 41\_MAR\_11\_21 # And Peter calling to remembrance saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away.

withered away 40\_MAT\_13\_06 # And when the sun was up, they were scorched; and because they had no root, they withered away.

withered away <u>40\_MAT\_21\_19</u># And when he saw a fig tree in the way, he came to it, and found nothing thereon, but leaves only, and said unto it, Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever. And presently the fig tree withered away.

withered away <u>40\_MAT\_21\_20</u># And when the disciples saw [it], they marvelled, saying, How soon is the fig tree withered away!

withered because joy <u>29\_JOE\_01\_12</u># The vine is dried up, and the fig tree languisheth; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree, [even] all the trees of the field, are withered: because joy is withered away from the sons of men.

withered hand Rise <u>42\_LUK\_06\_08</u># But he knew their thoughts, and said to the man which had the withered hand, Rise up, and stand forth in the midst. And he arose and stood forth.

withered hand Stand 41\_MAR\_03\_03 # And he saith unto the man which had the withered hand, Stand forth.

withered hand <u>41\_MAR\_03\_01</u> # And he entered again into the synagogue; and there was a man there which had a withered hand.

withered it is <u>25\_LAM\_04\_08</u> # Their visage is blacker than a coal; they are not known in the streets: their skin cleaveth to their bones; it is withered, it is become like a stick.

withered like grass <u>19\_PSA\_102\_04</u> # My heart is smitten, and withered like grass; so that I forget to eat my bread.

withered like grass 19\_PSA\_102\_11 # My days [are] like a shadow that declineth; and I am withered like grass.

withered the fire <u>26\_EZE\_19\_12</u># But she was plucked up in fury, she was cast down to the ground, and the east wind dried up her fruit: her strong rods were broken and withered; the fire consumed them.

withered they shall <u>23\_ISA\_27\_11</u># When the boughs thereof are withered, they shall be broken off: the women come, [and] set them on fire: for it [is] a people of no understanding: therefore he that made them will not have mercy on them, and he that formed them will show them no favour.

withered thin and <u>01\_GEN\_41\_23</u> # And, behold, seven ears, withered, thin, [and] blasted with the east wind, sprung up after them:

withered waiting for <u>43\_JOH\_05\_03</u> # In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered, waiting for the moving of the water.

withered <u>30 AMO 04 07 # And also I have withholden the rain from you, when [there were] yet three months to the harvest: and I caused it to rain upon one city, and caused it not to rain upon another city: one piece was rained upon, and the piece whereupon it rained not withered.</u>

withered <u>29\_JOE\_01\_17</u> # The seed is rotten under their clods, the garners are laid desolate, the barns are broken down; for the corn is withered.

withered <u>32\_JON\_04\_07</u># But God prepared a worm when the morning rose the next day, and it smote the gourd that it withered.

withered <u>42\_LUK\_06\_06</u> # And it came to pass also on another sabbath, that he entered into the synagogue and taught: and there was a man whose right hand was withered.

withereth afore it 19\_PSA\_129\_06 # Let them be as the grass [upon] the housetops, which withereth afore it groweth up:

withereth and the <u>60\_1PE\_01\_24</u> # For all flesh [is] as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away:

withereth before any <u>18\_JOB\_08\_12</u> # Whilst it [is] yet in his greenness, [and] not cut down, it withereth before any [other] herb.

withereth the flower <u>23\_ISA\_40\_07</u> # The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: because the spirit of the LORD bloweth upon it: surely the people [is] grass.

withereth the flower <u>23\_ISA\_40\_08</u># The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand for ever.

withereth the grass <u>59\_JAM\_01\_11</u># For the sun is no sooner risen with a burning heat, but it withereth the grass, and the flower thereof falleth, and the grace of the fashion of it perisheth: so also shall the rich man fade away in his ways.

withereth without fruit <u>65\_JDE\_01\_12</u> # These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds [they are] without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withereth, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots;

withereth <u>19\_PSA\_90\_06</u> # In the morning it flourisheth, and groweth up; in the evening it is cut down, and withereth.
