withered and men [43 JOH 15 06](#) # If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast [them] into the fire, and they are burned.

withered And they [40 MAT 12 10](#) # And, behold, there was a man which had [his] hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him.

withered away because [42 LUK 08 06](#) # And some fell upon a rock; and as soon as it was sprung up, it withered away, because it lacked moisture.

withered away from [29 JOE 01 12](#) # The vine is dried up, and the fig tree languisheth; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree, [even] all the trees of the field, are withered: because joy is withered away from the sons of men.

withered away the [23 ISA 15 06](#) # For the waters of Nimrim shall be desolate: for the hay is withered away, the grass faileth, there is no green thing.

withered away [41 MAR 04 06](#) # But when the sun was up, it was scorched; and because it had no root, it withered away.

withered away [41 MAR 11 21](#) # And Peter calling to remembrance saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away.

withered away [40 MAT 13 06](#) # And when the sun was up, they were scorched; and because they had no root, they withered away.

withered away [40 MAT 21 19](#) # And when he saw a fig tree in the way, he came to it, and found nothing thereon, but leaves only, and said unto it, Let no fruit grow on thee henceforward for ever. And presently the fig tree withered away.

withered away [40 MAT 21 20](#) # And when the disciples saw [it], they marvelled, saying, How soon is the fig tree withered away!

withered because joy [29 JOE 01 12](#) # The vine is dried up, and the fig tree languisheth; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree, [even] all the trees of the field, are withered: because joy is withered away from the sons of men.

withered hand Rise [42 LUK 06 08](#) # But he knew their thoughts, and said to the man which had the withered hand, Rise up, and stand forth in the midst. And he arose and stood forth.

withered hand Stand [41 MAR 03 03](#) # And he saith unto the man which had the withered hand, Stand forth.

withered hand [41 MAR 03 01](#) # And he entered again into the synagogue; and there was a man there which had a withered hand.

withered it is [25 LAM 04 08](#) # Their visage is blacker than a coal; they are not known in the streets: their skin cleaveth to their bones; it is withered, it is become like a stick.

withered like grass [19 PSA 102 04](#) # My heart is smitten, and withered like grass; so that I forget to eat my bread.

withered like grass [19 PSA 102 11](#) # My days [are] like a shadow that declineth; and I am withered like grass.

withered the fire [26 EZE 19 12](#) # But she was plucked up in fury, she was cast down to the ground, and the east wind dried up her fruit: her strong rods were broken and withered; the fire consumed them.

withered they shall [23 ISA 27 11](#) # When the boughs thereof are withered, they shall be broken off: the women come, [and] set them on fire: for it [is] a people of no understanding; therefore he that made them will not have mercy on them, and he that formed them will show them no favour.

withered thin and [01 GEN 41 23](#) # And, behold, seven ears, withered, thin, [and] blasted with the east wind, sprung up after them:

withered waiting for [43 JOH 05 03](#) # In these lay a great multitude of impotent folk, of blind, halt, withered, waiting for the moving of the water.

withered [30 AMO 04 07](#) # And also I have withholden the rain from you, when [there were] yet three months to the harvest: and I caused it to rain upon one city, and caused it not to rain upon another city: one piece was rained upon, and the piece whereupon it rained not withered.

withered [29 JOE 01 17](#) # The seed is rotten under their clods, the garners are laid desolate, the barns are broken down; for the corn is withered.

withered [32 JON 04 07](#) # But God prepared a worm when the morning rose the next day, and it smote the gourd that it withered.

withered [42 LUK 06 06](#) # And it came to pass also on another sabbath, that he entered into the synagogue and taught: and there was a man whose right hand was withered.
