wrong and defraud [46_1CO_06_08](#) # Nay, ye do wrong, and defraud, and that [your] brethren.

wrong as thou [44_ACT_25_10](#) # Then said Paul, I stand at Caesar's judgment seat, where I ought to be judged: to the Jews have I done no wrong, as thou very well knowest.

wrong be upon [01_GEN_16_05](#) # And Sarai said unto Abram, My wrong [be] upon thee: I have given my maid into thy bosom; and when she saw that she had conceived, I was despised in her eyes: the LORD judge between me and thee.

wrong but I [18_JOB_19_07](#) # Behold, I cry out of wrong, but I am not heard: I cry aloud, but [there is] no judgment.

wrong but that [47_2CO_07_12](#) # Wherefore, though I wrote unto you, [I did it] not for his cause that had done the wrong, nor for his cause that suffered wrong, but that our care for you in the sight of God might appear unto you.

wrong didst not [40_MAT_20_13](#) # But he answered one of them, and said, Friend, I do thee no wrong: didst not thou agree with me for a penny?

wrong do no [24_JER_22_03](#) # Thus saith the LORD; Execute ye judgment and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place.

wrong he defended [44_ACT_07_24](#) # And seeing one [of them] suffer wrong, he defended [him], and avenged him that was oppressed, and smote the Egyptian:

wrong in mine [13_1CH_12_17](#) # And David went out to meet them, and answered and said unto them, If ye be come peaceably unto me to help me, mine heart shall be knit unto you: but if [ye be come] to betray me to mine enemies, seeing [there is] no wrong in mine hands, the God of our fathers look [thereon], and rebuke [it].

wrong judge thou [25_LAM_03_59](#) # O LORD, thou hast seen my wrong: judge thou my cause.

wrong judgment proceedeth [35_HAB_01_04](#) # Therefore the law is slacked, and judgment doth never go forth: for the wicked doth compass about the righteous; therefore wrong judgment proceedeth.

wrong nor for [47_2CO_07_12](#) # Wherefore, though I wrote unto you, [I did it] not for his cause that had done the wrong, nor for his cause that suffered wrong, but that our care for you in the sight of God might appear unto you.

wrong one to [44_ACT_07_26](#) # And the next day he showed himself unto them as they strove, and would have set them at one again, saying, Sirs, ye are brethren; why do ye wrong one to another?

wrong or wicked [44_ACT_18_14](#) # And when Paul was now about to open [his] mouth, Gallio said unto the Jews, If it were a matter of wrong or wicked lewdness, O [ye] Jews, reason would that I should bear with you:

wrong shall receive [51_COL_03_25](#) # But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath

done: and there is no respect of persons.

wrong that useth [24 JER 22 13](#) # Woe unto him that buildeth his house by unrighteousness, and his chambers by wrong; [that] useth his neighbour's service without wages, and giveth him not for his work;

wrong thrust him [44 ACT 07 27](#) # But he that did his neighbour wrong thrust him away, saying, Who made thee a ruler and a judge over us?

wrong to the [17 EST 01 16](#) # And Memucan answered before the king and the princes, Vashti the queen hath not done wrong to the king only, but also to all the princes, and to all the people that [are] in all the provinces of the king Ahasuerus.

wrong to war [07 JUD 11 27](#) # Wherefore I have not sinned against thee, but thou doest me wrong to war against me: the LORD the Judge be judge this day between the children of Israel and the children of Ammon.

wrong Wherefore smitest [02 EXO 02 13](#) # And when he went out the second day, behold, two men of the Hebrews strove together: and he said to him that did the wrong, Wherefore smitest thou thy fellow?

wrong which he [51 COL 03 25](#) # But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath done: and there is no respect of persons.

wrong why do [46 1CO 06 07](#) # Now therefore there is utterly a fault among you, because ye go to law one with another. Why do ye not rather take wrong? why do ye not rather [suffer yourselves to] be defrauded?

wrong yea he [13 1CH 16 21](#) # He suffered no man to do them wrong: yea, he reproveth kings for their sakes,

wrong yea he [19 PSA 105 14](#) # He suffered no man to do them wrong: yea, he reproveth kings for their sakes;

wrong [47 2CO 12 13](#) # For what is it wherein ye were inferior to other churches, except [it be] that I myself was not burdensome to you? forgive me this wrong.

wrong [05 DEU 19 16](#) # If a false witness rise up against any man to testify against him [that which is] wrong;

wronged no man [47 2CO 07 02](#) # Receive us; we have wronged no man, we have corrupted no man, we have defrauded no man.

wronged thee or [57 PHM 01 18](#) # If he hath wronged thee, or oweth [thee] ought, put that on mine account;

wrongeth his own [20 PRO 08 36](#) # But he that sinneth against me wrongeth his own soul: all they that hate me love death.

wrongfully are mighty [19 PSA 69 04](#) # They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head: they that would destroy me, [being] mine enemies wrongfully, are mighty: then I restored [that] which I took not away.

wrongfully are multiplied [19 PSA 38 19](#) # But mine enemies [are] lively, [and] they are strong: and they that hate me wrongfully are multiplied.

wrongfully help thou [19 PSA 119 86](#) # All thy commandments [are] faithful: they persecute me wrongfully; help thou me.

wrongfully imagine against [18 JOB 21 27](#) # Behold, I know your thoughts, and the devices [which] ye wrongfully imagine against me.

wrongfully rejoice over [19 PSA 35 19](#) # Let not them that are mine enemies wrongfully rejoice over me: [neither] let them wink with the eye that hate me without a cause.

wrongfully [60 1PE 02 19](#) # For this [is] thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God endure grief, suffering wrongfully.

wrongfully [26 EZE 22 29](#) # The people of the land have used oppression, and exercised robbery, and have vexed the poor and needy: yea, they have oppressed the stranger wrongfully.
