wroth against two <u>01\_GEN\_40\_02</u> # And Pharaoh was wroth against two [of] his officers, against the chief of the butlers, and against the chief of the bakers.

wroth against us 25\_LAM\_05\_22 # But thou hast utterly rejected us; thou art very wroth against us.

wroth against you <u>05\_DEU\_09\_19</u># For I was afraid of the anger and hot displeasure, wherewith the LORD was wroth against you to destroy you. But the LORD hearkened unto me at that time also.

wroth and chided <u>01\_GEN\_31\_36</u># And Jacob was wroth, and chided with Laban: and Jacob answered and said to Laban, What [is] my trespass? what [is] my sin, that thou hast so hotly pursued after me?

wroth and delivered <u>40\_MAT\_18\_34</u># And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him.

wroth and greatly <u>19\_PSA\_78\_59</u> # When God heard [this], he was wroth, and greatly abhorred Israel:

wroth and had <u>14\_2CH\_26\_19</u> # Then Uzziah was wroth, and [had] a censer in his hand to burn incense: and while he was wroth with the priests, the leprosy even rose up in his forehead before the priests in the house of the LORD, from beside the incense altar.

wroth and he <u>23\_ISA\_57\_17</u> # For the iniquity of his covetousness was I wroth, and smote him: I hid me, and was wroth, and he went on frowardly in the way of his heart.

wroth and he <u>40\_MAT\_22\_07</u># But when the king heard [thereof], he was wroth: and he sent forth his armies, and destroyed those murderers, and burned up their city.

wroth and his <u>17\_EST\_01\_12</u># But the queen Vashti refused to come at the king's commandment by [his] chamberlains: therefore was the king very wroth, and his anger burned in him.

wroth and his <u>01\_GEN\_04\_05</u># But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell.

wroth and said <u>04\_NUM\_16\_15</u> # And Moses was very wroth, and said unto the LORD, Respect not thou their offering: I have not taken one ass from them, neither have I hurt one of them.

wroth and sent <u>40\_MAT\_02\_16</u># Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the wise men, was exceeding wroth, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently inquired of the wise men.

wroth and smote <u>23\_ISA\_57\_17</u> # For the iniquity of his covetousness was I wroth, and smote him: I hid me, and was wroth, and he went on frowardly in the way of his heart.

wroth and sought <u>17\_EST\_02\_21</u> # In those days, while Mordecai sat in the king's gate, two of the king's chamberlains, Bigthan and Teresh, of those which kept the door, were wroth, and sought to lay hand on the king Ahasuerus.

wroth and sware <u>05\_DEU\_01\_34</u># And the LORD heard the voice of your words, and was wroth, and

sware, saying,

wroth and the <u>09\_1SA\_18\_08</u># And Saul was very wroth, and the saying displeased him; and he said, They have ascribed unto David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed [but] thousands: and [what] can he have more but the kingdom?

wroth and took <u>16\_NEH\_04\_01</u># But it came to pass, that when Sanballat heard that we builded the wall, he was wroth, and took great indignation, and mocked the Jews.

wroth and went <u>12\_2KI\_05\_11</u># But Naaman was wroth, and went away, and said, Behold, I thought, He will surely come out to me, and stand, and call on the name of the LORD his God, and strike his hand over the place, and recover the leper.

wroth and why <u>01\_GEN\_04\_06</u># And the LORD said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen?

wroth as in <u>23\_ISA\_28\_21</u># For the LORD shall rise up as [in] mount Perazim, he shall be wroth as [in] the valley of Gibeon, that he may do his work, his strange work; and bring to pass his act, his strange act.

wroth because he <u>01\_GEN\_34\_07</u> # And the sons of Jacob came out of the field when they heard [it]: and the men were grieved, and they were very wroth, because he had wrought folly in Israel in lying with Jacob's daughter; which thing ought not to be done.

wroth for the <u>10\_2SA\_03\_08</u># Then was Abner very wroth for the words of Ishbosheth, and said, [Am] I a dog's head, which against Judah do show kindness this day unto the house of Saul thy father, to his brethren, and to his friends, and have not delivered thee into the hand of David, that thou chargest me to day with a fault concerning this woman?

wroth for the <u>23\_ISA\_57\_16</u># For I will not contend for ever, neither will I be always wroth: for the spirit should fail before me, and the souls [which] I have made.

wroth for we <u>23\_ISA\_64\_05</u> # Thou meetest him that rejoiceth and worketh righteousness, [those that] remember thee in thy ways: behold, thou art wroth; for we have sinned: in those is continuance, and we shall be saved.

wroth so a <u>19\_PSA\_78\_21</u># Therefore the LORD heard [this], and was wroth: so a fire was kindled against Jacob, and anger also came up against Israel;

wroth then be <u>09\_18A\_20\_07</u># If he say thus, [It is] well; thy servant shall have peace: but if he be very wroth, [then] be sure that evil is determined by him.

wroth very sore <u>23\_ISA\_64\_09</u> # Be not wroth very sore, O LORD, neither remember iniquity for ever: behold, see, we beseech thee, we [are] all thy people.

wroth with all <u>04\_NUM\_16\_22</u> # And they fell upon their faces, and said, O God, the God of the spirits of all flesh, shall one man sin, and wilt thou be wroth with all the congregation?

wroth with him <u>09\_1SA\_29\_04</u> # And the princes of the Philistines were wroth with him; and the princes of the Philistines said unto him, Make this fellow return, that he may go again to his place which thou hast appointed him, and let him not go down with us to battle, lest in the battle he be an adversary to us: for wherewith should he reconcile himself unto his master? [should it] not [be] with the heads of these men?

wroth with him <u>12\_2KI\_13\_19</u> # And the man of God was wroth with him, and said, Thou shouldest have smitten five or six times; then hadst thou smitten Syria till thou hadst consumed [it]: whereas now thou shalt smite Syria [but] thrice.

wroth with his <u>01\_GEN\_41\_10</u> # Pharaoh was wroth with his servants, and put me in ward in the captain of the guard's house, [both] me and the chief baker:

wroth with his <u>19\_PSA\_78\_62</u># He gave his people over also unto the sword; and was wroth with his inheritance.

wroth with Jeremiah <u>24\_JER\_37\_15</u> # Wherefore the princes were wroth with Jeremiah, and smote him, and put him in prison in the house of Jonathan the scribe: for they had made that the prison.

wroth with Judah <u>14\_2CH\_28\_09</u> # But a prophet of the LORD was there, whose name [was] Oded: and he went out before the host that came to Samaria, and said unto them, Behold, because the LORD God of your fathers was wroth with Judah, he hath delivered them into your hand, and ye have slain them in a rage [that] reacheth up unto heaven.

wroth with me <u>05\_DEU\_03\_26</u> # But the LORD was wroth with me for your sakes, and would not hear me: and the LORD said unto me, Let it suffice thee; speak no more unto me of this matter.

wroth with my <u>23\_ISA\_47\_06</u># I was wroth with my people, I have polluted mine inheritance, and given them into thine hand: thou didst show them no mercy; upon the ancient hast thou very heavily laid thy yoke.

wroth with the <u>14\_2CH\_16\_10</u> # Then Asa was wroth with the seer, and put him in a prison house; for [he was] in a rage with him because of this [thing]. And Asa oppressed [some] of the people the same time.

wroth with the <u>14\_2CH\_26\_19</u> # Then Uzziah was wroth, and [had] a censer in his hand to burn incense: and while he was wroth with the priests, the leprosy even rose up in his forehead before the priests in the house of the LORD, from beside the incense altar.

wroth with the <u>06\_JOS\_22\_18</u># But that ye must turn away this day from following the LORD? and it will be, [seeing] ye rebel to day against the LORD, that to morrow he will be wroth with the whole congregation of Israel.

wroth with the <u>04\_NUM\_31\_14</u> # And Moses was wroth with the officers of the host, [with] the captains over thousands, and captains over hundreds, which came from the battle.

wroth with the <u>66\_REV\_12\_17</u># And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

wroth with thee <u>23\_ISA\_54\_09</u># For this [is as] the waters of Noah unto me: for [as] I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth; so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with thee, nor rebuke thee.

wroth with them <u>02\_EXO\_16\_20</u># Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto Moses; but some of them left of it until the morning, and it bred worms, and stank: and Moses was wroth with them.

wroth with thine <u>19\_PSA\_89\_38</u># But thou hast cast off and abhorred, thou hast been wroth with thine anointed.

wroth <u>10\_2SA\_13\_21</u> # But when king David heard of all these things, he was very wroth.

wroth <u>10\_2SA\_22\_08</u> # Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations of heaven moved and shook, because he was wroth.

wroth 16\_NEH\_04\_07 # But it came to pass, [that] when Sanballat, and Tobiah, and the Arabians, and the

Ammonites, and the Ashdodites, heard that the walls of Jerusalem were made up, [and] that the breaches began to be stopped, then they were very wroth,
