yoke and burst 24 JER 02 20 # For of old time I have broken thy yoke, [and] burst thy bands; and thou saidst, I will not transgress; when upon every high hill and under every green tree thou wanderest, playing the harlot.

yoke and burst 24 JER_05_05 # I will get me unto the great men, and will speak unto them; for they have known the way of the LORD, [and] the judgment of their God: but these have altogether broken the yoke, [and] burst the bonds.

yoke and delivered <u>26_EZE_34_27</u> # And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them.

yoke and made <u>03_LEV_26_13</u> # I [am] the LORD your God, which brought you forth out of the land of Egypt, that ye should not be their bondmen; and I have broken the bands of your yoke, and made you go upright.

yoke and tie <u>09_1SA_06_07</u># Now therefore make a new cart, and take two milch kine, on which there hath come no yoke, and tie the kine to the cart, and bring their calves home from them:

yoke count their <u>54_1TI_06_01</u># Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honour, that the name of God and [his] doctrine be not blasphemed.

yoke depart from <u>23_ISA_14_25</u> # That I will break the Assyrian in my land, and upon my mountains tread him under foot: then shall his yoke depart from off them, and his burden depart from off their shoulders.

yoke from off <u>01_GEN_27_40</u> # And by thy sword shalt thou live, and shalt serve thy brother; and it shall come to pass when thou shalt have the dominion, that thou shalt break his yoke from off thy neck.

yoke from off <u>23_ISA_10_27</u> # And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] his burden shall be taken away from off thy shoulder, and his yoke from off thy neck, and the yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing.

yoke from off <u>24_JER_28_10</u> # Then Hananiah the prophet took the yoke from off the prophet Jeremiah's neck, and brake it.

yoke from off <u>24_JER_28_12</u> # Then the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah [the prophet], after that Hananiah the prophet had broken the yoke from off the neck of the prophet Jeremiah, saying,

yoke from off <u>24_JER_30_08</u># For it shall come to pass in that day, saith the LORD of hosts, [that] I will break his yoke from off thy neck, and will burst thy bonds, and strangers shall no more serve themselves of him:

yoke from off <u>34_NAH_01_13</u># For now will I break his yoke from off thee, and will burst thy bonds in sunder.

yoke grievous now 11_1KI_12_04 # Thy father made our yoke grievous: now therefore make thou the grievous service of thy father, and his heavy yoke which he put upon us, lighter, and we will serve thee.

yoke grievous now 14_2CH_10_04# Thy father made our yoke grievous: now therefore ease thou somewhat the grievous servitude of thy father, and his heavy yoke that he put upon us, and we will serve thee.

yoke heavy and <u>11_1KI_12_14</u># And spake to them after the counsel of the young men, saying, My father made your yoke heavy, and I will add to your yoke: my father [also] chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scorpions.

yoke heavy but 11_1KI_12_10# And the young men that were grown up with him spake unto him, saying, Thus shalt thou speak unto this people that spake unto thee, saying, Thy father made our yoke heavy, but make thou [it] lighter unto us; thus shalt thou say unto them, My little [finger] shall be thicker than my father's loins.

yoke heavy but 14_2CH_10_10 # And the young men that were brought up with him spake unto him, saying, Thus shalt thou answer the people that spake unto thee, saying, Thy father made our yoke heavy, but make thou [it] somewhat lighter for us; thus shalt thou say unto them, My little [finger] shall be thicker than my father's loins.

yoke heavy but 14 2CH 10 14 # And answered them after the advice of the young men, saying, My father made your yoke heavy, but I will add thereto: my father chastised you with whips, but I [will chastise you] with scorpions.

yoke I will <u>11_1KI_12_11</u># And now whereas my father did lade you with a heavy yoke, I will add to your yoke: my father hath chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scorpions.

yoke in his 25_LAM_03_27 # [It is] good for a man that he bear the yoke in his youth.

yoke is easy 40_MAT_11_30# For my yoke [is] easy, and my burden is light.

yoke my father 11_1KI_12_11# And now whereas my father did lade you with a heavy yoke, I will add to your yoke: my father hath chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scorpions.

yoke my father 11_1KI_12_14# And spake to them after the counsel of the young men, saying, My father made your yoke heavy, and I will add to your yoke: my father [also] chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scorpions.

yoke my father 14_2CH_10_11# For whereas my father put a heavy yoke upon you, I will put more to your yoke: my father chastised you with whips, but I [will chastise you] with scorpions.

yoke of bondage <u>48_GAL_05_01</u> # Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

yoke of his <u>23_ISA_09_04</u> # For thou hast broken the yoke of his burden, and the staff of his shoulder, the rod of his oppressor, as in the day of Midian.

yoke of iron <u>05_DEU_28_48</u> # Therefore shalt thou serve thine enemies which the LORD shall send against thee, in hunger, and in thirst, and in nakedness, and in want of all [things]: and he shall put a yoke of iron upon thy neck, until he have destroyed thee.

yoke of iron 24 JER 28 14 # For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; I have put a yoke of iron upon the neck of all these nations, that they may serve Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon; and they shall serve him: and I have given him the beasts of the field also.

yoke of my <u>25_LAM_01_14</u># The yoke of my transgressions is bound by his hand: they are wreathed, [and] come up upon my neck: he hath made my strength to fall, the Lord hath delivered me into [their] hands,

[from whom] I am not able to rise up.

yoke of Nebuchadnezzar <u>24_JER_28_11</u># And Hananiah spake in the presence of all the people, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Even so will I break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon from the neck of all nations within the space of two full years. And the prophet Jeremiah went his way.

yoke of oxen <u>11_1KI_19_19</u># So he departed thence, and found Elisha the son of Shaphat, who [was] plowing [with] twelve yoke [of oxen] before him, and he with the twelfth: and Elijah passed by him, and cast his mantle upon him.

yoke of oxen <u>11_1KI_19_21</u># And he returned back from him, and took a yoke of oxen, and slew them, and boiled their flesh with the instruments of the oxen, and gave unto the people, and they did eat. Then he arose, and went after Elijah, and ministered unto him.

yoke of oxen <u>09_1SA_11_07</u># And he took a yoke of oxen, and hewed them in pieces, and sent [them] throughout all the coasts of Israel by the hands of messengers, saying, Whosoever cometh not forth after Saul and after Samuel, so shall it be done unto his oxen. And the fear of the LORD fell on the people, and they came out with one consent.

yoke of oxen <u>09_1SA_14_14</u> # And that first slaughter, which Jonathan and his armourbearer made, was about twenty men, within as it were an half acre of land, [which] a yoke [of oxen might plow].

yoke of oxen <u>24_JER_51_23</u> # I will also break in pieces with thee the shepherd and his flock; and with thee will I break in pieces the husbandman and his yoke of oxen; and with thee will I break in pieces captains and rulers.

yoke of oxen <u>18_JOB_01_03</u> # His substance also was seven thousand sheep, and three thousand camels, and five hundred yoke of oxen, and five hundred she asses, and a very great household; so that this man was the greatest of all the men of the east.

yoke of oxen <u>18_JOB_42_12</u> # So the LORD blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning: for he had fourteen thousand sheep, and six thousand camels, and a thousand yoke of oxen, and a thousand she asses.

yoke of oxen <u>42_LUK_14_19</u># And another said, I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I go to prove them: I pray thee have me excused.

yoke of the 24_JER_27_08 # And it shall come to pass, [that] the nation and kingdom which will not serve the same Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and that will not put their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation will I punish, saith the LORD, with the sword, and with the famine, and with the pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand.

yoke of the <u>24_JER_27_11</u># But the nations that bring their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, and serve him, those will I let remain still in their own land, saith the LORD; and they shall till it, and dwell therein.

yoke of the <u>24_JER_27_12</u># I spake also to Zedekiah king of Judah according to all these words, saying, Bring your necks under the yoke of the king of Babylon, and serve him and his people, and live.

yoke of the <u>24_JER_28_02</u> # Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saying, I have broken the yoke of the king of Babylon.

yoke of the <u>24_JER_28_04</u> # And I will bring again to this place Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, with all the captives of Judah, that went into Babylon, saith the LORD: for I will break the yoke of the king of Babylon.

yoke on their <u>28_HOS_11_04</u># I drew them with cords of a man, with bands of love: and I was to them as they that take off the yoke on their jaws, and I laid meat unto them.

yoke that thy <u>14_2CH_10_09</u> # And he said unto them, What advice give ye that we may return answer to this people, which have spoken to me, saying, Ease somewhat the yoke that thy father did put upon us?

yoke the putting <u>23_ISA_58_09</u> # Then shalt thou call, and the LORD shall answer; thou shalt cry, and he shall say, Here I [am]. If thou take away from the midst of thee the yoke, the putting forth of the finger, and speaking vanity;

yoke turn thou <u>24_JER_31_18</u># I have surely heard Ephraim bemoaning himself [thus]; Thou hast chastised me, and I was chastised, as a bullock unaccustomed [to the yoke]: turn thou me, and I shall be turned; for thou [art] the LORD my God.

yoke upon the <u>44_ACT_15_10</u> # Now therefore why tempt ye God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear?

yoke upon you 14_2CH_10_11 # For whereas my father put a heavy yoke upon you, I will put more to your yoke: my father chastised you with whips, but I [will chastise you] with scorpions.

yoke upon you <u>40_MAT_11_29</u># Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

yoke which he <u>11_1KI_12_04</u># Thy father made our yoke grievous: now therefore make thou the grievous service of thy father, and his heavy yoke which he put upon us, lighter, and we will serve thee.

yoke which thy <u>11_1KI_12_09</u># And he said unto them, What counsel give ye that we may answer this people, who have spoken to me, saying, Make the yoke which thy father did put upon us lighter?

yoke <u>05_DEU_21_03</u> # And it shall be, [that] the city [which is] next unto the slain man, even the elders of that city shall take an heifer, which hath not been wrought with, [and] which hath not drawn in the yoke;

yoke <u>23_ISA_47_06</u># I was wroth with my people, I have polluted mine inheritance, and given them into thine hand: thou didst show them no mercy; upon the ancient hast thou very heavily laid thy yoke.

yoke <u>23_ISA_58_06</u> # [Is] not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?

yoke <u>04_NUM_19_02</u> # This [is] the ordinance of the law which the LORD hath commanded, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, that they bring thee a red heifer without spot, wherein [is] no blemish, [and] upon which never came yoke:

yoked together with <u>47_2CO_06_14</u> # Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

yokefellow help those <u>50_PHP_04_03</u># And I entreat thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which laboured with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and [with] other my fellowlabourers, whose names [are]

in the book of life.

yokes and put <u>24_JER_27_02</u> # Thus saith the LORD to me; Make thee bonds and yokes, and put them upon thy neck,

yokes of Egypt <u>26_EZE_30_18</u># At Tehaphnehes also the day shall be darkened, when I shall break there the yokes of Egypt: and the pomp of her strength shall cease in her: as for her, a cloud shall cover her, and her daughters shall go into captivity.

yokes of iron 24 JER 28 13 # Go and tell Hananiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Thou hast broken the yokes of wood; but thou shalt make for them yokes of iron.
