- 01_GEN_44_01 [And he commanded the steward of his house, saying, fill the men's sacks \[with\] food, as much as they can carry. And put every man's money in his sack's mouth.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_02 [And put my cup, the silver cup, in the sack's mouth of the youngest. And his corn money. And he did according to the word that Joseph had spoken.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_03 [as soon as the morning was light, the men were sent away, they And their asses.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_04 [\[And\] when they were gone out of the city, \[And\] not \[yet\] far off, Joseph said unto his steward, up, follow after the men; And when thou dost overtake them, say unto them, Wherefore have ye rewarded evil for good?](#)
- 01_GEN_44_05 [\[Is\] not this \[it\] in which my LORD drinketh, And whereby indeed he divineth? ye have done evil in So doing.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_06 [And he overtook them, And he spake unto them These same words.](#)

- 01_GEN_44_08 [behold, the money, which we found in our sacks' mouths, we brought again unto thee out of the land of Canaan: how Then should we steal out of thy LORD's house silver or gold?](#)
- 01_GEN_44_09 [with whomsoever of thy servants it be found, Both let him die. And we also will be my LORD's bondmen.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_10 [And he said, now also \[let\] it \[be\] according unto your words: he with whom it Is found shall be my servant; And ye shall be blameless.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_11 [Then they speedily took down every man his sack to the ground, And opened every man his sack.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_12 [And he searched, \[And\] began at the eldest, And left at the youngest: And the cup was found in Benjamin's sack.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_13 [Then they rent their clothes, And laded every man his ass, And returned to the city.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_14 [And Judah And his brethren came to Joseph's house; for he \[was\] yet there: And they fell before him on the ground.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_15 [And Joseph said unto them, what deed \[Is\] this that ye have done? wot ye not that such A man as I can certainly divine?](#)
- 01_GEN_44_16 [And Judah said, what shall we say unto my LORD? what shall we speak? or how shall we clear ourselves? God hath found out the iniquity of thy servants: behold, we \[are\] my LORD's servants, Both we, And \[he\] also with whom the cup Is found.](#)

- 01_GEN_44_23 [And thou saidst unto thy servants, except your youngest brother come down with you, ye shall see my face no more.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_24 [And it came to pass when we came up unto thy servant my Father, we told him the words of my LORD.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_25 [And our Father said, go again, \[And\] buy us A little food.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_26 [And we said, we cannot go down: if our youngest brother be with us, Then will we go down: for we may not see the man's face, except our youngest brother \[be\] with us.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_27 [And thy servant my Father said unto us, ye know that my wife bare me two \[sons\]:](#)
- 01_GEN_44_28 [And the one went out from me, And I said, surely he Is torn in pieces; And I saw him not since;](#)
- 01_GEN_44_29 [And if ye take this also from me, And mischief befall him, ye shall bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_30 [now therefore when I come to thy servant my Father, And the lad \[be\] not with us; seeing that his life Is bound up in the lad's life;](#)
- 01_GEN_44_31 [it shall come to pass, when he seeth that the lad \[Is\] not \[with us\], that he will die; And thy servants shall bring down the gray hairs of thy servant our Father with sorrow to the grave.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_32 [for thy servant became surety for the lad unto my Father, saying, if I bring him not unto thee, Then I shall bear the blame to my Father for ever.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_33 [now therefore, I pray thee, let thy servant abide instead of the lad A bondman to my LORD; And let the lad go up with his brethren.](#)
- 01_GEN_44_34 [for how shall I go up to my Father, And the lad \[be\] not with me? lest peradventure I see the evil that shall come on my Father.](#)
