- 02\_EXO\_02\_01 [And there went A man of the house of Levi, And took \[ to wife\] A daughter of Levi.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_02\_02 [And the woman conceived, And bare A son: And when she saw him that he \[ was A\] goodly \[ child\], she hid him three months.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_02\_03 [And when she could not longer hide him, she took for him an ark of bulrushes, And daubed it with slime And with pitch, And put the child therein; And she laid \[ it\] in the flags by the river's brink.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_02\_04 [And his sister stood afar off, to wit what would be done to him.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_02\_05 [And the daughter of Pharaoh came down to Wash \[ herself\] at the river; And her maidens walked along by the river's side; And when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_02\_06 [And when she had opened \[ it\], she saw the child: And, behold, the babe wept. And she had compassion on him, And said, this \[ Is one\] of the Hebrews' children.](#)

- 02\_EXO\_02\_09 [And Pharaoh's daughter said unto her, take this child away, And nurse it for me, And I will give \[ thee\] thy wages. And the woman took the child, And nursed it.](#)
