- 02\_EXO\_22\_01 [if A man shall steal an ox, or A sheep, And kill it, or sell it; he shall Restore five oxen for an ox, And four sheep for A sheep.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_02 [if A thief be found breaking up, And be smitten that he die, \[ there shall\] no blood \[ be shed\] for him.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_03 [if the sun be risen upon him, \[ there shall be\] blood \[ shed\] for him; \[ for\] he should make full restitution; if he have nothing, Then he shall be sold for his theft.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_04 [if the theft be certainly found in his hand alive, whether it be ox, or ass, or sheep; he shall Restore double.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_05 [if A man shall cause A field or vineyard to be eaten, And shall put in his beast, And shall feed in another man's field; of the best of his own field, And of the best of his own vineyard, shall he make restitution.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_06 [if fire break out, And catch in thorns, So that the stacks of corn, or the standing corn, or the field, be consumed \[ therewith\]; he that kindled the fire shall surely make restitution.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_07 [if A man shall deliver unto his neighbour money or stuff to keep, And it be stolen out of the man's house; if the thief be found, let him pay double.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_08 [if the thief be not found, Then the master of the house shall be brought unto the judges, \[ to see\] whether he have put his hand unto his neighbour's goods.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_09 [for all manner of trespass, \[ whether it be\] for ox, for ass, for sheep, for raiment, \[ or\] for any manner of lost thing, which \[ another\] challengeth to be his, the cause of Both parties shall come before the judges; \[ And\] whom the judges shall condemn, he shall pay double unto his neighbour.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_10 [if A man deliver unto his neighbour an ass, or an ox, or A sheep, or any beast, to keep; And it die, or be hurt, or driven away, no man seeing \[ it\];](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_11 [\[ Then\] shall an oath of the LORD be between them Both, that he hath not put his hand unto his neighbour's goods; And the owner of it shall accept \[ thereof\], And he shall not make \[ it\] good.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_12 [And if it be stolen from him, he shall make restitution unto the owner thereof.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_13 [if it be torn in pieces, \[ Then\] let him bring it \[ for\] witness, \[ And\] he shall not make good that which was torn.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_14 [And if A man borrow \[ ought\] of his neighbour, And it be hurt, or die, the owner thereof \[ being\] not with it, he shall surely make \[ it\] good.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_15 [\[ but\] if the owner thereof \[ be\] with it, he shall not make \[ it\] good; if it \[ be\] an hired \[ thing\], it came for his hire.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_16 [And if A man entice A maid that Is not betrothed, And Lie with her, he shall surely endow her to be his wife.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_17 [if her Father utterly refuse to give her unto him, he shall pay money according to the dowry of virgins.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_18 [thou shalt not suffer A witch to live.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_19 [whosoever lieth with A beast shall surely be put to death.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_20 [he that sacrificeth unto \[ any\] God, save unto the LORD only, he shall be utterly destroyed.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_21 [thou shalt neither vex A stranger, nor oppress him; for ye were strangers in the land of Egypt.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_22 [ye shall not afflict any widow, or fatherless child.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_23 [if thou afflict them in any wise, And they cry at all unto me, I will surely hear their cry;](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_24 [And my wrath shall wax hot, And I will kill you with the sword; And your wives shall be widows, And your children fatherless.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_25 [if thou lend money to \[ any of\] my people \[ that Is\] poor by thee, thou shalt not be to him as an usurer, neither shalt thou lay upon him usury.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_26 [if thou at all take thy neighbour's raiment to pledge, thou shalt deliver it unto him by that the sun goeth down;](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_27 [for that \[ Is\] his covering only, it \[ Is\] his raiment for his skin: wherein shall he Sleep? And it shall come to pass, when he crieth unto me, that I will hear; for I \[ am\] gracious.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_28 [thou shalt not revile the gods, nor curse the ruler of thy people.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_29 [thou shalt not delay \[ to offer\] the first of thy ripe fruits, And of thy liquors: the firstborn of thy sons shalt thou give unto me.](#)
- 02\_EXO\_22\_30 [Likewise shalt thou do with thine oxen, \[ And\] with thy sheep; seven days it shall be with his dam; on the eighth day thou shalt give it me.](#)
