[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_01 Maschil of Asaph. give ear, O my people, \[ to\] my law: incline your ears to the words of my mouth.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_02 I will open my mouth in A parable: I will utter dark sayings of old:](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_03 which we have heard And known, And our fathers have told us.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_04 we will not hide \[ them\] from their children, showing to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, And his strength, And his wonderful works that he hath done.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_05 for he established A testimony in Jacob, And appointed A law in Israel, which he commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children:](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_06 that the generation to come might know \[ them, even\] the children \[ which\] should be born; \[ who\] should Arise And declare \[ them\] to their children:](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_07 that they might set their hope in God, And not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments:](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_08 And might not be as their fathers, A stubborn And rebellious generation; A generation \[ that\] set not their heart aright, And whose spirit was not stedfast with God.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_09 the children of Ephraim, \[ being\] armed, \[ And\] carrying bows, turned back in the day of battle.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_10 they kept not the covenant of God, And refused to walk in his law;](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_11 And forgat his works, And his wonders that he had showed them.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_12 marvellous things did he in the sight of their fathers, in the land of Egypt, \[ in\] the field of Zoan.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_13 he divided the sea, And caused them to pass through; And he made the waters to stand as an heap.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_14 in the daytime also he led them with A cloud, And all the night with A light of fire.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_15 he clave the rocks in the wilderness, And gave \[ them\] drink as \[ out of\] the great depths.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_16 he brought streams also out of the rock, And caused waters to run down like rivers.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_17 And they sinned yet more against him by provoking the most high in the wilderness.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_18 And they tempted God in their heart by asking meat for their lust.](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_19 yea, they spake against God; they said, can God furnish A table in the wilderness?](#)

[19\\_PSA\\_78\\_20 behold, he smote the rock, that the waters gushed out, And the streams overflowed; can he give bread also? can he provide flesh for his people?](#)

19\_PSA\_78\_21 therefore the LORD heard [ this], And was wroth: So A fire was kindled against Jacob, And anger also came up against Israel;

19\_PSA\_78\_22 because they believed not in God, And trusted not in his salvation:

19\_PSA\_78\_23 though he had commanded the clouds from above, And opened the doors of heaven,

19\_PSA\_78\_24 And had rained down manna upon them to eat, And had given them of the corn of heaven.

19\_PSA\_78\_25 man did eat angels' food: he sent them meat to the full.

19\_PSA\_78\_26 he caused an east wind to blow in the heaven: And by his power he brought in the south wind.

19\_PSA\_78\_27 he rained flesh also upon them as dust, And feathered fowls like as the sand of the sea:

19\_PSA\_78\_28 And he let [ it] fall in the midst of their camp, round about their habitations.

19\_PSA\_78\_29 So they did eat, And were Well filled: for he gave them their own desire;

19\_PSA\_78\_30 they were not estranged from their lust. but while their meat [ was] yet in their mouths,

19\_PSA\_78\_31 the wrath of God came upon them, And slew the fattest of them, And smote down the chosen [ men] of Israel.

19\_PSA\_78\_32 for all this they sinned still, And believed not for his wondrous works.

19\_PSA\_78\_33 therefore their days did he consume in vanity, And their years in Trouble.

19\_PSA\_78\_34 when he slew them, Then they sought him: And they returned And inquired early after God.

19\_PSA\_78\_35 And they remembered that God [ was] their rock, And the high God their Redeemer.

19\_PSA\_78\_36 Nevertheless they did flatter him with their mouth, And they lied unto him with their tongues.

19\_PSA\_78\_37 for their heart was not right with him, neither were they stedfast in his covenant.

19\_PSA\_78\_38 but he, [ being] full of compassion, forgave [ their] iniquity, And destroyed [ them] not: yea, Many A time turned he his anger away, And did not stir up all his wrath.

19\_PSA\_78\_39 for he remembered that they [ were but] flesh; A wind that passeth away, And cometh not again.

19\_PSA\_78\_40 how oft did they provoke him in the wilderness, [ And] grieve him in the desert !

19\_PSA\_78\_41 yea, they turned back And tempted God, And limited the holy one of Israel.

19\_PSA\_78\_42 they remembered not his hand, [ nor] the day when he delivered them from the enemy.

19\_PSA\_78\_43 how he had wrought his signs in Egypt, And his wonders in the field of Zoan:

19\_PSA\_78\_44 And had turned their rivers into blood; And their floods, that they could not drink.

19\_PSA\_78\_45 he sent divers sorts of flies among them, which devoured them; And frogs, which destroyed them.

19\_PSA\_78\_46 he gave also their increase unto the caterpillar, And their labour unto the locust.

19\_PSA\_78\_47 he destroyed their vines with hail, And their sycamore trees with frost.

19\_PSA\_78\_48 he gave up their cattle also to the hail, And their flocks to hot thunderbolts.

19\_PSA\_78\_49 he cast upon them the fierceness of his anger, wrath, And indignation, And Trouble, by sending evil angels [ among them].

19\_PSA\_78\_50 he made A way to his anger; he spared not their soul from death, but gave their life over to the pestilence;

19\_PSA\_78\_51 And smote all the firstborn in Egypt; the chief of [ their] strength in the tabernacles of Ham:

19\_PSA\_78\_52 but made his own people to go forth like sheep, And guided them in the wilderness like A flock.

19\_PSA\_78\_53 And he led them on safely, So that they feared not: but the sea overwhelmed their enemies.

19\_PSA\_78\_54 And he brought them to the border of his sanctuary, [ even to] this mountain, [ which] his right hand had purchased.

19\_PSA\_78\_55 he cast out the heathen also before them, And divided them an inheritance by line, And made the tribes of Israel to dwell in their tents.

19\_PSA\_78\_56 yet they tempted And provoked the most high God, And kept not his testimonies:

19\_PSA\_78\_57 but turned back, And dealt unfaithfully like their fathers: they were turned aside like A deceitful bow.

19\_PSA\_78\_58 for they provoked him to anger with their high places, And moved him to jealousy with their graven images.

19\_PSA\_78\_59 when God heard [ this], he was wroth, And greatly abhorred Israel:

19\_PSA\_78\_60 So that he forsook the tabernacle of Shiloh, the tent [ which] he placed among men;

19\_PSA\_78\_61 And delivered his strength into captivity, And his glory into the enemy's hand.

19\_PSA\_78\_62 he gave his people over also unto the sword; And was wroth with his inheritance.

19\_PSA\_78\_63 the fire consumed their young men; And their maidens were not given to marriage.

19\_PSA\_78\_64 their priests fell by the sword; And their widows made no lamentation.

19\_PSA\_78\_65 Then the LORD awaked as one out of Sleep, [ And] like A mighty man that shouteth by reason of wine.

19\_PSA\_78\_66 And he smote his enemies in the hinder parts: he put them to A perpetual reproach.

**19\_PSA\_78\_67 moreover he refused the tabernacle of Joseph, And chose not the tribe of Ephraim:**

**19\_PSA\_78\_68 but chose the tribe of Judah, the mount Zion which he loved.**

**19\_PSA\_78\_69 And he built his sanctuary like high [ palaces], like the earth which he hath established for ever.**

**19\_PSA\_78\_70 he chose David also his servant, And took him from the sheepfolds:**

**19\_PSA\_78\_71 from following the ewes great with young he brought him to feed Jacob his people, And Israel his inheritance.**

**19\_PSA\_78\_72 So he fed them according to the integrity of his heart; And guided them by the skilfulness of his hands.**
