- 24\_JER\_06\_01 [O ye children of Benjamin, gather yourselves to flee out of the midst of Jerusalem, And blow the trumpet in Tekoa, And set up A sign of fire in Bethhaccerem: for evil appeareth out of the north, And great destruction.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_02 [I have likened the daughter of Zion to A comely And delicate \[ woman\].](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_03 [the shepherds with their flocks shall come unto her; they shall pitch \[ their\] tents against her round about; they shall feed every one in his place.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_04 [prepare ye war against her; Arise, And let us go up at noon, woe unto us ! for the day goeth away, for the shadows of the evening are stretched out.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_05 [Arise, And let us go by night, And let us destroy her palaces.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_06 [for thus hath the LORD of hosts said, Hew ye down trees, And cast A mount against Jerusalem: this \[ Is\] the city to be visited; she \[ Is\] wholly oppression in the midst of her.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_07 [as A fountain casteth out her waters, So she casteth out her wickedness: violence And spoil Is heard in her; before me continually \[ Is\] grief And wounds.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_08 [be thou instructed, O Jerusalem, lest my soul Depart from thee; lest I make thee desolate, A land not inhabited.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_09 [thus saith the LORD of hosts, they shall thoroughly glean the remnant of Israel as A vine: turn back thine hand as A grapegatherer into the baskets.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_10 [to whom shall I speak, And give warning, that they may hear? behold, their ear \[ Is\] uncircumcised, And they cannot hearken; behold, the word of the LORD Is unto them A reproach; they have no delight in it.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_11 [therefore I am full of the fury of the LORD; I am weary with holding in: I will Pour it out upon the children abroad, And upon the assembly of young men together: for even the husband with the wife shall be taken, the aged with \[ him that Is\] full of days.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_12 [And their houses shall be turned unto others, \[ with their\] fields And wives together: for I will stretch out my hand upon the inhabitants of the land, saith the LORD.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_13 [for from the least of them even unto the greatest of them every one \[ Is\] given to covetousness; And from the prophet even unto the priest every one dealeth falsely.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_14 [they have healed also the hurt \[ of the daughter\] of my people slightly, saving, peace, peace; when \[ there Is\] no peace.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_15 [were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? Nay, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush: therefore they shall fall among them that fall: at the time \[ that\] I visit them they shall be cast down, saith the LORD.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_16 [thus saith the LORD, stand ye in the ways, And see, And ask for the old paths, where \[ Is\] the good way, And walk therein, And ye shall find rest for your souls, but they said, we will not walk \[ therein\].](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_17 [also I set watchmen over you, \[ saving\], hearken to the sound of the trumpet, but they said, we will not hearken.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_18 [therefore hear, ye nations, And know, O congregation, what \[ Is\] among them.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_19 [hear, O earth; behold, I will bring evil upon this people, \[ even\] the fruit of their thoughts, because they have not hearkened unto my words, nor to my law, but rejected it.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_20 [to what purpose cometh there to me incense from Sheba, And the sweet cane from A far country? your burnt offerings \[ are\] not acceptable, nor your sacrifices sweet unto me.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_21 [therefore thus saith the LORD, behold, I will lay stumblingblocks before this people, And the fathers And the sons together shall fall upon them; the neighbour And his friend shall perish.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_22 [thus saith the LORD, behold, A people cometh from the north country, And A great nation shall be raised from the sides of the earth.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_23 [they shall lay hold on bow And spear; they \[ are\] cruel, And have no mercy; their voice roareth like the sea; And they ride upon horses, set in array as men for war against thee, O daughter of Zion.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_24 [we have heard the fame thereof: our hands wax feeble; anguish hath taken hold of us, \[ And\] pain, as of A woman in travail.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_25 [go not forth into the field, nor walk by the way; for the sword of the enemy \[ And\] Fear \[ Is\] on every side.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_26 [O daughter of my people, gird \[ thee\] with sackcloth, And wallow thyself in ashes: make thee mourning, \[ as for\] an only son, most bitter lamentation: for the spoiler shall suddenly come upon us.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_27 [I have set thee \[ for\] A tower \[ And\] A fortress among my people, that thou mayest know And try their way.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_28 [they \[ are\] all grievous revolvers, walking with slanders: \[ they are\] brass And iron; they \[ are\] all corrupters.](#)
- 24\_JER\_06\_29 [the bellows are burned, the lead Is consumed of the fire; the founder melteth in vain: for the wicked are not plucked away.](#)
