[24\\_JER\\_48\\_01](#) [against Moab thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; woe unto Nebo ! for it Is spoiled: Kiriathaim Is confounded \[ And\] taken: Misgab Is confounded And dismayed.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_02](#) [\[ there shall be\] no more praise of Moab: in Heshbon they have devised evil against it; come, And let us cut it off from \[ being\] A nation. also thou shalt be cut down, O Madmen; the sword shall pursue thee.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_03](#) [A voice of crying \[ shall be\] from Horonaim, spoiling And great destruction.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_04](#) [Moab Is destroyed; her little ones have caused A cry to be heard.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_05](#) [for in the going up of Luhith continual weeping shall go up; for in the going down of Horonaim the enemies have heard A cry of destruction.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_06](#) [flee, save your lives, And be like the heath in the wilderness.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_07](#) [for because thou hast trusted in thy works And in thy treasures, thou shalt also be taken: And Chemosh shall go forth into captivity \[ with\] his priests And his princes together.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_08](#) [And the spoiler shall come upon every city, And no city shall escape: the valley also shall perish, And the plain shall be destroyed, as the LORD hath spoken.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_09](#) [give wings unto Moab, that it may flee And get away: for the cities thereof shall be desolate, without any to dwell therein.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_10](#) [Cursed \[ be\] he that doeth the work of the LORD deceitfully, And Cursed \[ be\] he that keepeth back his sword from blood.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_11](#) [Moab hath been at ease from his youth, And he hath settled on his lees, And hath not been emptied from vessel to vessel, neither hath he gone into captivity: therefore his taste remained in him, And his scent Is not changed.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_12](#) [therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will send unto him wanderers, that shall cause him to wander, And shall empty his vessels, And break their bottles.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_13](#) [And Moab shall be ashamed of Chemosh, as the house of Israel was ashamed of Bethel their confidence.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_14](#) [how say ye, we \[ are\] mighty And strong men for the war?](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_15](#) [Moab Is spoiled, And gone up \[ out of\] her cities, And his chosen young men are gone down to the slaughter, saith the king, whose name \[ Is\] the LORD of hosts.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_16](#) [the calamity of Moab \[ Is\] near to come, And his affliction hasteth fast.](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_17](#) [all ye that are about him, bemoan him; And all ye that know his name, say, how Is the strong staff broken, \[ And\] the beautiful rod !](#)

[24\\_JER\\_48\\_18](#) [thou daughter that dost inhabit Dibon, come down from \[ thy\] glory, And sit in thirst; for](#)

the spoiler of Moab shall come upon thee, [ And] he shall destroy thy strong holds.

24\_JER\_48\_19 O inhabitant of Aroer, stand by the way, And espy; ask him that fleeth, And her that escapeth, [ And] say, what Is done?

24\_JER\_48\_20 Moab Is confounded; for it Is broken down: howl And cry; tell ye it in Arnon, that Moab Is spoiled,

24\_JER\_48\_21 And judgment Is come upon the plain country; upon Holon, And upon Jahazah, And upon Mephaath,

24\_JER\_48\_22 And upon Dibon, And upon Nebo, And upon Bethdiblathaim,

24\_JER\_48\_23 And upon Kiriathaim, And upon Bethgamul, And upon Bethmeon,

24\_JER\_48\_24 And upon Kerioth, And upon Bozrah, And upon all the cities of the land of Moab, far or near.

24\_JER\_48\_25 the horn of Moab Is cut off, And his arm Is broken, saith the LORD.

24\_JER\_48\_26 make ye him drunken: for he magnified [ himself] against the LORD: Moab also shall wallow in his vomit, And he also shall be in derision.

24\_JER\_48\_27 for was not Israel A derision unto thee? was he found among thieves? for since thou spakest of him, thou skippedst for joy.

24\_JER\_48\_28 O ye that dwell in Moab, leave the cities, And dwell in the rock, And be like the dove [ that] maketh her nest in the sides of the hole's mouth.

24\_JER\_48\_29 we have heard the pride of Moab, [ he Is exceeding proud] his loftiness, And his arrogancy, And his pride, And the haughtiness of his heart.

24\_JER\_48\_30 I know his wrath, saith the LORD; but [ it shall] not [ be] So; his lies shall not So effect [ it].

24\_JER\_48\_31 therefore will I howl for Moab, And I will cry out for all Moab; [ mine heart] shall mourn for the men of Kirheres.

24\_JER\_48\_32 O vine of Sibmah, I will weep for thee with the weeping of Jazer: thy plants are gone over the sea, they reach [ even] to the sea of Jazer: the spoiler Is fallen upon thy summer fruits And upon thy vintage.

24\_JER\_48\_33 And joy And gladness Is taken from the plentiful field, And from the land of Moab; And I have caused wine to fail from the winepresses: none shall tread with shouting; [ their] shouting [ shall be] no shouting.

24\_JER\_48\_34 from the cry of Heshbon [ even] unto Elealeh, [ And even] unto Jahaz, have they uttered their voice, from Zoar [ even] unto Horonaim, [ as] an heifer of three years old: for the waters also of Nimrim shall be desolate.

24\_JER\_48\_35 moreover I will cause to cease in Moab, saith the LORD, him that offereth in the high places, And him that burneth incense to his gods.

24\_JER\_48\_36 therefore mine heart shall sound for Moab like pipes, And mine heart shall sound like pipes for the men of Kirheres: because the riches [ that] he hath gotten are perished.

24\_JER\_48\_37 for every head [ shall be] bald, And every beard clipped: upon all the hands [ shall be] cuttings, And upon the loins sackcloth.

24\_JER\_48\_38 [ there shall be] lamentation generally upon all the housetops of Moab, And in the streets thereof: for I have broken Moab like A vessel wherein [ Is] no pleasure, saith the LORD.

24\_JER\_48\_39 they shall howl, [ saying], how Is it broken down ! how hath Moab turned the back with shame ! So shall Moab be A derision And A dismaying to all them about him.

24\_JER\_48\_40 for thus saith the LORD; behold, he shall fly as an eagle, And shall spread his wings over Moab.

24\_JER\_48\_41 Kerioth Is taken, And the strong holds are surprised, And the mighty men's hearts in Moab at that day shall be as the heart of A woman in her pangs.

24\_JER\_48\_42 And Moab shall be destroyed from [ being] A people, because he hath magnified [ himself] against the LORD.

24\_JER\_48\_43 Fear, And the pit, And the snare, [ shall be] upon thee, O inhabitant of Moab, saith the LORD.

24\_JER\_48\_44 he that fleeth from the Fear shall fall into the pit; And he that getteth up out of the pit shall be taken in the snare: for I will bring upon it, [ even] upon Moab, the year of their visitation, saith the LORD.

24\_JER\_48\_45 they that fled stood under the shadow of Heshbon because of the force: but A fire shall come forth out of Heshbon, And A flame from the midst of Sihon, And shall devour the corner of Moab, And the crown of the head of the tumultuous ones.

24\_JER\_48\_46 woe be unto thee, O Moab ! the people of Chemosh perisheth: for thy sons are taken captives, And thy daughters captives.

24\_JER\_48\_47 yet will I bring again the captivity of Moab in the latter days, saith the LORD. thus far [ Is] the judgment of Moab.
