[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_01 And as \[ Jesus\] passed by, he saw A man which was blind from \[ his\] birth.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_02 And his disciples asked him, saying, master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_03 Jesus answered, neither hath this man sinned, nor his parents: but that the works of God should be made manifest in him.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_04 I must work the works of him that sent me, while it Is day: the night cometh, when no man can work.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_05 as long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_06 when he had thus spoken, he spat on the ground, And made clay of the spittle, And he anointed the eyes of the blind man with the clay,](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_07 And said unto him, go, Wash in the pool of Siloam, \[ which Is by interpretation, sent .\] he went his way therefore, And washed, And came seeing.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_08 the neighbours therefore, And they which before had seen him that he was blind, said, Is not this he that sat And begged?](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_09 some said, this Is he: others \[ said\], he Is like him: \[ but\] he said, I am \[ he\].](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_10 therefore said they unto him, how were thine eyes opened?](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_11 he answered And said, A man that Is called Jesus made clay, And anointed mine eyes, And said unto me, go to the pool of Siloam, And Wash: And I went And washed, And I received sight.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_12 Then said they unto him, where Is he? he said, I know not.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_13 they brought to the Pharisees him that aforetime was blind.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_14 And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, And opened his eyes.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_15 Then again the Pharisees also asked him how he had received his sight. he said unto them, he put clay upon mine eyes, And I washed, And do see.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_16 therefore said some of the Pharisees, this man Is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day. others said, how can A man that Is A sinner do such miracles? And there was A division among them.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_17 they say unto the blind man again, what sayest thou of him, that he hath opened thine eyes? he said, he Is A prophet.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_18 but the Jews did not believe concerning him, that he had been blind, And received his sight, until they called the parents of him that had received his sight.](#)

[43\\_JOH\\_09\\_19 And they asked them, saying, Is this your son, who ye say was born blind? how Then Doth](#)

he now see?

43\_JOH\_09\_20 his parents answered them And said, we know that this Is our son, And that he was born blind:

43\_JOH\_09\_21 but by what means he now seeth, we know not; or who hath opened his eyes, we know not: he Is of age; ask him: he shall speak for himself.

43\_JOH\_09\_22 These [ words] spake his parents, because they feared the Jews: for the Jews had agreed already, that if any man did confess that he was Christ, he should be put out of the synagogue.

43\_JOH\_09\_23 therefore said his parents, he Is of age; ask him.

43\_JOH\_09\_24 Then again called they the man that was blind, And said unto him, give God the praise: we know that this man Is A sinner.

43\_JOH\_09\_25 he answered And said, whether he be A sinner [ or no], I know not: one thing I know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see.

43\_JOH\_09\_26 Then said they to him again, what did he to thee? how opened he thine eyes?

43\_JOH\_09\_27 he answered them, I have told you already, And ye did not hear: Wherefore would ye hear [ it] again? will ye also be his disciples?

43\_JOH\_09\_28 Then they reviled him, And said, thou art his disciple; but we are Moses' disciples.

43\_JOH\_09\_29 we know that God spake unto Moses: [ as for] this [ fellow], we know not from whence he Is.

43\_JOH\_09\_30 the man answered And said unto them, why herein Is A marvellous thing, that ye know not from whence he Is, And [ yet] he hath opened mine eyes.

43\_JOH\_09\_31 now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be A worshipper of God, And doeth his will, him he heareth.

43\_JOH\_09\_32 since the world began was it not heard that any man opened the eyes of one that was born blind.

43\_JOH\_09\_33 if this man were not of God, he could do nothing.

43\_JOH\_09\_34 they answered And said unto him, thou wast altogether born in sins, And dost thou teach us? And they cast him out.

43\_JOH\_09\_35 Jesus heard that they had cast him out; And when he had found him, he said unto him, dost thou believe on the son of God?

43\_JOH\_09\_36 he answered And said, who Is he, LORD, that I might believe on him?

43\_JOH\_09\_37 And Jesus said unto him, thou hast Both seen him, And it Is he that talketh with thee.

43\_JOH\_09\_38 And he said, LORD, I believe. And he worshipped him.

43\_JOH\_09\_39 And Jesus said, for judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; And that they which see might be made blind.

43\_JOH\_09\_40 And [ some] of the Pharisees which were with him heard These words, And said unto him, are we blind also?

43\_JOH\_09\_41 Jesus said unto them, if ye were blind, ye should have no sin: but now ye say, we see; therefore your sin remaineth.
