Ahaz and Hezekiah [28 HOS 01 01](#) # The word of the LORD that came unto Hosea, the son of Beer, in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash, king of Israel.

Ahaz and Hezekiah [23 ISA 01 01](#) # The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah.

Ahaz and Hezekiah [33 MIC 01 01](#) # The word of the LORD that came to Micah the Morasthite in the days of Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah, which he saw concerning Samaria and Jerusalem.

Ahaz begat Jarah [13 1CH 09 42](#) # And Ahaz begat Jarah; and Jarah begat Alemeth, and Azmaveth, and Zimri; and Zimri begat Moza;

Ahaz begat Jehoadah [13 1CH 08 36](#) # And Ahaz begat Jehoadah; and Jehoadah begat Alemeth, and Azmaveth, and Zimri; and Zimri begat Moza,

Ahaz but could [12 2KI 16 05](#) # Then Rezin king of Syria and Pekah son of Remaliah king of Israel came up to Jerusalem to war: and they besieged Ahaz, but could not overcome [him].

Ahaz came from [12 2KI 16 11](#) # And Urijah the priest built an altar according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus: so Urijah the priest made [it] against king Ahaz came from Damascus.

Ahaz commanded Urijah [12 2KI 16 15](#) # And king Ahaz commanded Urijah the priest, saying, Upon the great altar burn the morning burnt offering, and the evening meat offering, and the king's burnt sacrifice, and his meat offering, with the burnt offering of all the people of the land, and their meat offering, and their drink offerings; and sprinkle upon it all the blood of the burnt offering, and all the blood of the sacrifice: and the brazen altar shall be for me to inquire [by].

Ahaz commanded [12 2KI 16 16](#) # Thus did Urijah the priest, according to all that king Ahaz commanded.

Ahaz cut off [12 2KI 16 17](#) # And king Ahaz cut off the borders of the bases, and removed the laver from off them; and took down the sea from off the brazen oxen that [were] under it, and put it upon a pavement of stones.

Ahaz died was [23 ISA 14 28](#) # In the year that king Ahaz died was this burden.

Ahaz gathered together [14 2CH 28 24](#) # And Ahaz gathered together the vessels of the house of God, and cut in pieces the vessels of the house of God, and shut up the doors of the house of the LORD, and he made him altars in every corner of Jerusalem.

Ahaz had sent [12 2KI 16 11](#) # And Urijah the priest built an altar according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus: so Urijah the priest made [it] against king Ahaz came from Damascus.

Ahaz his son [13 1CH 03 13](#) # Ahaz his son, Hezekiah his son, Manasseh his son,

Ahaz his son [14 2CH 27 09](#) # And Jotham slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David: and Ahaz his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaz his son [12 2KI 15 38](#) # And Jotham slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: and Ahaz his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaz in his [14 2CH 29 19](#) # Moreover all the vessels, which king Ahaz in his reign did cast away in his transgression, have we prepared and sanctified, and, behold, they [are] before the altar of the LORD.

Ahaz king of [14 2CH 28 19](#) # For the LORD brought Judah low because of Ahaz king of Israel; for he made Judah naked, and transgressed sore against the LORD.

Ahaz king of [12 2KI 17 01](#) # In the twelfth year of Ahaz king of Judah began Hoshea the son of Elah to reign in Samaria over Israel nine years.

Ahaz king of [12 2KI 18 01](#) # Now it came to pass in the third year of Hoshea son of Elah king of Israel, [that] Hezekiah the son of Ahaz king of Judah began to reign.

Ahaz said I [23 ISA 07 12](#) # But Ahaz said, I will not ask, neither will I tempt the LORD.

Ahaz saying [23 ISA 07 10](#) # Moreover the LORD spake again unto Ahaz, saying,

Ahaz send unto [14 2CH 28 16](#) # At that time did king Ahaz send unto the kings of Assyria to help him.

Ahaz sent messengers [12 2KI 16 07](#) # So Ahaz sent messengers to Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, saying, I [am] thy servant and thy son: come up, and save me out of the hand of the king of Syria, and out of the hand of the king of Israel, which rise up against me.

Ahaz sent to [12 2KI 16 10](#) # And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and saw an altar that [was] at Damascus: and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof.

Ahaz slept with [14 2CH 28 27](#) # And Ahaz slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city, [even] in Jerusalem: but they brought him not into the sepulchres of the kings of Israel: and Hezekiah his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaz slept with [12 2KI 16 20](#) # And Ahaz slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David: and Hezekiah his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaz ten degrees [23 ISA 38 08](#) # Behold, I will bring again the shadow of the degrees, which is gone down in the sun dial of Ahaz, ten degrees backward. So the sun returned ten degrees, by which degrees it was gone down.

Ahaz the son [12 2KI 16 01](#) # In the seventeenth year of Pekah the son of Remaliah Ahaz the son of Jotham king of Judah began to reign.

Ahaz the son [23 ISA 07 01](#) # And it came to pass in the days of Ahaz the son of Jotham, the son of Uzziah, king of Judah, [that] Rezin the king of Syria, and Pekah the son of Remaliah, king of Israel, went up toward Jerusalem to war against it, but could not prevail against it.

Ahaz thou and [23 ISA 07 03](#) # Then said the LORD unto Isaiah, Go forth now to meet Ahaz, thou, and Shearjashub thy son, at the end of the conduit of the upper pool in the highway of the fuller's field;

Ahaz took away [14 2CH 28 21](#) # For Ahaz took away a portion [out] of the house of the LORD, and [out] of the house of the king, and of the princes, and gave [it] unto the king of Assyria: but he helped him not.

Ahaz took the [12 2KI 16 08](#) # And Ahaz took the silver and gold that was found in the house of the LORD, and in the treasures of the king's house, and sent [it for] a present to the king of Assyria.

Ahaz was twenty [14_2CH_28_01](#) # Ahaz [was] twenty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem: but he did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, like David his father:

Ahaz went to [12_2KI_16_10](#) # And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and saw an altar that [was] at Damascus: and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof.

Ahaz when he [12_2KI_16_02](#) # Twenty years old [was] Ahaz when he began to reign, and reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem, and did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD his God, like David his father.

Ahaz which he [12_2KI_16_19](#) # Now the rest of the acts of Ahaz which he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah?

Ahaz which the [12_2KI_23_12](#) # And the altars that [were] on the top of the upper chamber of Ahaz, which the kings of Judah had made, and the altars which Manasseh had made in the two courts of the house of the LORD, did the king beat down, and brake [them] down from thence, and cast the dust of them into the brook Kidron.

Ahaz [13_1CH_08_35](#) # And the sons of Micah [were], Pithon, and Melech, and Tarea, and Ahaz.

Ahaz [13_1CH_09_41](#) # And the sons of Micah [were], Pithon, and Melech, and Tahrea, [and Ahaz].

Ahaz [14_2CH_28_22](#) # And in the time of his distress did he trespass yet more against the LORD: this [is that] king Ahaz.

Ahaz [12_2KI_20_11](#) # And Isaiah the prophet cried unto the LORD: and he brought the shadow ten degrees backward, by which it had gone down in the dial of Ahaz.

Ahaziah and stole [14_2CH_22_11](#) # But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

Ahaziah and stole [12_2KI_11_02](#) # But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even] him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

Ahaziah and they [14_2CH_22_09](#) # And he sought Ahaziah: and they caught him, [for he was hid in Samaria,] and brought him to Jehu: and when they had slain him, they buried him: Because, said they, he [is] the son of Jehoshaphat, who sought the LORD with all his heart. So the house of Ahaziah had no power to keep still the kingdom.

Ahaziah and we [12_2KI_10_13](#) # Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who [are] ye? And they answered, We [are] the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.

Ahaziah at Bethshemesh [12_2KI_14_13](#) # And Jehoash king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Jehoash the son of Ahaziah, at Bethshemesh, and came to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim unto the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Ahaziah fell down [12_2KI_01_02](#) # And Ahaziah fell down through a lattice in his upper chamber that [was] in Samaria, and was sick: and he sent messengers, and said unto them, Go, inquire of Baalzebub the

god of Ekron whether I shall recover of this disease.

Ahaziah had no [14 2CH 22 09](#) # And he sought Ahaziah: and they caught him, [for he was hid in Samaria,] and brought him to Jehu: and when they had slain him, they buried him: Because, said they, he [is] the son of Jehoshaphat, who sought the LORD with all his heart. So the house of Ahaziah had no power to keep still the kingdom.

Ahaziah he slew [14 2CH 22 08](#) # And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

Ahaziah hid him [14 2CH 22 11](#) # But Jehoshabeath, the daughter of the king, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons that were slain, and put him and his nurse in a bedchamber. So Jehoshabeath, the daughter of king Jehoram, the wife of Jehoiada the priest, [for she was the sister of Ahaziah,] hid him from Athaliah, so that she slew him not.

Ahaziah his fathers [12 2KI 12 18](#) # And Jehoash king of Judah took all the hallowed things that Jehoshaphat, and Jehoram, and Ahaziah, his fathers, kings of Judah, had dedicated, and his own hallowed things, and all the gold [that was] found in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and in the king's house, and sent [it] to Hazael king of Syria: and he went away from Jerusalem.

Ahaziah his son [13 1CH 03 11](#) # Joram his son, Ahaziah his son, Joash his son,

Ahaziah his son [11 1KI 22 40](#) # So Ahab slept with his fathers; and Ahaziah his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaziah his son [12 2KI 08 24](#) # And Joram slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David: and Ahaziah his son reigned in his stead.

Ahaziah his youngest [14 2CH 22 01](#) # And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

Ahaziah king of [14 2CH 20 35](#) # And after this did Jehoshaphat king of Judah join himself with Ahaziah king of Israel, who did very wickedly:

Ahaziah king of [12 2KI 09 16](#) # So Jehu rode in a chariot, and went to Jezreel; for Joram lay there. And Ahaziah king of Judah was come down to see Joram.

Ahaziah king of [12 2KI 09 21](#) # And Joram said, Make ready. And his chariot was made ready. And Joram king of Israel and Ahaziah king of Judah went out, each in his chariot, and they went out against Jehu, and met him in the portion of Naboth the Jezreelite.

Ahaziah king of [12 2KI 10 13](#) # Jehu met with the brethren of Ahaziah king of Judah, and said, Who [are] ye? And they answered, We [are] the brethren of Ahaziah; and we go down to salute the children of the king and the children of the queen.

Ahaziah king of [12 2KI 13 01](#) # In the three and twentieth year of Joash the son of Ahaziah king of Judah Jehoahaz the son of Jehu began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] seventeen years.

Ahaziah saw that [14 2CH 22 10](#) # But when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal of the house of Judah.

Ahaziah saw that [12 2KI 11 01](#) # And when Athaliah the mother of Ahaziah saw that her son was dead, she arose and destroyed all the seed royal.

Ahaziah that ministered [14 2CH 22 08](#) # And it came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing judgment upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them.

Ahaziah the king [12 2KI 09 27](#) # But when Ahaziah the king of Judah saw [this], he fled by the way of the garden house. And Jehu followed after him, and said, Smite him also in the chariot. [And they did so] at the going up to Gur, which [is] by Ibleam. And he fled to Megiddo, and died there.

Ahaziah the LORD [14 2CH 20 37](#) # Then Eliezer the son of Dodavah of Mareshah prophesied against Jehoshaphat, saying, Because thou hast joined thyself with Ahaziah, the LORD hath broken thy works. And the ships were broken, that they were not able to go to Tarshish.

Ahaziah the son [11 1KI 22 49](#) # Then said Ahaziah the son of Ahab unto Jehoshaphat, Let my servants go with thy servants in the ships. But Jehoshaphat would not.

Ahaziah the son [11 1KI 22 51](#) # Ahaziah the son of Ahab began to reign over Israel in Samaria the seventeenth year of Jehoshaphat king of Judah, and reigned two years over Israel.

Ahaziah the son [14 2CH 22 01](#) # And the inhabitants of Jerusalem made Ahaziah his youngest son king in his stead: for the band of men that came with the Arabians to the camp had slain all the eldest. So Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah reigned.

Ahaziah the son [12 2KI 08 25](#) # In the twelfth year of Joram the son of Ahab king of Israel did Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah begin to reign.

Ahaziah the son [12 2KI 08 29](#) # And king Joram went back to be healed in Jezreel of the wounds which the Syrians had given him at Ramah, when he fought against Hazael king of Syria. And Ahaziah the son of Jehoram king of Judah went down to see Joram the son of Ahab in Jezreel, because he was sick.

Ahaziah There is [12 2KI 09 23](#) # And Joram turned his hands, and fled, and said to Ahaziah, [There is] treachery, O Ahaziah.

Ahaziah to reign [12 2KI 09 29](#) # And in the eleventh year of Joram the son of Ahab began Ahaziah to reign over Judah.

Ahaziah took Joash [12 2KI 11 02](#) # But Jehosheba, the daughter of king Joram, sister of Ahaziah, took Joash the son of Ahaziah, and stole him from among the king's sons [which were] slain; and they hid him, [even] him and his nurse, in the bedchamber from Athaliah, so that he was not slain.

Ahaziah was of [14 2CH 22 07](#) # And the destruction of Ahaziah was of God by coming to Joram: for when he was come, he went out with Jehoram against Jehu the son of Nimshi, whom the LORD had anointed to cut off the house of Ahab.

Ahaziah when he [14 2CH 22 02](#) # Forty and two years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign, and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. His mother's name also [was] Athaliah the daughter of Omri.

Ahaziah when he [12 2KI 08 26](#) # Two and twenty years old [was] Ahaziah when he began to reign; and he reigned one year in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Athaliah, the daughter of Omri king of Israel.

Ahaziah which he [12 2KI 01 18](#) # Now the rest of the acts of Ahaziah which he did, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Ahaziah [12 2KI 09 23](#) # And Joram turned his hands, and fled, and said to Ahaziah, [There is] treachery, O Ahaziah.

Jahaz and fought [07 JUD 11 20](#) # But Sihon trusted not Israel to pass through his coast: but Sihon gathered all his people together, and pitched in Jahaz, and fought against Israel.

Jahaz and fought [04 NUM 21 23](#) # And Sihon would not suffer Israel to pass through his border: but Sihon gathered all his people together, and went out against Israel into the wilderness: and he came to Jahaz, and fought against Israel.

Jahaz have they [24 JER 48 34](#) # From the cry of Heshbon [even] unto Elealeh, [and even] unto Jahaz, have they uttered their voice, from Zoar [even] unto Horonaim, [as] an heifer of three years old: for the waters also of Nimrim shall be desolate.

Jahaz therefore the [23 ISA 15 04](#) # And Heshbon shall cry, and Elealeh: their voice shall be heard [even] unto Jahaz: therefore the armed soldiers of Moab shall cry out; his life shall be grievous unto him.

Jahaz [05 DEU 02 32](#) # Then Sihon came out against us, he and all his people, to fight at Jahaz.

Jahaza and Kedemoth [06 JOS 13 18](#) # And Jahaza, and Kedemoth, and Mephaath,

Jahazah and upon [24 JER 48 21](#) # And judgment is come upon the plain country; upon Holon, and upon Jahazah, and upon Mephaath,

Jahazah with her [06 JOS 21 36](#) # And out of the tribe of Reuben, Bezer with her suburbs, and Jahazah with her suburbs,

Jahaziah the son [15 EZR 10 15](#) # Only Jonathan the son of Asahel and Jahaziah the son of Tikvah were employed about this [matter]: and Meshullam and Shabbethai the Levite helped them.

Jahaziel and Johanan [13 1CH 12 04](#) # And Ismaiah the Gibeonite, a mighty man among the thirty, and over the thirty; and Jeremiah, and Jahaziel, and Johanan, and Josabad the Gederathite,

Jahaziel and with [15 EZR 08 05](#) # Of the sons of Shechaniah; the son of Jahaziel, and with him three hundred males.

Jahaziel the priests [13 1CH 16 06](#) # Benaiah also and Jahaziel the priests with trumpets continually before the ark of the covenant of God.

Jahaziel the son [14 2CH 20 14](#) # Then upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, came the Spirit of the LORD in the midst of the congregation;

Jahaziel the third [13 1CH 23 19](#) # Of the sons of Hebron; Jeriah the first, Amariah the second, Jahaziel the third, and Jekameam the fourth.

Jahaziel the third [13 1CH 24 23](#) # And the sons [of Hebron]; Jeriah [the first], Amariah the second, Jahaziel the third, Jekameam the fourth.

Jehoahaz and all [12 2KI 13 08](#) # Now the rest of the acts of Jehoahaz, and all that he did, and his might, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Jehoahaz at Bethshemesh [14 2CH 25 23](#) # And Joash the king of Israel took Amaziah king of Judah, the son of Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, at Bethshemesh, and brought him to Jerusalem, and brake down the wall of Jerusalem from the gate of Ephraim to the corner gate, four hundred cubits.

Jehoahaz away and [12 2KI 23 34](#) # And Pharaohnechoh made Eliakim the son of Josiah king in the room of Josiah his father, and turned his name to Jehoiakim, and took Jehoahaz away: and he came to Egypt,

and died there.

Jehoahaz besought the [12 2KI 13 04](#) # And Jehoahaz besought the LORD, and the LORD hearkened unto him: for he saw the oppression of Israel, because the king of Syria oppressed them.

Jehoahaz but fifty [12 2KI 13 07](#) # Neither did he leave of the people to Jehoahaz but fifty horsemen, and ten chariots, and ten thousand footmen; for the king of Syria had destroyed them, and had made them like the dust by threshing.

Jehoahaz his father [12 2KI 13 25](#) # And Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz took again out of the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael the cities, which he had taken out of the hand of Jehoahaz his father by war. Three times did Joash beat him, and recovered the cities of Israel.

Jehoahaz his son [12 2KI 10 35](#) # And Jehu slept with his fathers: and they buried him in Samaria. And Jehoahaz his son reigned in his stead.

Jehoahaz king of [14 2CH 25 25](#) # And Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah lived after the death of Joash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel fifteen years.

Jehoahaz king of [12 2KI 14 01](#) # In the second year of Joash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel reigned Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah.

Jehoahaz king of [12 2KI 14 17](#) # And Amaziah the son of Joash king of Judah lived after the death of Jehoash son of Jehoahaz king of Israel fifteen years.

Jehoahaz slept with [12 2KI 13 09](#) # And Jehoahaz slept with his fathers; and they buried him in Samaria: and Joash his son reigned in his stead.

Jehoahaz son of [12 2KI 14 08](#) # Then Amaziah sent messengers to Jehoash, the son of Jehoahaz son of Jehu, king of Israel, saying, Come, let us look one another in the face.

Jehoahaz the son [14 2CH 25 17](#) # Then Amaziah king of Judah took advice, and sent to Joash, the son of Jehoahaz, the son of Jehu, king of Israel, saying, Come, let us see one another in the face.

Jehoahaz the son [14 2CH 36 01](#) # Then the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and made him king in his father's stead in Jerusalem.

Jehoahaz the son [12 2KI 13 01](#) # In the three and twentieth year of Joash the son of Ahaziah king of Judah Jehoahaz the son of Jehu began to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] seventeen years.

Jehoahaz the son [12 2KI 23 30](#) # And his servants carried him in a chariot dead from Megiddo, and brought him to Jerusalem, and buried him in his own sepulchre. And the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah, and anointed him, and made him king in his father's stead.

Jehoahaz the youngest [14 2CH 21 17](#) # And they came up into Judah, and brake into it, and carried away all the substance that was found in the king's house, and his sons also, and his wives; so that there was never a son left him, save Jehoahaz, the youngest of his sons.

Jehoahaz to reign [12 2KI 13 10](#) # In the thirty and seventh year of Joash king of Judah began Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz to reign over Israel in Samaria, [and reigned] sixteen years.

Jehoahaz took again [12 2KI 13 25](#) # And Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz took again out of the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael the cities, which he had taken out of the hand of Jehoahaz his father by war. Three times did Joash beat him, and recovered the cities of Israel.

Jehoahaz was twenty [14 2CH 36 02](#) # Jehoahaz [was] twenty and three years old when he began to reign, and he reigned three months in Jerusalem.

Jehoahaz was twenty [12 2KI 23 31](#) # Jehoahaz [was] twenty and three years old when he began to reign; and he reigned three months in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Hamutal, the daughter of Jeremiah of Libnah.

Jehoahaz [12 2KI 13 22](#) # But Hazael king of Syria oppressed Israel all the days of Jehoahaz.

Joahaz the recorder [14 2CH 34 08](#) # Now in the eighteenth year of his reign, when he had purged the land, and the house, he sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, and Maaseiah the governor of the city, and Joah the son of Joahaz the recorder, to repair the house of the LORD his God.

Mahazioth he his [13 1CH 25 30](#) # The three and twentieth to Mahazioth, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:
