

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Barak and lead <u>07\_JUD\_05\_12</u># Awake, awake, Deborah: awake, awake, utter a song: arise, Barak, and lead thy captivity captive, thou son of Abinoam.

Barak and of <u>58\_HEB\_11\_32</u># And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and [of] Barak, and [of] Samson, and [of] Jephthae; [of] David also, and Samuel, and [of] the prophets:

Barak called Zebulun <u>07\_JUD\_04\_10</u># And Barak called Zebulun and Naphtali to Kedesh; and he went up with ten thousand men at his feet: and Deborah went up with him.
