Abaddon but in <u>66\_REV\_09\_11</u># And they had a king over them, [which is] the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue [is] Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath [his] name Apollyon.

Ammizabad his son 13\_1CH\_27\_06 # This [is that] Benaiah, [who was] mighty [among] the thirty, and above the thirty: and in his course [was] Ammizabad his son.

bad and good 40\_MAT\_22\_10# So those servants went out into the highways, and gathered together all as many as they found, both bad and good: and the wedding was furnished with guests.

bad and what <u>04\_NUM\_13\_19</u># And what the land [is] that they dwell in, whether it [be] good or bad; and what cities [they be] that they dwell in, whether in tents, or in strong holds;

bad as the <u>03\_LEV\_27\_14</u># And when a man shall sanctify his house [to be] holy unto the LORD, then the priest shall estimate it, whether it be good or bad: as the priest shall estimate it, so shall it stand.

bad as thou <u>03\_LEV\_27\_12</u> # And the priest shall value it, whether it be good or bad: as thou valuest it, [who art] the priest, so shall it be.

bad away 40\_MAT\_13\_48# Which, when it was full, they drew to shore, and sat down, and gathered the good into vessels, but cast the bad away.

bad city and <u>15\_EZR\_04\_12</u> # Be it known unto the king, that the Jews which came up from thee to us are come unto Jerusalem, building the rebellious and the bad city, and have set up the walls [thereof], and joined the foundations.

bad for a <u>03\_LEV\_27\_10</u># He shall not alter it, nor change it, a good for a bad, or a bad for a good: and if he shall at all change beast for beast, then it and the exchange thereof shall be holy.

bade him he <u>06\_JOS\_11\_09</u># And Joshua did unto them as the LORD bade him: he hocked their horses, and burnt their chariots with fire.

bade him When 42 LUK 14 12 # Then said he also to him that bade him, When thou makest a dinner or a supper, call not thy friends, nor thy brethren, neither thy kinsmen, nor [thy] rich neighbours; lest they also bid thee again, and a recompense be made thee.

bade many 42\_LUK\_14\_16 # Then said he unto him, A certain man made a great supper, and bade many:

bade me and 10\_2SA\_14\_19 # And the king said, [Is not] the hand of Joab with thee in all this? And the woman answered and said, [As] thy soul liveth, my lord the king, none can turn to the right hand or to the left from ought that my lord the king hath spoken: for thy servant Joab, he bade me, and he put all these words in the mouth of thine handmaid:

badest me arise <u>01\_GEN\_27\_19</u># And Jacob said unto his father, I [am] Esau thy firstborn; I have done according as thou badest me: arise, I pray thee, sit and eat of my venison, that thy soul may bless me.

badgers skin and <u>26\_EZE\_16\_10</u># I clothed thee also with broidered work, and shod thee with badgers' skin, and I girded thee about with fine linen, and I covered thee with silk.

badgers skins above <u>02\_EXO\_36\_19</u># And he made a covering for the tent [of] rams' skins dyed red, and a covering [of] badgers' skins above [that].

badgers skins and 02\_EXO\_25\_05 # And rams' skins dyed red, and badgers' skins, and shittim wood,

badgers skins and 02\_EXO\_35\_07 # And rams' skins dyed red, and badgers' skins, and shittim wood,

badgers skins and <u>02\_EXO\_39\_34</u> # And the covering of rams' skins dyed red, and the covering of badgers' skins, and the veil of the covering,

badgers skins and <u>04\_NUM\_04\_06</u># And shall put thereon the covering of badgers' skins, and shall spread over [it] a cloth wholly of blue, and shall put in the staves thereof.

badgers skins and <u>04\_NUM\_04\_08</u># And they shall spread upon them a cloth of scarlet, and cover the same with a covering of badgers' skins, and shall put in the staves thereof.

badgers skins and <u>04\_NUM\_04\_10</u> # And they shall put it and all the vessels thereof within a covering of badgers' skins, and shall put [it] upon a bar.

badgers skins and <u>04\_NUM\_04\_11</u># And upon the golden altar they shall spread a cloth of blue, and cover it with a covering of badgers' skins, and shall put to the staves thereof:

forbad him saying 40\_MAT\_03\_14# But John forbad him, saying, I have need to be baptized of thee, and comest thou to me?

forbad the madness <u>61\_2PE\_02\_16</u> # But was rebuked for his iniquity: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the madness of the prophet.

forbad us <u>05\_DEU\_02\_37</u># Only unto the land of the children of Ammon thou camest not, [nor] unto any place of the river Jabbok, nor unto the cities in the mountains, nor unto whatsoever the LORD our God forbad us.

Hashbadana Zechariah and 16\_NEH\_08\_04 # And Ezra the scribe stood upon a pulpit of wood, which they had made for the purpose; and beside him stood Mattithiah, and Shema, and Anaiah, and Urijah, and Hilkiah, and Maaseiah, on his right hand; and on his left hand, Pedaiah, and Mishael, and Malchiah, and Hashbadana, Zechariah, [and] Meshullam.

Jozabad and Eliel <u>14\_2CH\_31\_13</u># And Jehiel, and Azaziah, and Nahath, and Asahel, and Jerimoth, and Jozabad, and Eliel, and Ismachiah, and Mahath, and Benaiah, [were] overseers under the hand of Cononiah and Shimei his brother, at the commandment of Hezekiah the king, and Azariah the ruler of the house of God.

Jozabad Hanan Pelaiah <u>16\_NEH\_08\_07</u> # Also Jeshua, and Bani, and Sherebiah, Jamin, Akkub, Shabbethai, Hodijah, Maaseiah, Kelita, Azariah, Jozabad, Hanan, Pelaiah, and the Levites, caused the people to understand the law: and the people [stood] in their place.

Jozabad of the <u>16\_NEH\_11\_16</u># And Shabbethai and Jozabad, of the chief of the Levites, [had] the oversight of the outward business of the house of God.

Jozabad the son 15 EZR 08 33 # Now on the fourth day was the silver and the gold and the vessels weighed in the house of our God by the hand of Meremoth the son of Uriah the priest; and with him [was] Eleazar the son of Phinehas; and with them [was] Jozabad the son of Jeshua, and Noadiah the son of Binnui, Levites;

Obadiah the Levites 14\_2CH\_34\_12 # And the men did the work faithfully: and the overseers of them [were] Jahath and Obadiah, the Levites, of the sons of Merari; and Zechariah and Meshullam, of the sons of the Kohathites, to set [it] forward; and [other of] the Levites, all that could skill of instruments of music.

Obadiah the second 13\_1CH\_12\_09 # Ezer the first, Obadiah the second, Eliab the third,

Obadiah the son 13\_1CH\_09\_16# And Obadiah the son of Shemaiah, the son of Galal, the son of Jeduthun, and Berechiah the son of Asa, the son of Elkanah, that dwelt in the villages of the Netophathites.

Obadiah the son <u>15\_EZR\_08\_09</u> # Of the sons of Joab; Obadiah the son of Jehiel, and with him two hundred and eighteen males.

Obadiah the sons <u>13\_1CH\_03\_21</u># And the sons of Hananiah; Pelatiah, and Jesaiah: the sons of Rephaiah, the sons of Arnan, the sons of Obadiah, the sons of Shechaniah.

Obadiah Thus saith <u>31\_OBA\_01\_01</u> # The vision of Obadiah. Thus saith the Lord GOD concerning Edom; We have heard a rumour from the LORD, and an ambassador is sent among the heathen, Arise ye, and let us rise up against her in battle.

Zabad Zebina Jadau <u>15\_EZR\_10\_43</u># Of the sons of Nebo; Jeiel, Mattithiah, Zabad, Zebina, Jadau, and Joel, Benaiah.

Zabad 13\_1CH\_02\_36 # And Attai begat Nathan, and Nathan begat Zabad,

Zebadiah and Arad 13\_1CH\_08\_15 # And Zebadiah, and Arad, and Ader,

Zebadiah and Asahel <u>14\_2CH\_17\_08</u># And with them [he sent] Levites, [even] Shemaiah, and Nethaniah, and Zebadiah, and Asahel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehonathan, and Adonijah, and Tobijah, and Tobadonijah, Levites; and with them Elishama and Jehoram, priests.
