bade and it [02 EXO 16 24](#) # And they laid it up till the morning, as Moses bade: and it did not stink, neither was there any worm therein.

bade and the [01 GEN 43 17](#) # And the man did as Joseph bade; and the man brought the men into Joseph's house.

bade her [08 RUT 03 06](#) # And she went down unto the floor, and did according to all that her mother in law bade her.

bade him he [06 JOS 11 09](#) # And Joshua did unto them as the LORD bade him: he hocked their horses, and burnt their chariots with fire.

bade him When [42 LUK 14 12](#) # Then said he also to him that bade him, When thou makest a dinner or a supper, call not thy friends, nor thy brethren, neither thy kinsmen, nor [thy] rich neighbours; lest they also bid thee again, and a recompense be made thee.

bade many [42 LUK 14 16](#) # Then said he unto him, A certain man made a great supper, and bade many:

bade me and [10 2SA 14 19](#) # And the king said, [Is not] the hand of Joab with thee in all this? And the woman answered and said, [As] thy soul liveth, my lord the king, none can turn to the right hand or to the left from ought that my lord the king hath spoken: for thy servant Joab, he bade me, and he put all these words in the mouth of thine handmaid:

bade me go [44 ACT 11 12](#) # And the Spirit bade me go with them, nothing doubting. Moreover these six brethren accompanied me, and we entered into the man's house:

bade me kill [09 ISA 24 10](#) # Behold, this day thine eyes have seen how that the LORD had delivered thee to day into mine hand in the cave: and [some] bade [me] kill thee: but [mine eye] spared thee; and I said, I will not put forth mine hand against my lord; for he [is] the LORD'S anointed.

bade saying Come [14 2CH 10 12](#) # So Jeroboam and all the people came to Rehoboam on the third day, as the king bade, saying, Come again to me on the third day.

bade stone them [04 NUM 14 10](#) # But all the congregation bade stone them with stones. And the glory of the LORD appeared in the tabernacle of the congregation before all the children of Israel.

bade that he [44 ACT 22 24](#) # The chief captain commanded him to be brought into the castle, and bade that he should be examined by scourging; that he might know wherefore they cried so against him.

bade thee and [42 LUK 14 09](#) # And he that bade thee and him come and say to thee, Give this man place; and thou begin with shame to take the lowest room.

bade thee cometh [42 LUK 14 10](#) # But when thou art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade thee cometh, he may say unto thee, Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have worship in the presence of them that sit at meat with thee.

bade them farewell [44 ACT 18 21](#) # But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

bade them not [40 MAT 16 12](#) # Then understood they how that he bade [them] not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees.

bade them return [17 EST 04 15](#) # Then Esther bade [them] return Mordecai [this answer],

bade them teach [10 2SA 01 18](#) # [Also he bade them teach the children of Judah [the use of] the bow: behold, [it is] written in the book of Jasher.]

badest me arise [01 GEN 27 19](#) # And Jacob said unto his father, I [am] Esau thy firstborn; I have done according as thou badest me: arise, I pray thee, sit and eat of my venison, that thy soul may bless me.
