abase him that <u>26\_EZE\_21\_26</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; Remove the diadem, and take off the crown: this [shall] not [be] the same: exalt [him that is] low, and abase [him that is] high.

abase him <u>18\_JOB\_40\_11</u># Cast abroad the rage of thy wrath: and behold every one [that is] proud, and abase him.

abase himself for 23 ISA 31 04 # For thus hath the LORD spoken unto me, Like as the lion and the young lion roaring on his prey, when a multitude of shepherds is called forth against him, [he] will not be afraid of their voice, nor abase himself for the noise of them: so shall the LORD of hosts come down to fight for mount Zion, and for the hill thereof.

abase <u>27\_DAN\_04\_37</u># Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all whose works [are] truth, and his ways judgment: and those that walk in pride he is able to abase.

abased and he <u>42\_LUK\_14\_11</u># For whosoever exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

abased and he <u>42\_LUK\_18\_14</u># I tell you, this man went down to his house justified [rather] than the other: for every one that exalteth himself shall be abased; and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

abased and he <u>40\_MAT\_23\_12</u># And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.

abased and I <u>50\_PHP\_04\_12</u># I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need.

base a cubit 11\_1KI\_07\_31 # And the mouth of it within the chapiter and above [was] a cubit: but the mouth thereof [was] round [after] the work of the base, a cubit and an half: and also upon the mouth of it [were] gravings with their borders, foursquare, not round.

base above and <u>11\_1KI\_07\_29</u> # And on the borders that [were] between the ledges [were] lions, oxen, and cherubims: and upon the ledges [there was] a base above: and beneath the lions and oxen [were] certain additions made of thin work.

base against the <u>23\_ISA\_03\_05</u># And the people shall be oppressed, every one by another, and every one by his neighbour: the child shall behave himself proudly against the ancient, and the base against the honourable.

base among you <u>47\_2CO\_10\_01</u> # Now I Paul myself beseech you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ, who in presence [am] base among you, but being absent am bold toward you:

base and four <u>11\_1KI\_07\_27</u># And he made ten bases of brass; four cubits [was] the length of one base, and four cubits the breadth thereof, and three cubits the height of it.

base and the <u>11\_1KI\_07\_32</u># And under the borders [were] four wheels; and the axletrees of the wheels [were joined] to the base: and the height of a wheel [was] a cubit and half a cubit.

base and the 11\_1KI\_07\_34 # And [there were] four undersetters to the four corners of one base: [and] the

undersetters [were] of the very base itself.

base before all <u>39\_MAL\_02\_09</u> # Therefore have I also made you contemptible and base before all the people, according as ye have not kept my ways, but have been partial in the law.

base had four 11\_1KI\_07\_30# And every base had four brazen wheels, and plates of brass: and the four corners thereof had undersetters: under the laver [were] undersetters molten, at the side of every addition.

base in mine 10\_28A\_06\_22 # And I will yet be more vile than thus, and will be base in mine own sight: and of the maidservants which thou hast spoken of, of them shall I be had in honour.

base itself 11 1KI 07 34 # And [there were] four undersetters to the four corners of one base: [and] the undersetters [were] of the very base itself.

base kingdom <u>26\_EZE\_29\_14</u> # And I will bring again the captivity of Egypt, and will cause them to return [into] the land of Pathros, into the land of their habitation; and they shall be there a base kingdom.

base men they <u>18\_JOB\_30\_08</u># [They were] children of fools, yea, children of base men: they were viler than the earth.

base that it <u>26\_EZE\_17\_14</u> # That the kingdom might be base, that it might not lift itself up, [but] that by keeping of his covenant it might stand.

base the ledges 11\_1KI\_07\_35 # And in the top of the base [was there] a round compass of half a cubit high: and on the top of the base the ledges thereof and the borders thereof [were] of the same.

base things of 46\_1CO\_01\_28 # And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, [yea], and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are:

base was there <u>11\_1KI\_07\_35</u># And in the top of the base [was there] a round compass of half a cubit high: and on the top of the base the ledges thereof and the borders thereof [were] of the same.

base 38\_ZEC\_05\_11# And he said unto me, To build it an house in the land of Shinar: and it shall be established, and set there upon her own base.

baser sort and <u>44\_ACT\_17\_05</u> # But the Jews which believed not, moved with envy, took unto them certain lewd fellows of the baser sort, and gathered a company, and set all the city on an uproar, and assaulted the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people.

bases all of <u>11\_1KI\_07\_37</u># After this [manner] he made the ten bases: all of them had one casting, one measure, [and] one size.

bases and concerning 24\_JER\_27\_19 # For thus saith the LORD of hosts concerning the pillars, and concerning the sea, and concerning the bases, and concerning the residue of the vessels that remain in this city,

bases and lavers 14\_2CH\_04\_14 # He made also bases, and lavers made he upon the bases;

bases and removed <u>12\_2KI\_16\_17</u># And king Ahaz cut off the borders of the bases, and removed the laver from off them; and took down the sea from off the brazen oxen that [were] under it, and put it upon a pavement of stones.

bases and ten 11\_1KI\_07\_43 # And the ten bases, and ten lavers on the bases;

bases and the 12\_2KI\_25\_13 # And the pillars of brass that [were] in the house of the LORD, and the bases,

and the brazen sea that [was] in the house of the LORD, did the Chaldees break in pieces, and carried the brass of them to Babylon.

bases for fear <u>15\_EZR\_03\_03</u># And they set the altar upon his bases; for fear [was] upon them because of the people of those countries: and they offered burnt offerings thereon unto the LORD, [even] burnt offerings morning and evening.

bases of brass 11\_1KI\_07\_27# And he made ten bases of brass; four cubits [was] the length of one base, and four cubits the breadth thereof, and three cubits the height of it.

bases on the 11\_1KI\_07\_39# And he put five bases on the right side of the house, and five on the left side of the house: and he set the sea on the right side of the house eastward over against the south.

bases one laver <u>11\_1KI\_07\_38</u># Then made he ten lavers of brass: one laver contained forty baths: [and] every laver was four cubits: [and] upon every one of the ten bases one laver.

bases was on 11\_1KI\_07\_28 # And the work of the bases [was] on this [manner]: they had borders, and the borders [were] between the ledges:

bases which king 24\_JER\_52\_20 # The two pillars, one sea, and twelve brazen bulls that [were] under the bases, which king Solomon had made in the house of the LORD: the brass of all these vessels was without weight.

bases which Solomon 12\_2KI\_25\_16 # The two pillars, one sea, and the bases which Solomon had made for the house of the LORD; the brass of all these vessels was without weight.

bases 11\_1KI\_07\_43 # And the ten bases, and ten layers on the bases;

bases 14\_2CH\_04\_14 # He made also bases, and lavers made he upon the bases;

basest of men <u>27\_DAN\_04\_17</u> # This matter [is] by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.

basest of the <u>26\_EZE\_29\_15</u># It shall be the basest of the kingdoms; neither shall it exalt itself any more above the nations: for I will diminish them, that they shall no more rule over the nations.

debase thyself even <u>23\_ISA\_57\_09</u># And thou wentest to the king with ointment, and didst increase thy perfumes, and didst send thy messengers far off, and didst debase [thyself even] unto hell.
