behaved and quieted [19 PSA 131 02](#) # Surely I have behaved and quieted myself, as a child that is weaned of his mother: my soul [is] even as a weaned child.

behaved himself more [09 1SA 18 30](#) # Then the princes of the Philistines went forth: and it came to pass, after they went forth, [that] David behaved himself more wisely than all the servants of Saul; so that his name was much set by.

behaved himself very [09 1SA 18 15](#) # Wherefore when Saul saw that he behaved himself very wisely, he was afraid of him.

behaved himself wisely [09 1SA 18 05](#) # And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, [and] behaved himself wisely: and Saul set him over the men of war, and he was accepted in the sight of all the people, and also in the sight of Saul's servants.

behaved himself wisely [09 1SA 18 14](#) # And David behaved himself wisely in all his ways; and the LORD [was] with him.
