inhabitants of Gath [13 1CH 08 13](#) # Beriah also, and Shema, who [were] heads of the fathers of the inhabitants of Aijalon, who drove away the inhabitants of Gath:

inhabitants of Geba [13 1CH 08 06](#) # And these [are] the sons of Ehud: these are the heads of the fathers of the inhabitants of Geba, and they removed them to Manahath:

inhabitants of Gebim [23 ISA 10 31](#) # Madmenah is removed; the inhabitants of Gebim gather themselves to flee.

inhabitants of Gibeah [07 JUD 20 15](#) # And the children of Benjamin were numbered at that time out of the cities twenty and six thousand men that drew sword, beside the inhabitants of Gibeah, which were numbered seven hundred chosen men.

inhabitants of Gibeon [06 JOS 09 03](#) # And when the inhabitants of Gibeon heard what Joshua had done unto Jericho and to Ai,
