boldly and slew [01_GEN_34_25](#) # And it came to pass on the third day, when they were sore, that two of the sons of Jacob, Simeon and Levi, Dinah's brethren, took each man his sword, and came upon the city boldly, and slew all the males.

boldly and they [43_JOH_07_26](#) # But, lo, he speaketh boldly, and they say nothing unto him. Do the rulers know indeed that this is the very Christ?

boldly as I [49_EPH_06_20](#) # For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

boldly at Damascus [44_ACT_09_27](#) # But Barnabas took him, and brought [him] to the apostles, and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way, and that he had spoken to him, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus.
