burden according to <u>04_NUM_04_31</u># And this [is] the charge of their burden, according to all their service in the tabernacle of the congregation; the boards of the tabernacle, and the bars thereof, and the pillars thereof, and sockets thereof,

burden and came 12 2KI 08 09 # So Hazael went to meet him, and took a present with him, even of every good thing of Damascus, forty camels' burden, and came and stood before him, and said, Thy son Benhadad king of Syria hath sent me to thee, saying, Shall I recover of this disease?

burden and desire 21_ECC_12_05 # Also [when] they shall be afraid of [that which is] high, and fears [shall be] in the way, and the almond tree shall flourish, and the grasshopper shall be a burden, and desire shall fail: because man goeth to his long home, and the mourners go about the streets:

burden of earth 12_2KI_05_17 # And Naaman said, Shall there not then, I pray thee, be given to thy servant two mules' burden of earth? for thy servant will henceforth offer neither burnt offering nor sacrifice unto other gods, but unto the LORD.

burden upon Arabia <u>23_ISA_21_13</u># The burden upon Arabia. In the forest in Arabia shall ye lodge, O ye travelling companies of Dedanim.

burden upon him 12_2KI_09_25 # Then said [Jehu] to Bidkar his captain, Take up, [and] cast him in the portion of the field of Naboth the Jezreelite: for remember how that, when I and thou rode together after Ahab his father, the LORD laid this burden upon him;

burden upon the 19_PSA_55_22 # Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved.

burden with thee <u>02_EXO_18_22</u># And let them judge the people at all seasons: and it shall be, [that] every great matter they shall bring unto thee, but every small matter they shall judge: so shall it be easier for thyself, and they shall bear [the burden] with thee.

burden you nevertheless <u>47_2CO_12_16</u># But be it so, I did not burden you: nevertheless, being crafty, I caught you with guile.

burdens and fourscore <u>11_1KI_05_15</u># And Solomon had threescore and ten thousand that bare burdens, and fourscore thousand hewers in the mountains;

burdens and he <u>02_EXO_02_11</u># And it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out unto his brethren, and looked on their burdens: and he spied an Egyptian smiting an Hebrew, one of his brethren.

burdens and in <u>04_NUM_04_27</u># At the appointment of Aaron and his sons shall be all the service of the sons of the Gershonites, in all their burdens, and in all their service: and ye shall appoint unto them in charge all their burdens.

burdens and so 48_GAL_06_02 # Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

burdens And they <u>02_EXO_01_11</u># Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.

burdens is decayed <u>16_NEH_04_10</u># And Judah said, The strength of the bearers of burdens is decayed, and [there is] much rubbish; so that we are not able to build the wall.

burdens laid upon 14_2CH_24_27 # Now [concerning] his sons, and the greatness of the burdens [laid] upon him, and the repairing of the house of God, behold, they [are] written in the story of the book of the kings. And Amaziah his son reigned in his stead.

burdens of the <u>02_EXO_06_06</u># Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I [am] the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments:

burdens with one <u>42_LUK_11_46</u># And he said, Woe unto you also, [ye] lawyers! for ye lade men with burdens grievous to be borne, and ye yourselves touch not the burdens with one of your fingers.

burdens with those <u>16_NEH_04_17</u> # They which builded on the wall, and they that bare burdens, with those that laded, [every one] with one of his hands wrought in the work, and with the other [hand] held a weapon.

burdens <u>02_EXO_05_04</u># And the king of Egypt said unto them, Wherefore do ye, Moses and Aaron, let the people from their works? get you unto your burdens.

burdens <u>02_EXO_05_05</u> # And Pharaoh said, Behold, the people of the land now [are] many, and ye make them rest from their burdens.

burdensome to you <u>47_2CO_12_13</u> # For what is it wherein ye were inferior to other churches, except [it be] that I myself was not burdensome to you? forgive me this wrong.

burdensome to you <u>47_2CO_12_14</u># Behold, the third time I am ready to come to you; and I will not be burdensome to you: for I seek not yours, but you: for the children ought not to lay up for the parents, but the parents for the children.

burdensome unto you <u>47_2CO_11_09</u># And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the brethren which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all [things] I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and [so] will I keep [myself].
