

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Caesar and lo <u>44\_ACT\_27\_24</u># Saying, Fear not, Paul; thou must be brought before Caesar: and, lo, God hath given thee all them that sail with thee.

Caesar Augustus that <u>42\_LUK\_02\_01</u># And it came to pass in those days, that there went out a decree from Caesar Augustus, that all the world should be taxed.

Caesar have I <u>44\_ACT\_25\_08</u> # While he answered for himself, Neither against the law of the Jews, neither against the temple, nor yet against Caesar, have I offended any thing at all.

Caesar not that 44\_ACT\_28\_19 # But when the Jews spake against [it], I was constrained to appeal unto Caesar; not that I had ought to accuse my nation of.

Caesar or no 42\_LUK\_20\_22 # Is it lawful for us to give tribute unto Caesar, or no?

Caesar or not <u>41\_MAR\_12\_14</u># And when they were come, they say unto him, Master, we know that thou art true, and carest for no man: for thou regardest not the person of men, but teachest the way of God in truth: Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar, or not?

Caesar or not 40\_MAT\_22\_17# Tell us therefore, What thinkest thou? Is it lawful to give tribute unto Caesar, or not?

Caesar Pontius Pilate <u>42\_LUK\_03\_01</u># Now in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberius Caesar, Pontius Pilate being governor of Judaea, and Herod being tetrarch of Galilee, and his brother Philip tetrarch of Ituraea and of the region of Trachonitis, and Lysanias the tetrarch of Abilene,

Caesar saying that <u>44\_ACT\_17\_07</u># Whom Jason hath received: and these all do contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying that there is another king, [one] Jesus.

Caesar saying that <u>42\_LUK\_23\_02</u># And they began to accuse him, saying, We found this [fellow] perverting the nation, and forbidding to give tribute to Caesar, saying that he himself is Christ a King.

Caesar shalt thou <u>44\_ACT\_25\_12</u> # Then Festus, when he had conferred with the council, answered, Hast thou appealed unto Caesar? unto Caesar shalt thou go.

Caesar the things <u>42\_LUK\_20\_25</u># And he said unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and unto God the things which be God's.

Caesar the things 41\_MAR\_12\_17 # And Jesus answering said unto them, Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's. And they marvelled at him.

Caesar the things 40\_MAT\_22\_21# They say unto him, Caesar's. Then saith he unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God the things that are God's.

Caesar unto Caesar 44\_ACT\_25\_12 # Then Festus, when he had conferred with the council, answered, Hast thou appealed unto Caesar? unto Caesar shalt thou go.

Caesar <u>44\_ACT\_11\_28</u># And there stood up one of them named Agabus, and signified by the Spirit that there should be great dearth throughout all the world: which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar.

Caesar <u>44\_ACT\_25\_11</u># For if I be an offender, or have committed any thing worthy of death, I refuse not to die: but if there be none of these things whereof these accuse me, no man may deliver me unto them. I appeal unto Caesar.

Caesar <u>44\_ACT\_25\_21</u># But when Paul had appealed to be reserved unto the hearing of Augustus, I commanded him to be kept till I might send him to Caesar.

Caesar <u>44\_ACT\_26\_32</u># Then said Agrippa unto Festus, This man might have been set at liberty, if he had not appealed unto Caesar.

Caesar <u>43\_JOH\_19\_12</u># And from thenceforth Pilate sought to release him: but the Jews cried out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not Caesar's friend: whosoever maketh himself a king speaketh against Caesar.

Caesar <u>43\_JOH\_19\_15</u># But they cried out, Away with [him], away with [him], crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.

Caesar's and to 41\_MAR\_12\_17 # And Jesus answering said unto them, Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's. And they marvelled at him.

Caesar's and unto 42\_LUK\_20\_25 # And he said unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which be Caesar's, and unto God the things which be God's.

Caesar's and unto 40\_MAT\_22\_21# They say unto him, Caesar's. Then saith he unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God the things that are God's.

Caesar's friend whosoever 43 JOH 19 12 # And from thenceforth Pilate sought to release him: but the Jews cried out, saying, If thou let this man go, thou art not Caesar's friend: whosoever maketh himself a king speaketh against Caesar.

Caesar's household 50\_PHP\_04\_22 # All the saints salute you, chiefly they that are of Caesar's household.

Caesar's judgment seat <u>44\_ACT\_25\_10</u> # Then said Paul, I stand at Caesar's judgment seat, where I ought to be judged: to the Jews have I done no wrong, as thou very well knowest.

Caesar's Then saith <u>40\_MAT\_22\_21</u># They say unto him, Caesar's. Then saith he unto them, Render therefore unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's; and unto God the things that are God's.

Caesar's <u>42\_LUK\_20\_24</u># Show me a penny. Whose image and superscription hath it? They answered and said, Caesar's.

Caesar's <u>41\_MAR\_12\_16</u># And they brought [it]. And he saith unto them, Whose [is] this image and superscription? And they said unto him, Caesar's.

Caesarea and brought <u>44\_ACT\_21\_16</u># There went with us also [certain] of the disciples of Caesarea, and brought with them one Mnason of Cyprus, an old disciple, with whom we should lodge.

Caesarea And Cornelius <u>44\_ACT\_10\_24</u> # And the morrow after they entered into Caesarea. And Cornelius waited for them, and had called together his kinsmen and near friends.

Caesarea and delivered <u>44\_ACT\_23\_33</u> # Who, when they came to Caesarea, and delivered the epistle to the governor, presented Paul also before him.

Caesarea and gone 44\_ACT\_18\_22 # And when he had landed at Caesarea, and gone up, and saluted the

church, he went down to Antioch.

Caesarea and horsemen <u>44\_ACT\_23\_23</u># And he called unto [him] two centurions, saying, Make ready two hundred soldiers to go to Caesarea, and horsemen threescore and ten, and spearmen two hundred, at the third hour of the night;

Caesarea and sent <u>44\_ACT\_09\_30</u> # [Which] when the brethren knew, they brought him down to Caesarea, and sent him forth to Tarsus.

Caesarea and that <u>44\_ACT\_25\_04</u> # But Festus answered, that Paul should be kept at Caesarea, and that he himself would depart shortly [thither].

Caesarea and the <u>44\_ACT\_25\_06</u> # And when he had tarried among them more than ten days, he went down unto Caesarea; and the next day sitting on the judgment seat commanded Paul to be brought.

Caesarea and there <u>44\_ACT\_12\_19</u># And when Herod had sought for him, and found him not, he examined the keepers, and commanded that [they] should be put to death. And he went down from Judaea to Caesarea, and [there] abode.

Caesarea and we <u>44\_ACT\_21\_08</u> # And the next [day] we that were of Paul's company departed, and came unto Caesarea: and we entered into the house of Philip the evangelist, which was [one] of the seven; and abode with him.

Caesarea called Cornelius <u>44\_ACT\_10\_01</u> # There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of the band called the Italian [band],

Caesarea Philippi and 41\_MAR\_08\_27 # And Jesus went out, and his disciples, into the towns of Caesarea Philippi: and by the way he asked his disciples, saying unto them, Whom do men say that I am?

Caesarea Philippi he <u>40\_MAT\_16\_13</u># When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, Whom do men say that I the Son of man am?

Caesarea to Jerusalem <u>44\_ACT\_25\_01</u> # Now when Festus was come into the province, after three days he ascended from Caesarea to Jerusalem.

Caesarea to salute <u>44\_ACT\_25\_13</u> # And after certain days king Agrippa and Bernice came unto Caesarea to salute Festus.

Caesarea unto me <u>44\_ACT\_11\_11</u># And, behold, immediately there were three men already come unto the house where I was, sent from Caesarea unto me.

Caesarea <u>44\_ACT\_08\_40</u> # But Philip was found at Azotus: and passing through he preached in all the cities, till he came to Caesarea.
