Bethmarcaboth and Hazarsusah [06 JOS 19 05](#) # And Ziklag, and Bethmarcaboth, and Hazarsusah,

Bethmarcaboth and Hazarsusim [13 1CH 04 31](#) # And at Bethmarcaboth, and Hazarsusim, and at Bethbirei, and at Shaaraim. These [were] their cities unto the reign of David.

cab of dove's [12 2KI 06 25](#) # And there was a great famine in Samaria: and, behold, they besieged it, until an ass's head was [sold] for fourscore [pieces] of silver, and the fourth part of a cab of dove's dung for five [pieces] of silver.

Cabbon and Lahmam [06 JOS 15 40](#) # And Cabbon, and Lahmam, and Kithlish,

cabins and Jeremiah [24 JER 37 16](#) # When Jeremiah was entered into the dungeon, and into the cabins, and Jeremiah had remained there many days;

Cabul on the [06 JOS 19 27](#) # And turneth toward the sunrising to Bethdagon, and reacheth to Zebulun, and to the valley of Jiphthahel toward the north side of Bethemek, and Neiel, and goeth out to Cabul on the left hand,

Cabul unto this [11 1KI 09 13](#) # And he said, What cities [are] these which thou hast given me, my brother? And he called them the land of Cabul unto this day.

implacable unmerciful [45 ROM 01 31](#) # Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful:

scab and for [03 LEV 14 56](#) # And for a rising, and for a scab, and for a bright spot:

scab and he [03 LEV 13 06](#) # And the priest shall look on him again the seventh day: and, behold, [if] the plague [be] somewhat dark, [and] the plague spread not in the skin, the priest shall pronounce him clean: it [is but] a scab: and he shall wash his clothes, and be clean.

scab and with [05 DEU 28 27](#) # The LORD will smite thee with the botch of Egypt, and with the emerods, and with the scab, and with the itch, whereof thou canst not be healed.

scab or bright [03 LEV 13 02](#) # When a man shall have in the skin of his flesh a rising, a scab, or bright spot, and it be in the skin of his flesh [like] the plague of leprosy; then he shall be brought unto Aaron the priest, or unto one of his sons the priests:

scab spread much [03 LEV 13 07](#) # But if the scab spread much abroad in the skin, after that he hath been seen of the priest for his cleansing, he shall be seen of the priest again:

scab spreadeth in [03 LEV 13 08](#) # And [if] the priest see that, behold, the scab spreadeth in the skin, then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a leprosy.

scab the crown [23 ISA 03 17](#) # Therefore the Lord will smite with a scab the crown of the head of the daughters of Zion, and the LORD will discover their secret parts.

scabbard rest and [24 JER 47 06](#) # O thou sword of the LORD, how long [will it be] ere thou be quiet? put up thyself into thy scabbard, rest, and be still.

scabbed or hath [03 LEV 21 20](#) # Or crookbacked, or a dwarf, or that hath a blemish in his eye, or be scurvy, or scabbed, or hath his stones broken;

scabbed ye shall [03 LEV 22 22](#) # Blind, or broken, or maimed, or having a wen, or scurvy, or scabbed, ye shall not offer these unto the LORD, nor make an offering by fire of them upon the altar unto the LORD.
