cannot attain unto [19\\_PSA\\_139\\_06](#) # [Such] knowledge [is] too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot [attain] unto it.

cannot away with [23\\_ISA\\_01\\_13](#) # Bring no more vain oblations; incense is an abomination unto me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; [it is] iniquity, even the solemn meeting.

cannot bark sleeping [23\\_ISA\\_56\\_10](#) # His watchmen [are] blind: they are all ignorant, they [are] all dumb dogs, they cannot bark; sleeping, lying down, loving to slumber.

cannot be able [02\\_EXO\\_10\\_05](#) # And they shall cover the face of the earth, that one cannot be able to see the earth: and they shall eat the residue of that which is escaped, which remaineth unto you from the hail, and shall eat every tree which groweth for you out of the field:

cannot be broken [43\\_JOH\\_10\\_35](#) # If he called them gods, unto whom the word of God came, and the scripture cannot be broken;

cannot be built [18\\_JOB\\_12\\_14](#) # Behold, he breaketh down, and it cannot be built again: he shutteth up a man, and there can be no opening.

cannot be cleansed [04\\_NUM\\_35\\_33](#) # So ye shall not pollute the land wherein ye [are]: for blood it defileth the land: and the land cannot be cleansed of the blood that is shed therein, but by the blood of him that shed it.

cannot be condemned [56\\_TIT\\_02\\_08](#) # Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.

cannot be eaten [24\\_JER\\_24\\_03](#) # Then said the LORD unto me, What seest thou, Jeremiah? And I said, Figs; the good figs, very good; and the evil, very evil, that cannot be eaten, they are so evil.

cannot be eaten [24\\_JER\\_24\\_08](#) # And as the evil figs, which cannot be eaten, they are so evil; surely thus saith the LORD, So will I give Zedekiah the king of Judah, and his princes, and the residue of Jerusalem, that remain in this land, and them that dwell in the land of Egypt:

cannot be healed [05\\_DEU\\_28\\_35](#) # The LORD shall smite thee in the knees, and in the legs, with a sore botch that cannot be healed, from the sole of thy foot unto the top of thy head.

cannot be hid [54\\_1TI\\_05\\_25](#) # Likewise also the good works [of some] are manifest beforehand; and they that are otherwise cannot be hid.

cannot be hid [40\\_MAT\\_05\\_14](#) # Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

cannot be made [21\\_ECC\\_01\\_15](#) # [That which is] crooked cannot be made straight: and that which is wanting cannot be numbered.

cannot be made [24\\_JER\\_19\\_11](#) # And shalt say unto them, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Even so will I break this people and this city, as [one] breaketh a potter's vessel, that cannot be made whole again: and they shall bury [them] in Tophet, till [there be] no place to bury.

cannot be measured [28\\_HOS\\_01\\_10](#) # Yet the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea, which cannot be measured nor numbered; and it shall come to pass, [that] in the place where it was said unto them, Ye [are] not my people, [there] it shall be said unto them, [Ye are] the sons of the living God.

cannot be moved [58\\_HEB\\_12\\_28](#) # Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear:

cannot be moved [18\\_JOB\\_41\\_23](#) # The flakes of his flesh are joined together: they are firm in themselves; they cannot be moved.

cannot be moved [19\\_PSA\\_93\\_01](#) # The LORD reigneth, he is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed with strength, [wherewith] he hath girded himself: the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved.

cannot be my [42\\_LUK\\_14\\_26](#) # If any [man] come to me, and hate not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yea, and his own life also, he cannot be my disciple.

cannot be my [42\\_LUK\\_14\\_27](#) # And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.

cannot be my [42\\_LUK\\_14\\_33](#) # So likewise, whosoever he be of you that forsaketh not all that he hath, he cannot be my disciple.

cannot be quiet [24\\_JER\\_49\\_23](#) # Concerning Damascus. Hamath is confounded, and Arpad: for they have heard evil tidings: they are fainthearted; [there is] sorrow on the sea; it cannot be quiet.

cannot be reckoned [19\\_PSA\\_40\\_05](#) # Many, O LORD my God, [are] thy wonderful works [which] thou hast done, and thy thoughts [which are] to us ward: they cannot be reckoned up in order unto thee: [if] I

would declare and speak [of them], they are more than can be numbered.

cannot be removed [19\\_PSA\\_125\\_01](#) # A Song of degrees. They that trust in the LORD [shall be] as mount Zion, [which] cannot be removed, [but] abideth for ever.

cannot be satisfied [35\\_HAB\\_02\\_05](#) # Yea also, because he transgresseth by wine, [he is] a proud man, neither keepeth at home, who enlargeth his desire as hell, and [is] as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathereth unto him all nations, and heapeth unto him all people:

cannot be satisfied [18\\_JOB\\_31\\_31](#) # If the men of my tabernacle said not, Oh that we had of his flesh! we cannot be satisfied.

cannot be saved [44\\_ACT\\_15\\_01](#) # And certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, [and said], Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved.

cannot be saved [44\\_ACT\\_27\\_31](#) # Paul said to the centurion and to the soldiers, Except these abide in the ship, ye cannot be saved.

cannot be searched [24\\_JER\\_46\\_23](#) # They shall cut down her forest, saith the LORD, though it cannot be searched; because they are more than the grasshoppers, and [are] innumerable.

cannot be seen [18\\_JOB\\_33\\_21](#) # His flesh is consumed away, that it cannot be seen; and his bones [that] were not seen stick out.

cannot be shaken [58\\_HEB\\_12\\_27](#) # And this [word], Yet once more, signifieth the removing of those things that are shaken, as of things that are made, that those things which cannot be shaken may remain.

cannot be spoken [44\\_ACT\\_19\\_36](#) # Seeing then that these things cannot be spoken against, ye ought to be quiet, and to do nothing rashly.

cannot be sundered [18\\_JOB\\_41\\_17](#) # They are joined one to another, they stick together, that they cannot be sundered.

cannot be taken [10\\_2SA\\_23\\_06](#) # But [the sons] of Belial [shall be] all of them as thorns thrust away, because they cannot be taken with hands:

cannot be tempted [59\\_JAM\\_01\\_13](#) # Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man:

cannot be touched [58\\_HEB\\_04\\_15](#) # For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as [we are, yet] without sin.

cannot be uttered [45\\_ROM\\_08\\_26](#) # Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

cannot be valued [18\\_JOB\\_28\\_16](#) # It cannot be valued with the gold of Ophir, with the precious onyx, or the sapphire.

cannot bear fruit [43\\_JOH\\_15\\_04](#) # Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

cannot bear them [43\\_JOH\\_16\\_12](#) # I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now.

cannot bear [20\\_PRO\\_30\\_21](#) # For three [things] the earth is disquieted, and for four [which] it cannot bear:

cannot behold him [18\\_JOB\\_23\\_09](#) # On the left hand, where he doth work, but I cannot behold [him]: he hideth himself on the right hand, that I cannot see [him]:

cannot bring forth [40\\_MAT\\_07\\_18](#) # A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither [can] a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

cannot bring forth [40\\_MAT\\_07\\_18](#) # A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither [can] a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

cannot but speak [44\\_ACT\\_04\\_20](#) # For we cannot but speak the things which we have seen and heard.

cannot cease from [61\\_2PE\\_02\\_14](#) # Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children:

cannot come down [16\\_NEH\\_06\\_03](#) # And I sent messengers unto them, saying, I [am] doing a great work, so that I cannot come down: why should the work cease, whilst I leave it, and come down to you?

cannot come forth [19\\_PSA\\_88\\_08](#) # Thou hast put away mine acquaintance far from me; thou hast made me an abomination unto them: [I am] shut up, and I cannot come forth.

cannot come in [10\\_2SA\\_05\\_06](#) # And the king and his men went to Jerusalem unto the Jebusites, the inhabitants of the land: which spake unto David, saying, Except thou take away the blind and the lame, thou shalt not come in hither: thinking, David cannot come in hither.

cannot come so [43\\_JOH\\_13\\_33](#) # Little children, yet a little while I am with you. Ye shall seek me: and as I said unto the Jews, Whither I go, ye cannot come; so now I say to you.

cannot come up [02\\_EXO\\_19\\_23](#) # And Moses said unto the LORD, The people cannot come up to mount Sinai: for thou chargedst us, saying, Set bounds about the mount, and sanctify it.

cannot come [43\\_JOH\\_07\\_34](#) # Ye shall seek me, and shall not find [me]: and where I am, [thither] ye cannot come.

cannot come [43\\_JOH\\_07\\_36](#) # What [manner of] saying is this that he said, Ye shall seek me, and shall not find [me]: and where I am, [thither] ye cannot come?

cannot come [43\\_JOH\\_08\\_21](#) # Then said Jesus again unto them, I go my way, and ye shall seek me, and shall die in your sins: whither I go, ye cannot come.

cannot come [43\\_JOH\\_08\\_22](#) # Then said the Jews, Will he kill himself? because he saith, Whither I go, ye cannot come.

cannot come [42\\_LUK\\_14\\_20](#) # And another said, I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.

cannot comprehend [18\\_JOB\\_37\\_05](#) # God thundereth marvellously with his voice; great things doeth he, which we cannot comprehend.

cannot contain him [14\\_2CH\\_02\\_06](#) # But who is able to build him an house, seeing the heaven and heaven of heavens cannot contain him? who [am] I then, that I should build him an house, save only to burn sacrifice before him?

cannot contain let [46\\_1CO\\_07\\_09](#) # But if they cannot contain, let them marry: for it is better to marry than to burn.

cannot contain thee [11\\_1KI\\_08\\_27](#) # But will God indeed dwell on the earth? behold, the heaven and heaven of heavens cannot contain thee; how much less this house that I have builded?

cannot contain thee [14\\_2CH\\_06\\_18](#) # But will God in very deed dwell with men on the earth? behold, heaven and the heaven of heavens cannot contain thee; how much less this house which I have built!

cannot declare it [07\\_JUD\\_14\\_13](#) # But if ye cannot declare [it] me, then shall ye give me thirty sheets and thirty change of garments. And they said unto him, Put forth thy riddle, that we may hear it.

cannot defile him [41\\_MAR\\_07\\_18](#) # And he saith unto them, Are ye so without understanding also? Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, [it] cannot defile him;

cannot deliver his [23\\_ISA\\_44\\_20](#) # He feedeth on ashes: a deceived heart hath turned him aside, that he cannot deliver his soul, nor say, [Is there] not a lie in my right hand?

cannot deliver thee [18\\_JOB\\_36\\_18](#) # Because [there is] wrath, [beware] lest he take thee away with [his] stroke: then a great ransom cannot deliver thee.

cannot deny himself [55\\_2TI\\_02\\_13](#) # If we believe not, [yet] he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself.

cannot deny it [44\\_ACT\\_04\\_16](#) # Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them [is] manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and we cannot deny [it].

cannot dig to [42\\_LUK\\_16\\_03](#) # Then the steward said within himself, What shall I do? for my lord taketh away from me the stewardship: I cannot dig; to beg I am ashamed.

cannot disannul that [48\\_GAL\\_03\\_17](#) # And this I say, [that] the covenant, that was confirmed before of God in Christ, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should make the promise of none effect.

cannot discern between [32\\_JON\\_04\\_11](#) # And should not I spare Nineveh, that great city, wherein are more than sixscore thousand persons that cannot discern between their right hand and their left hand; and [also] much cattle?

cannot do any [01\\_GEN\\_19\\_22](#) # Haste thee, escape thither; for I cannot do any thing till thou be come thither. Therefore the name of the city was called Zoar.

cannot do evil [24\\_JER\\_10\\_05](#) # They [are] upright as the palm tree, but speak not: they must needs be borne, because they cannot go. Be not afraid of them; for they cannot do evil, neither also [is it] in them to do good.

cannot drink the [46\\_1CO\\_10\\_21](#) # Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.

cannot enter into [43\\_JOH\\_03\\_05](#) # Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and [of] the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

cannot enter [23 ISA 59 14](#) # And judgment is turned away backward, and justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter.

cannot equal it [18 JOB 28 17](#) # The gold and the crystal cannot equal it: and the exchange of it [shall not be for] jewels of fine gold.

cannot escape to [01 GEN 19 19](#) # Behold now, thy servant hath found grace in thy sight, and thou hast magnified thy mercy, which thou hast showed unto me in saving my life; and I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die:

cannot fast [41 MAR 02 19](#) # And Jesus said unto them, Can the children of the bridechamber fast, while the bridegroom is with them? as long as they have the bridegroom with them, they cannot fast.

cannot find her [01 GEN 38 22](#) # And he returned to Judah, and said, I cannot find her; and also the men of the place said, [that] there was no harlot in this [place].

cannot find him [18 JOB 37 23](#) # [Touching] the Almighty, we cannot find him out: [he is] excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice: he will not afflict.

cannot find one [18 JOB 17 10](#) # But as for you all, do ye return, and come now: for I cannot find [one] wise [man] among you.

cannot find out [21 ECC 08 17](#) # Then I beheld all the work of God, that a man cannot find out the work that is done under the sun: because though a man labour to seek [it] out, yet he shall not find [it]; yea farther; though a wise [man] think to know [it], yet shall he not be able to find [it].

cannot find thee [11 1KI 18 12](#) # And it shall come to pass, [as soon as] I am gone from thee, that the spirit of the LORD shall carry thee whither I know not; and [so] when I come and tell Ahab, and he cannot find thee, he shall slay me: but I thy servant fear the LORD from my youth.

cannot for it [23 ISA 29 11](#) # And the vision of all is become unto you as the words of a book that is sealed, which [men] deliver to one that is learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith, I cannot; for it [is] sealed:

cannot get out [25 LAM 03 07](#) # He hath hedged me about, that I cannot get out: he hath made my chain heavy.

cannot get so [03 LEV 14 21](#) # And if he [be] poor, and cannot get so much; then he shall take one lamb [for] a trespass offering to be waved, to make an atonement for him, and one tenth deal of fine flour mingled with oil for a meat offering, and a log of oil;

cannot go back [07 JUD 11 35](#) # And it came to pass, when he saw her, that he rent his clothes, and said, Alas, my daughter! thou hast brought me very low, and thou art one of them that trouble me: for I have opened my mouth unto the LORD, and I cannot go back.

cannot go Be [24 JER 10 05](#) # They [are] upright as the palm tree, but speak not: they must needs be borne, because they cannot go. Be not afraid of them; for they cannot do evil, neither also [is it] in them to do good.

cannot go beyond [04 NUM 22 18](#) # And Balaam answered and said unto the servants of Balak, If Balak would give me his house full of silver and gold, I cannot go beyond the word of the LORD my God, to do less or more.

cannot go beyond [04 NUM 24 13](#) # If Balak would give me his house full of silver and gold, I cannot go



beyond the commandment of the LORD, to do [either] good or bad of mine own mind; [but] what the LORD saith, that will I speak?

cannot go down [01\\_GEN\\_44\\_26](#) # And we said, We cannot go down: if our youngest brother be with us, then will we go down: for we may not see the man's face, except our youngest brother [be] with us.

cannot go in [25\\_LAM\\_04\\_18](#) # They hunt our steps, that we cannot go in our streets: our end is near, our days are fulfilled; for our end is come.

cannot go into [24\\_JER\\_36\\_05](#) # And Jeremiah commanded Baruch, saying, I [am] shut up; I cannot go into the house of the LORD:

cannot go with [09\\_ISA\\_17\\_39](#) # And David girded his sword upon his armour, and he assayed to go; for he had not proved [it]. And David said unto Saul, I cannot go with these; for I have not proved [them]. And David put them off him.

cannot hate you [43\\_JOH\\_07\\_07](#) # The world cannot hate you; but me it hateth, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil.

cannot hear my [43\\_JOH\\_08\\_43](#) # Why do ye not understand my speech? [even] because ye cannot hear my word.

cannot hear [23\\_ISA\\_59\\_01](#) # Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear:

cannot hearken behold [24\\_JER\\_06\\_10](#) # To whom shall I speak, and give warning, that they may hear? behold, their ear [is] uncircumcised, and they cannot hearken: behold, the word of the LORD is unto them a reproach; they have no delight in it.

cannot hold my [24\\_JER\\_04\\_19](#) # My bowels, my bowels! I am pained at my very heart; my heart maketh a noise in me; I cannot hold my peace, because thou hast heard, O my soul, the sound of the trumpet, the alarm of war.

cannot hold the [18\\_JOB\\_41\\_26](#) # The sword of him that layeth at him cannot hold: the spear, the dart, nor the habergeon.

cannot hope for [23\\_ISA\\_38\\_18](#) # For the grave cannot praise thee, death can [not] celebrate thee: they that go down into the pit cannot hope for thy truth.

cannot I do [24\\_JER\\_18\\_06](#) # O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith the LORD. Behold, as the clay [is] in the potter's hand, so [are] ye in mine hand, O house of Israel.

cannot I follow [43\\_JOH\\_13\\_37](#) # Peter said unto him, Lord, why cannot I follow thee now? I will lay down my life for thy sake.

cannot inherit the [46\\_1CO\\_15\\_50](#) # Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

cannot leave his [01\\_GEN\\_44\\_22](#) # And we said unto my lord, The lad cannot leave his father: for [if] he should leave his father, [his father] would die.

cannot lie promised [56\\_TIT\\_01\\_02](#) # In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;

cannot make him [18\\_JOB\\_41\\_28](#) # The arrow cannot make him flee: slingstones are turned with him into

stubble.

cannot my taste [18\\_JOB\\_06\\_30](#) # Is there iniquity in my tongue? cannot my taste discern perverse things?

cannot neither can [42\\_LUK\\_16\\_26](#) # And beside all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed: so that they which would pass from hence to you cannot; neither can they pass to us, that [would come] from thence.

cannot now pray [40\\_MAT\\_26\\_53](#) # Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and he shall presently give me more than twelve legions of angels?

cannot now speak [58\\_HEB\\_09\\_05](#) # And over it the cherubims of glory shadowing the mercyseat; of which we cannot now speak particularly.

cannot obtain ye [59\\_JAM\\_04\\_02](#) # Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not.

cannot order our [18\\_JOB\\_37\\_19](#) # Teach us what we shall say unto him; [for] we cannot order [our speech] by reason of darkness.

cannot overthrow it [44\\_ACT\\_05\\_39](#) # But if it be of God, ye cannot overthrow it; lest haply ye be found even to fight against God.

cannot pass and [18\\_JOB\\_19\\_08](#) # He hath fenced up my way that I cannot pass, and he hath set darkness in my paths.

cannot pass it [24\\_JER\\_05\\_22](#) # Fear ye not me? saith the LORD: will ye not tremble at my presence, which have placed the sand [for] the bound of the sea by a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass it: and though the waves thereof toss themselves, yet can they not prevail; though they roar, yet can they not pass over it?

cannot praise thee [23\\_ISA\\_38\\_18](#) # For the grave cannot praise thee, death can [not] celebrate thee: they that go down into the pit cannot hope for thy truth.

cannot profit nor [09\\_1SA\\_12\\_21](#) # And turn ye not aside: for [then should ye go] after vain [things], which cannot profit nor deliver; for they [are] vain.

cannot profit [24\\_JER\\_07\\_08](#) # Behold, ye trust in lying words, that cannot profit.
