

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

coat a mitre <u>02\_EXO\_28\_04</u> # And these [are] the garments which they shall make; a breastplate, and an ephod, and a robe, and a broidered coat, a mitre, and a girdle: and they shall make holy garments for Aaron thy brother, and his sons, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

coat also <u>42\_LUK\_06\_29</u> # And unto him that smiteth thee on the [one] cheek offer also the other; and him that taketh away thy cloak forbid not [to take thy] coat also.

coat an evil <u>01\_GEN\_37\_33</u># And he knew it, and said, [It is] my son's coat; an evil beast hath devoured him; Joseph is without doubt rent in pieces.
