companion and every <u>02_EXO_32_27</u> # And he said unto them, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Put every man his sword by his side, [and] go in and out from gate to gate throughout the camp, and slay every man his brother, and every man his companion, and every man his neighbour.

companion And the <u>07_JUD_15_06</u># Then the Philistines said, Who hath done this? And they answered, Samson, the son in law of the Timnite, because he had taken his wife, and given her to his companion. And the Philistines came up, and burnt her and her father with fire.

companion and the <u>39_MAL_02_14</u># Yet ye say, Wherefore? Because the LORD hath been witness between thee and the wife of thy youth, against whom thou hast dealt treacherously: yet [is] she thy companion, and the wife of thy covenant.

companion in labour <u>50_PHP_02_25</u># Yet I supposed it necessary to send to you Epaphroditus, my brother, and companion in labour, and fellowsoldier, but your messenger, and he that ministered to my wants.

companion in tribulation <u>66_REV_01_09</u># I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

companion is not <u>07_JUD_15_02</u> # And her father said, I verily thought that thou hadst utterly hated her; therefore I gave her to thy companion: [is] not her younger sister fairer than she? take her, I pray thee, instead of her.

companion of a <u>20_PRO_28_24</u># Whoso robbeth his father or his mother, and saith, [It is] no transgression; the same [is] the companion of a destroyer.

companion of all <u>19_PSA_119_63</u># I [am] a companion of all [them] that fear thee, and of them that keep thy precepts.

companion of fools <u>20_PRO_13_20</u># He that walketh with wise [men] shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed.

companion of riotous <u>20_PRO_28_07</u> # Whoso keepeth the law [is] a wise son: but he that is a companion of riotous [men] shameth his father.

companion to owls 18_JOB_30_29 # I am a brother to dragons, and a companion to owls.

companion whom he <u>07_JUD_14_20</u> # But Samson's wife was [given] to his companion, whom he had used as his friend.

companion <u>13_1CH_27_33</u> # And Ahithophel [was] the king's counsellor: and Hushai the Archite [was] the king's companion:

companions according to <u>15_EZR_06_13</u> # Then Tatnai, governor on this side the river, Shetharboznai, and their companions, according to that which Darius the king had sent, so they did speedily.

companions and bewailed 07_JUD_11_38 # And he said, Go. And he sent her away [for] two months: and

she went with her companions, and bewailed her virginity upon the mountains.

companions and said <u>15_EZR_05_03</u># At the same time came to them Tatnai, governor on this side the river, and Shetharboznai, and their companions, and said thus unto them, Who hath commanded you to build this house, and to make up this wall?

companions hearken to <u>22_SON_08_13</u># Thou that dwellest in the gardens, the companions hearken to thy voice: cause me to hear [it].

companions in travel <u>44_ACT_19_29</u># And the whole city was filled with confusion: and having caught Gaius and Aristarchus, men of Macedonia, Paul's companions in travel, they rushed with one accord into the theatre.

companions make a <u>18_JOB_41_06</u># Shall the companions make a banquet of him? shall they part him among the merchants?

companions of them <u>58_HEB_10_33</u> # Partly, whilst ye were made a gazingstock both by reproaches and afflictions; and partly, whilst ye became companions of them that were so used.

companions of thieves <u>23_ISA_01_23</u># Thy princes [are] rebellious, and companions of thieves: every one loveth gifts, and followeth after rewards: they judge not the fatherless, neither doth the cause of the widow come unto them.

companions sakes I <u>19_PSA_122_08</u># For my brethren and companions' sakes, I will now say, Peace [be] within thee.

companions that dwell <u>15_EZR_04_17</u> # [Then] sent the king an answer unto Rehum the chancellor, and [to] Shimshai the scribe, and [to] the rest of their companions that dwell in Samaria, and [unto] the rest beyond the river, Peace, and at such a time.

companions that follow 19_PSA_45_14 # She shall be brought unto the king in raiment of needlework: the virgins her companions that follow her shall be brought unto thee.

companions the Apharsachites <u>15_EZR_05_06</u># The copy of the letter that Tatnai, governor on this side the river, and Shetharboznai, and his companions the Apharsachites, which [were] on this side the river, sent unto Darius the king:

companions the Apharsachites <u>15_EZR_06_06</u> # Now [therefore], Tatnai, governor beyond the river, Shetharboznai, and your companions the Apharsachites, which [are] beyond the river, be ye far from thence:

companions the Dinaites <u>15_EZR_04_09</u> # Then [wrote] Rehum the chancellor, and Shimshai the scribe, and the rest of their companions; the Dinaites, the Apharsathchites, the Tarpelites, the Apharsites, the Archevites, the Babylonians, the Susanchites, the Dehavites, [and] the Elamites,

companions then take <u>26_EZE_37_16</u># Moreover, thou son of man, take thee one stick, and write upon it, For Judah, and for the children of Israel his companions: then take another stick, and write upon it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and [for] all the house of Israel his companions:

companions they went <u>15 EZR 04 23 #</u> Now when the copy of king Artaxerxes' letter [was] read before Rehum, and Shimshai the scribe, and their companions, they went up in haste to Jerusalem unto the Jews, and made them to cease by force and power.

companions <u>26_EZE_37_16</u># Moreover, thou son of man, take thee one stick, and write upon it, For Judah, and for the children of Israel his companions: then take another stick, and write upon it, For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and [for] all the house of Israel his companions:

companions 22_SON_01_07_# Tell me, O thou whom my soul loveth, where thou feedest, where thou makest [thy flock] to rest at noon: for why should I be as one that turneth aside by the flocks of thy companions?
