

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

damsel abide with <u>01\_GEN\_24\_55</u> # And her brother and her mother said, Let the damsel abide with us [a few] days, at the least ten; after that she shall go.

damsel and her <u>05\_DEU\_22\_15</u># Then shall the father of the damsel, and her mother, take and bring forth [the tokens of] the damsel's virginity unto the elders of the city in the gate:

damsel and inquire <u>01\_GEN\_24\_57</u># And they said, We will call the damsel, and inquire at her mouth.

damsel and she <u>40\_MAT\_14\_11</u># And his head was brought in a charger, and given to the damsel: and she brought [it] to her mother.

damsel and spake <u>01\_GEN\_34\_03</u> # And his soul clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob, and he loved the damsel, and spake kindly unto the damsel.

damsel and the <u>41\_MAR\_06\_28</u># And brought his head in a charger, and gave it to the damsel: and the damsel gave it to her mother.

damsel and them <u>41\_MAR\_05\_40</u># And they laughed him to scorn. But when he had put them all out, he taketh the father and the mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying.

damsel arose and <u>41\_MAR\_05\_42</u> # And straightway the damsel arose, and walked; for she was [of the age] of twelve years. And they were astonished with a great astonishment.

damsel Ask of <u>41 MAR\_06\_22</u># And when the daughter of the said Herodias came in, and danced, and pleased Herod and them that sat with him, the king said unto the damsel, Ask of me whatsoever thou wilt, and I will give [it] thee.

damsel because he <u>05\_DEU\_22\_19</u># And they shall amerce him in an hundred [shekels] of silver, and give [them] unto the father of the damsel, because he hath brought up an evil name upon a virgin of Israel: and she shall be his wife; he may not put her away all his days.

damsel because she <u>05\_DEU\_22\_24</u># Then ye shall bring them both out unto the gate of that city, and ye shall stone them with stones that they die; the damsel, because she cried not, [being] in the city; and the man, because he hath humbled his neighbour's wife: so thou shalt put away evil from among you.

damsel by the <u>41\_MAR\_05\_41</u># And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise.

damsel came to <u>44\_ACT\_12\_13</u># And as Peter knocked at the door of the gate, a damsel came to hearken, named Rhoda.

damsel came unto 40\_MAT\_26\_69 # Now Peter sat without in the palace: and a damsel came unto him, saying, Thou also wast with Jesus of Galilee.

damsel cried and <u>05\_DEU\_22\_27</u># For he found her in the field, [and] the betrothed damsel cried, and [there was] none to save her.

damsel gave it 41\_MAR\_06\_28 # And brought his head in a charger, and gave it to the damsel: and the damsel gave it to her mother.

Damsel I say <u>41\_MAR\_05\_41</u># And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise.

damsel in the <u>05\_DEU\_22\_25</u># But if a man find a betrothed damsel in the field, and the man force her, and lie with her: then the man only that lay with her shall die:

damsel is not <u>41\_MAR\_05\_39</u> # And when he was come in, he saith unto them, Why make ye this ado, and weep? the damsel is not dead, but sleepeth.

damsel is this <u>08\_RUT\_02\_05</u># Then said Boaz unto his servant that was set over the reapers, Whose damsel [is] this?

damsel no sin <u>05\_DEU\_22\_26</u># But unto the damsel thou shalt do nothing; [there is] in the damsel no sin [worthy] of death: for as when a man riseth against his neighbour, and slayeth him, even so [is] this matter:

damsel or two <u>07\_JUD\_05\_30</u># Have they not sped? have they [not] divided the prey; to every man a damsel [or] two; to Sisera a prey of divers colours, a prey of divers colours of needlework, of divers colours of needlework on both sides, [meet] for the necks of [them that take] the spoil?

damsel possessed with <u>44\_ACT\_16\_16</u># And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying:

damsel ran and 01\_GEN\_24\_28 # And the damsel ran, and told [them of] her mother's house these things.

damsel saw him <u>07\_JUD\_19\_03</u># And her husband arose, and went after her, to speak friendly unto her, [and] to bring her again, having his servant with him, and a couple of asses: and she brought him into her father's house: and when the father of the damsel saw him, he rejoiced to meet him.

damsel that came <u>08\_RUT\_02\_06</u> # And the servant that was set over the reapers answered and said, It [is] the Moabitish damsel that came back with Naomi out of the country of Moab:

damsel that is <u>05\_DEU\_22\_23</u> # If a damsel [that is] a virgin be betrothed unto an husband, and a man find her in the city, and lie with her;

damsel that is <u>05\_DEU\_22\_28</u># If a man find a damsel [that is] a virgin, which is not betrothed, and lay hold on her, and lie with her, and they be found;

damsel that kept <u>43\_JOH\_18\_17</u> # Then saith the damsel that kept the door unto Peter, Art not thou also [one] of this man's disciples? He saith, I am not.

damsel thou shalt <u>05\_DEU\_22\_26</u># But unto the damsel thou shalt do nothing; [there is] in the damsel no sin [worthy] of death: for as when a man riseth against his neighbour, and slayeth him, even so [is] this matter:

damsel throughout all <u>11\_1KI\_01\_03</u># So they sought for a fair damsel throughout all the coasts of Israel, and found Abishag a Shunammite, and brought her to the king.

damsel to the <u>05\_DEU\_22\_21</u># Then they shall bring out the damsel to the door of her father's house, and the men of her city shall stone her with stones that she die: because she hath wrought folly in Israel, to play the whore in her father's house: so shalt thou put evil away from among you.

damsel to whom 01\_GEN\_24\_14 # And let it come to pass, that the damsel to whom I shall say, Let down

thy pitcher, I pray thee, that I may drink; and she shall say, Drink, and I will give thy camels drink also: [let the same be] she [that] thou hast appointed for thy servant Isaac; and thereby shall I know that thou hast showed kindness unto my master.

damsel to wife <u>01\_GEN\_34\_04</u># And Shechem spake unto his father Hamor, saying, Get me this damsel to wife.

damsel to wife <u>01\_GEN\_34\_12</u> # Ask me never so much dowry and gift, and I will give according as ye shall say unto me: but give me the damsel to wife.

damsel was lying <u>41\_MAR\_05\_40</u># And they laughed him to scorn. But when he had put them all out, he taketh the father and the mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying.

damsel was very 11\_1KI\_01\_04 # And the damsel [was] very fair, and cherished the king, and ministered to him: but the king knew her not.

damsel was very <u>01\_GEN\_24\_16</u> # And the damsel [was] very fair to look upon, a virgin, neither had any man known her: and she went down to the well, and filled her pitcher, and came up.

damsel 05\_DEU\_22\_20 # But if this thing be true, [and the tokens of] virginity be not found for the damsel:

damsel <u>01\_GEN\_34\_03</u># And his soul clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob, and he loved the damsel, and spake kindly unto the damsel.

damsel's father fifty <u>05 DEU 22 29 #</u> Then the man that lay with her shall give unto the damsel's father fifty [shekels] of silver, and she shall be his wife; because he hath humbled her, he may not put her away all his days.

damsel's father had <u>07\_JUD\_19\_06</u># And they sat down, and did eat and drink both of them together: for the damsel's father had said unto the man, Be content, I pray thee, and tarry all night, and let thine heart be merry.

damsel's father retained <u>07\_JUD\_19\_04</u> # And his father in law, the damsel's father, retained him; and he abode with him three days: so they did eat and drink, and lodged there.

damsel's father said <u>07\_JUD\_19\_05</u># And it came to pass on the fourth day, when they arose early in the morning, that he rose up to depart: and the damsel's father said unto his son in law, Comfort thine heart with a morsel of bread, and afterward go your way.

damsel's father said <u>07\_JUD\_19\_08</u># And he arose early in the morning on the fifth day to depart: and the damsel's father said, Comfort thine heart, I pray thee. And they tarried until afternoon, and they did eat both of them.

damsel's father said <u>07\_JUD\_19\_09</u># And when the man rose up to depart, he, and his concubine, and his servant, his father in law, the damsel's father, said unto him, Behold, now the day draweth toward evening, I pray you tarry all night: behold, the day groweth to an end, lodge here, that thine heart may be merry; and to morrow get you early on your way, that thou mayest go home.

damsel's father shall <u>05\_DEU\_22\_16</u># And the damsel's father shall say unto the elders, I gave my daughter unto this man to wife, and he hateth her;

damsel's virginity unto <u>05\_DEU\_22\_15</u># Then shall the father of the damsel, and her mother, take and bring forth [the tokens of] the damsel's virginity unto the elders of the city in the gate:

damsels and they <u>01\_GEN\_24\_61</u># And Rebekah arose, and her damsels, and they rode upon the camels, and followed the man: and the servant took Rebekah, and went his way.

damsels of hers <u>09\_1SA\_25\_42</u> # And Abigail hasted, and arose, and rode upon an ass, with five damsels of hers that went after her; and she went after the messengers of David, and became his wife.

damsels playing with 19 PSA 68 25 # The singers went before, the players on instruments [followed] after; among [them were] the damsels playing with timbrels.
