devise a device 24\_JER\_18\_11\_# Now therefore go to, speak to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I frame evil against you, and devise a device against you: return ye now every one from his evil way, and make your ways and your doings good.

devise an evil <u>33\_MIC\_02\_03</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD; Behold, against this family do I devise an evil, from which ye shall not remove your necks; neither shall ye go haughtily: for this time [is] evil.

devise cunning work <u>02\_EXO\_35\_35</u># Them hath he filled with wisdom of heart, to work all manner of work, of the engraver, and of the cunning workman, and of the embroiderer, in blue, and in purple, in scarlet, and in fine linen, and of the weaver, [even] of them that do any work, and of those that devise cunning work.

devise cunning works <u>02\_EXO\_31\_04</u> # To devise cunning works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass,

devise curious works <u>02\_EXO\_35\_32</u># And to devise curious works, to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass,

devise deceitful matters 19\_PSA\_35\_20 # For they speak not peace: but they devise deceitful matters against [them that are] quiet in the land.

devise devices against <u>24\_JER\_18\_18</u> # Then said they, Come, and let us devise devices against Jeremiah; for the law shall not perish from the priest, nor counsel from the wise, nor the word from the prophet. Come, and let us smite him with the tongue, and let us not give heed to any of his words.

devise evil but <u>20\_PRO\_14\_22</u> # Do they not err that devise evil? but mercy and truth [shall be] to them that devise good.

devise froward things <u>20\_PRO\_16\_30</u># He shutteth his eyes to devise froward things: moving his lips he bringeth evil to pass.

devise good 20\_PRO\_14\_22 # Do they not err that devise evil? but mercy and truth [shall be] to them that devise good.

devise iniquity and <u>33\_MIC\_02\_01</u># Woe to them that devise iniquity, and work evil upon their beds! when the morning is light, they practice it, because it is in the power of their hand.

devise means that <u>10\_2SA\_14\_14</u># For we must needs die, and [are] as water spilled on the ground, which cannot be gathered up again; neither doth God respect [any] person: yet doth he devise means, that his banished be not expelled from him.

devise mischief and <u>26\_EZE\_11\_02</u># Then said he unto me, Son of man, these [are] the men that devise mischief, and give wicked counsel in this city:

devise my hurt 19 PSA 35 04 # Let them be confounded and put to shame that seek after my soul: let them be turned back and brought to confusion that devise my hurt.

devise my hurt 19\_PSA\_41\_07 # All that hate me whisper together against me: against me do they devise

my hurt.

Devise not evil 20\_PRO\_03\_29 # Devise not evil against thy neighbour, seeing he dwelleth securely by thee.

devised against the <u>17\_EST\_08\_03</u># And Esther spake yet again before the king, and fell down at his feet, and besought him with tears to put away the mischief of Haman the Agagite, and his device that he had devised against the Jews.

devised against the <u>17\_EST\_09\_24</u># Because Haman the son of Hammedatha, the Agagite, the enemy of all the Jews, had devised against the Jews to destroy them, and had cast Pur, that [is], the lot, to consume them, and to destroy them;

devised against the <u>17\_EST\_09\_25</u># But when [Esther] came before the king, he commanded by letters that his wicked device, which he devised against the Jews, should return upon his own head, and that he and his sons should be hanged on the gallows.

devised against us <u>10\_2SA\_21\_05</u># And they answered the king, The man that consumed us, and that devised against us [that] we should be destroyed from remaining in any of the coasts of Israel,

devised and done <u>24\_JER\_51\_12</u># Set up the standard upon the walls of Babylon, make the watch strong, set up the watchmen, prepare the ambushes: for the LORD hath both devised and done that which he spake against the inhabitants of Babylon.

devised by Haman 17\_EST\_08\_05 # And said, If it please the king, and if I have found favour in his sight, and the thing [seem] right before the king, and I [be] pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which [are] in all the king's provinces:

devised devices against <u>24 JER\_11\_19</u># But I [was] like a lamb [or] an ox [that] is brought to the slaughter; and I knew not that they had devised devices against me, [saying], Let us destroy the tree with the fruit thereof, and let us cut him off from the land of the living, that his name may be no more remembered.

devised evil against <u>24\_JER\_48\_02</u># [There shall be] no more praise of Moab: in Heshbon they have devised evil against it; come, and let us cut it off from [being] a nation. Also thou shalt be cut down, O Madmen; the sword shall pursue thee.

devised fables when  $61_2PE_01_16$ # For we have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known unto you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of his majesty.

devised he hath <u>25\_LAM\_02\_17</u> # The LORD hath done [that] which he had devised; he hath fulfilled his word that he had commanded in the days of old: he hath thrown down, and hath not pitied: and he hath caused [thine] enemy to rejoice over thee, he hath set up the horn of thine adversaries.

devised of his 11\_1KI\_12\_33 # So he offered upon the altar which he had made in Bethel the fifteenth day of the eighth month, [even] in the month which he had devised of his own heart; and ordained a feast unto the children of Israel: and he offered upon the altar, and burnt incense.

devised to take 19\_PSA\_31\_13 # For I have heard the slander of many: fear [was] on every side: while they took counsel together against me, they devised to take away my life.

deviseth his way 20\_PRO\_16\_09 # A man's heart deviseth his way: but the LORD directeth his steps.

deviseth liberal things <u>23\_ISA\_32\_08</u># But the liberal deviseth liberal things; and by liberal things shall he stand.

deviseth mischief continually <u>20\_PRO\_06\_14</u># Frowardness [is] in his heart, he deviseth mischief continually; he soweth discord.

deviseth mischief upon 19\_PSA\_36\_04 # He deviseth mischief upon his bed; he setteth himself in a way [that is] not good; he abhorreth not evil.

deviseth mischiefs like 19 PSA 52 02 # Thy tongue deviseth mischiefs; like a sharp razor, working deceitfully.

deviseth to do 20\_PRO\_24\_08 # He that deviseth to do evil shall be called a mischievous person.

deviseth wicked devices 23\_ISA\_32\_07 # The instruments also of the churl [are] evil: he deviseth wicked devices to destroy the poor with lying words, even when the needy speaketh right.

deviseth wicked imaginations <u>20\_PRO\_06\_18</u># An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief,
