devour Abimelech <u>07\_JUD\_09\_20</u># But if not, let fire come out from Abimelech, and devour the men of Shechem, and the house of Millo; and let fire come out from the men of Shechem, and from the house of Millo, and devour Abimelech.

devour all round 24 JER\_50\_32 # And the most proud shall stumble and fall, and none shall raise him up: and I will kindle a fire in his cities, and it shall devour all round about him.

devour all the <u>38\_ZEC\_12\_06</u># In that day will I make the governors of Judah like an hearth of fire among the wood, and like a torch of fire in a sheaf; and they shall devour all the people round about, on the right hand and on the left: and Jerusalem shall be inhabited again in her own place, [even] in Jerusalem.

devour all things 24\_JER\_21\_14 # But I will punish you according to the fruit of your doings, saith the LORD: and I will kindle a fire in the forest thereof, and it shall devour all things round about it.

devour and destroy 24\_JER\_15\_03 # And I will appoint over them four kinds, saith the LORD: the sword to slay, and the dogs to tear, and the fowls of the heaven, and the beasts of the earth, to devour and destroy.

devour and it <u>24\_JER\_46\_10</u># For this [is] the day of the Lord GOD of hosts, a day of vengeance, that he may avenge him of his adversaries: and the sword shall devour, and it shall be satiate and made drunk with their blood: for the Lord GOD of hosts hath a sacrifice in the north country by the river Euphrates.

devour and subdue <u>38\_ZEC\_09\_15</u> # The LORD of hosts shall defend them; and they shall devour, and subdue with sling stones; and they shall drink, [and] make a noise as through wine; and they shall be filled like bowls, [and] as the corners of the altar.

devour at once <u>23\_ISA\_42\_14</u> # I have long time holden my peace; I have been still, [and] refrained myself: [now] will I cry like a travailing woman; I will destroy and devour at once.

devour before him 19\_PSA\_50\_03 # Our God shall come, and shall not keep silence: a fire shall devour before him, and it shall be very tempestuous round about him.

devour every green <u>26\_EZE\_20\_47</u># And say to the forest of the south, Hear the word of the LORD; Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will kindle a fire in thee, and it shall devour every green tree in thee, and every dry tree: the flaming flame shall not be quenched, and all faces from the south to the north shall be burned therein.

devour flesh and <u>05\_DEU\_32\_42</u># I will make mine arrows drunk with blood, and my sword shall devour flesh; [and that] with the blood of the slain and of the captives, from the beginning of revengers upon the enemy.

devour for ever <u>10\_2SA\_02\_26</u> # Then Abner called to Joab, and said, Shall the sword devour for ever? knowest thou not that it will be bitterness in the latter end? how long shall it be then, ere thou bid the people return from following their brethren?

devour from the <u>24\_JER\_12\_12</u># The spoilers are come upon all high places through the wilderness: for the sword of the LORD shall devour from the [one] end of the land even to the [other] end of the land: no flesh shall have peace.

devour her child <u>66\_REV\_12\_04</u># And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

devour him but <u>23\_ISA\_31\_08</u># Then shall the Assyrian fall with the sword, not of a mighty man; and the sword, not of a mean man, shall devour him: but he shall flee from the sword, and his young men shall be discomfited.

devour him shall <u>24\_JER\_02\_03</u> # Israel [was] holiness unto the LORD, [and] the firstfruits of his increase: all that devour him shall offend; evil shall come upon them, saith the LORD.

devour him <u>26\_EZE\_07\_15</u># The sword [is] without, and the pestilence and the famine within: he that [is] in the field shall die with the sword; and he that [is] in the city, famine and pestilence shall devour him.

devour his strength <u>18\_JOB\_18\_13</u> # It shall devour the strength of his skin: [even] the firstborn of death shall devour his strength.

devour his thorns 23 ISA 10 17 # And the light of Israel shall be for a fire, and his Holy One for a flame: and it shall burn and devour his thorns and his briers in one day;

devour Israel with <u>23\_ISA\_09\_12</u> # The Syrians before, and the Philistines behind; and they shall devour Israel with open mouth. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

devour it and <u>30\_AMO\_05\_06</u># Seek the LORD, and ye shall live; lest he break out like fire in the house of Joseph, and devour [it], and [there be] none to quench [it] in Bethel.

devour it in <u>23\_ISA\_01\_07</u> # Your country [is] desolate, your cities [are] burned with fire: your land, strangers devour it in your presence, and [it is] desolate, as overthrown by strangers.

devour it 19\_PSA\_80\_13 # The boar out of the wood doth waste it, and the wild beast of the field doth devour it.

devour men no <u>26\_EZE\_36\_14</u># Therefore thou shalt devour men no more, neither bereave thy nations any more, saith the Lord GOD.

devour much flesh <u>27\_DAN\_07\_05</u> # And behold another beast, a second, like to a bear, and it raised up itself on one side, and [it had] three ribs in the mouth of it between the teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh.

devour one another <u>48\_GAL\_05\_15</u># But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.

devour round about <u>24\_JER\_46\_14</u># Declare ye in Egypt, and publish in Migdol, and publish in Noph and in Tahpanhes: say ye, Stand fast, and prepare thee; for the sword shall devour round about thee.

devour the adversaries <u>58\_HEB\_10\_27</u> # But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.

devour the briers 23\_ISA\_09\_18 # For wickedness burneth as the fire: it shall devour the briers and thorns, and shall kindle in the thickets of the forest, and they shall mount up [like] the lifting up of smoke.

devour the cedars <u>07\_JUD\_09\_15</u># And the bramble said unto the trees, If in truth ye anoint me king over you, [then] come [and] put your trust in my shadow: and if not, let fire come out of the bramble, and devour the cedars of Lebanon.

devour the corner <u>24 JER\_48\_45</u># They that fled stood under the shadow of Heshbon because of the force: but a fire shall come forth out of Heshbon, and a flame from the midst of Sihon, and shall devour the corner of Moab, and the crown of the head of the tumultuous ones.

devour the land 14\_2CH\_07\_13 # If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people;

devour the men <u>07\_JUD\_09\_20</u> # But if not, let fire come out from Abimelech, and devour the men of Shechem, and the house of Millo; and let fire come out from the men of Shechem, and from the house of Millo, and devour Abimelech.

devour the palaces <u>30\_AMO\_01\_04</u># But I will send a fire into the house of Hazael, which shall devour the palaces of Benhadad.

devour the palaces <u>30\_AMO\_01\_07</u># But I will send a fire on the wall of Gaza, which shall devour the palaces thereof:

devour the palaces <u>30\_AMO\_01\_10</u> # But I will send a fire on the wall of Tyrus, which shall devour the palaces thereof.

devour the palaces <u>30\_AMO\_01\_12</u># But I will send a fire upon Teman, which shall devour the palaces of Bozrah.

devour the palaces <u>30\_AMO\_01\_14</u> # But I will kindle a fire in the wall of Rabbah, and it shall devour the palaces thereof, with shouting in the day of battle, with a tempest in the day of the whirlwind:

devour the palaces 30\_AMO\_02\_02 # But I will send a fire upon Moab, and it shall devour the palaces of Kirioth: and Moab shall die with tumult, with shouting, [and] with the sound of the trumpet:

devour the palaces <u>30\_AMO\_02\_05</u> # But I will send a fire upon Judah, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem.

devour the palaces <u>28\_HOS\_08\_14</u># For Israel hath forgotten his Maker, and buildeth temples; and Judah hath multiplied fenced cities: but I will send a fire upon his cities, and it shall devour the palaces thereof.

devour the palaces <u>24\_JER\_17\_27</u># But if ye will not hearken unto me to hallow the sabbath day, and not to bear a burden, even entering in at the gates of Jerusalem on the sabbath day; then will I kindle a fire in the gates thereof, and it shall devour the palaces of Jerusalem, and it shall not be quenched.

devour the poor <u>35\_HAB\_03\_14</u> # Thou didst strike through with his staves the head of his villages: they came out as a whirlwind to scatter me: their rejoicing [was] as to devour the poor secretly.

devour the poor 20\_PRO\_30\_14 # [There is] a generation, whose teeth [are as] swords, and their jaw teeth [as] knives, to devour the poor from off the earth, and the needy from [among] men.

devour the prey <u>01\_GEN\_49\_27</u># Benjamin shall ravin [as] a wolf: in the morning he shall devour the prey, and at night he shall divide the spoil.

devour the strength <u>18\_JOB\_18\_13</u> # It shall devour the strength of his skin: [even] the firstborn of death shall devour his strength.

devour the whole <u>27\_DAN\_07\_23</u># Thus he said, The fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth, which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces.

devour thee and <u>26\_EZE\_28\_18</u> # Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffic; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee.

devour thee shall <u>24 JER\_30\_16</u> # Therefore all they that devour thee shall be devoured; and all thine adversaries, every one of them, shall go into captivity; and they that spoil thee shall be a spoil, and all that prey upon thee will I give for a prey.

devour thee the <u>34\_NAH\_03\_15</u># There shall the fire devour thee; the sword shall cut thee off, it shall eat thee up like the cankerworm: make thyself many as the cankerworm, make thyself many as the locusts.

devour them and <u>26\_EZE\_15\_07</u># And I will set my face against them; they shall go out from [one] fire, and [another] fire shall devour them; and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I set my face against them.

devour them and 31\_OBA\_01\_18 # And the house of Jacob shall be a fire, and the house of Joseph a flame, and the house of Esau for stubble, and they shall kindle in them, and devour them; and there shall not be [any] remaining of the house of Esau; for the LORD hath spoken [it].

devour them because <u>28\_HOS\_11\_06</u># And the sword shall abide on his cities, and shall consume his branches, and devour [them], because of their own counsels.

devour them but <u>26\_EZE\_34\_28</u> # And they shall no more be a prey to the heathen, neither shall the beast of the land devour them; but they shall dwell safely, and none shall make [them] afraid.

devour them like <u>28\_HOS\_13\_08</u># I will meet them as a bear [that is] bereaved [of her whelps], and will rend the caul of their heart, and there will I devour them like a lion: the wild beast shall tear them.

devour them with <u>28\_HOS\_05\_07</u># They have dealt treacherously against the LORD: for they have begotten strange children: now shall a month devour them with their portions.

devour them <u>26\_EZE\_23\_37</u> # That they have committed adultery, and blood [is] in their hands, and with their idols have they committed adultery, and have also caused their sons, whom they bare unto me, to pass for them through [the fire], to devour [them].

devour them <u>23\_ISA\_26\_11</u> # LORD, [when] thy hand is lifted up, they will not see: [but] they shall see, and be ashamed for [their] envy at the people; yea, the fire of thine enemies shall devour them.

devour them <u>24\_JER\_05\_14</u># Wherefore thus saith the LORD God of hosts, Because ye speak this word, behold, I will make my words in thy mouth fire, and this people wood, and it shall devour them.

devour them 19\_PSA\_21\_09 # Thou shalt make them as a fiery oven in the time of thine anger: the LORD shall swallow them up in his wrath, and the fire shall devour them.

devour thy bars 34\_NAH\_03\_13 # Behold, thy people in the midst of thee [are] women: the gates of thy land shall be set wide open unto thine enemies: the fire shall devour thy bars.

devour thy cedars 38\_ZEC\_11\_01 # Open thy doors, O Lebanon, that the fire may devour thy cedars.

devour thy young <u>34\_NAH\_02\_13</u> # Behold, I [am] against thee, saith the LORD of hosts, and I will burn her chariots in the smoke, and the sword shall devour thy young lions: and I will cut off thy prey from the earth, and the voice of thy messengers shall no more be heard.

devour widows' houses <u>42\_LUK\_20\_47</u># Which devour widows' houses, and for a show make long prayers: the same shall receive greater damnation.

devour widows' houses <u>41\_MAR\_12\_40</u># Which devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayers: these shall receive greater damnation.

devour widows' houses <u>40\_MAT\_23\_14</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation.

devour yea all 23\_ISA\_56\_09 # All ye beasts of the field, come to devour, [yea], all ye beasts in the forest.

devour you if <u>47\_2CO\_11\_20</u># For ye suffer, if a man bring you into bondage, if a man devour [you], if a man take [of you], if a man exalt himself, if a man smite you on the face.

devour you <u>23\_ISA\_33\_11</u># Ye shall conceive chaff, ye shall bring forth stubble: your breath, [as] fire, shall devour you.

devour <u>60\_1PE\_05\_08</u> # Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

devour 24\_JER\_12\_09 # Mine heritage [is] unto me [as] a speckled bird, the birds round about [are] against her; come ye, assemble all the beasts of the field, come to devour.

devoured also our <u>01\_GEN\_31\_15</u># Are we not counted of him strangers? for he hath sold us, and hath quite devoured also our money.

devoured and all <u>24\_JER\_30\_16</u> # Therefore all they that devour thee shall be devoured; and all thine adversaries, every one of them, shall go into captivity; and they that spoil thee shall be a spoil, and all that prey upon thee will I give for a prey.

devoured and brake <u>27\_DAN\_07\_07</u> # After this I saw in the night visions, and behold a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it [was] diverse from all the beasts that [were] before it; and it had ten horns.

devoured and many <u>05\_DEU\_31\_17</u># Then my anger shall be kindled against them in that day, and I will forsake them, and I will hide my face from them, and they shall be devoured, and many evils and troubles shall befall them; so that they will say in that day, Are not these evils come upon us, because our God [is] not among us?

devoured as stubble <u>34\_NAH\_01\_10</u> # For while [they be] folden together [as] thorns, and while they are drunken [as] drunkards, they shall be devoured as stubble fully dry.

devoured brake in <u>27\_DAN\_07\_19</u># Then I would know the truth of the fourth beast, which was diverse from all the others, exceeding dreadful, whose teeth [were of] iron, and his nails [of] brass; [which] devoured, brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with his feet;

devoured by the <u>26\_EZE\_23\_25</u># And I will set my jealousy against thee, and they shall deal furiously with thee: they shall take away thy nose and thine ears; and thy remnant shall fall by the sword: they shall take thy sons and thy daughters; and thy residue shall be devoured by the fire.

devoured her fruit <u>26\_EZE\_19\_14</u> # And fire is gone out of a rod of her branches, [which] hath devoured her fruit, so that she hath no strong rod [to be] a sceptre to rule. This [is] a lamentation, and shall be for a lamentation.

devoured him and <u>01\_GEN\_37\_20</u> # Come now therefore, and let us slay him, and cast him into some pit, and we will say, Some evil beast hath devoured him: and we shall see what will become of his dreams.

devoured him and <u>24\_JER\_10\_25</u># Pour out thy fury upon the heathen that know thee not, and upon the families that call not on thy name: for they have eaten up Jacob, and devoured him, and consumed him, and have made his habitation desolate.

devoured him and 24\_JER\_50\_17 # Israel [is] a scattered sheep; the lions have driven [him] away: first the king of Assyria hath devoured him; and last this Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon hath broken his bones.

devoured him Joseph <u>01\_GEN\_37\_33</u># And he knew it, and said, [It is] my son's coat; an evil beast hath devoured him; Joseph is without doubt rent in pieces.

devoured his strength <u>28\_HOS\_07\_09</u> # Strangers have devoured his strength, and he knoweth [it] not: yea, gray hairs are here and there upon him, yet he knoweth not.

devoured Is this <u>26\_EZE\_16\_20</u># Moreover thou hast taken thy sons and thy daughters, whom thou hast borne unto me, and these hast thou sacrificed unto them to be devoured. [Is this] of thy whoredoms a small matter,

devoured it and <u>26\_EZE\_15\_05</u># Behold, when it was whole, it was meet for no work: how much less shall it be meet yet for [any] work, when the fire hath devoured it, and it is burned?

devoured it up <u>41\_MAR\_04\_04</u> # And it came to pass, as he sowed, some fell by the way side, and the fowls of the air came and devoured it up.

devoured it <u>42\_LUK\_08\_05</u> # A sower went out to sow his seed: and as he sowed, some fell by the way side; and it was trodden down, and the fowls of the air devoured it.

devoured Jacob and 19\_PSA\_79\_07# For they have devoured Jacob, and laid waste his dwelling place.

devoured me he <u>24\_JER\_51\_34</u># Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon hath devoured me, he hath crushed me, he hath made me an empty vessel, he hath swallowed me up like a dragon, he hath filled his belly with my delicates, he hath cast me out.

devoured men <u>26\_EZE\_19\_03</u> # And she brought up one of her whelps: it became a young lion, and it learned to catch the prey; it devoured men.

devoured men <u>26\_EZE\_19\_06</u># And he went up and down among the lions, he became a young lion, and learned to catch the prey, [and] devoured men.

devoured more people <u>10\_2SA\_18\_08</u># For the battle was there scattered over the face of all the country: and the wood devoured more people that day than the sword devoured.

devoured souls they <u>26\_EZE\_22\_25</u> # [There is] a conspiracy of her prophets in the midst thereof, like a roaring lion ravening the prey; they have devoured souls; they have taken the treasure and precious things; they have made her many widows in the midst thereof.

devoured the earth <u>23\_ISA\_24\_06</u># Therefore hath the curse devoured the earth, and they that dwell therein are desolate: therefore the inhabitants of the earth are burned, and few men left.

devoured the foundations <u>25\_LAM\_04\_11</u># The LORD hath accomplished his fury; he hath poured out his fierce anger, and hath kindled a fire in Zion, and it hath devoured the foundations thereof.

devoured the fruit 19\_PSA\_105\_35 # And did eat up all the herbs in their land, and devoured the fruit of their ground.

devoured the great <u>30\_AMO\_07\_04</u> # Thus hath the Lord GOD showed unto me: and, behold, the Lord GOD called to contend by fire, and it devoured the great deep, and did eat up a part.

devoured the labour <u>24\_JER\_03\_24</u> # For shame hath devoured the labour of our fathers from our youth; their flocks and their herds, their sons and their daughters.

devoured the land <u>24\_JER\_08\_16</u># The snorting of his horses was heard from Dan: the whole land trembled at the sound of the neighing of his strong ones; for they are come, and have devoured the land, and all that is in it; the city, and those that dwell therein.

devoured the pastures 29\_JOE\_01\_19 # O LORD, to thee will I cry: for the fire hath devoured the pastures of the wilderness, and the flame hath burned all the trees of the field.

devoured the pastures 29\_JOE\_01\_20 # The beasts of the field cry also unto thee: for the rivers of waters are dried up, and the fire hath devoured the pastures of the wilderness.

devoured the seven <u>01\_GEN\_41\_07</u> # And the seven thin ears devoured the seven rank and full ears. And Pharaoh awoke, and, behold, [it was] a dream.

devoured them and <u>19\_PSA\_78\_45</u># He sent divers sorts of flies among them, which devoured them; and frogs, which destroyed them.

devoured them up <u>40\_MAT\_13\_04</u># And when he sowed, some [seeds] fell by the way side, and the fowls came and devoured them up:

devoured them yet <u>30\_AMO\_04\_09</u> # I have smitten you with blasting and mildew: when your gardens and your vineyards and your fig trees and your olive trees increased, the palmerworm devoured [them]: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD.

devoured them <u>66\_REV\_20\_09</u> # And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.

devoured thy living <u>42\_LUK\_15\_30</u> # But as soon as this thy son was come, which hath devoured thy living with harlots, thou hast killed for him the fatted calf.

devoured two hundred <u>04\_NUM\_26\_10</u># And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up together with Korah, when that company died, what time the fire devoured two hundred and fifty men: and they became a sign.

devoured with burning <u>05\_DEU\_32\_24</u># [They shall be] burnt with hunger, and devoured with burning heat, and with bitter destruction: I will also send the teeth of beasts upon them, with the poison of serpents of the dust.

devoured with fire <u>38\_ZEC\_09\_04</u> # Behold, the Lord will cast her out, and he will smite her power in the sea; and she shall be devoured with fire.

devoured with the <u>23\_ISA\_01\_20</u> # But if ye refuse and rebel, ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken [it].

devoured with the <u>36\_ZEP\_03\_08</u> # Therefore wait ye upon me, saith the LORD, until the day that I rise up to the prey: for my determination [is] to gather the nations, that I may assemble the kingdoms, to pour upon them mine indignation, [even] all my fierce anger: for all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of my jealousy.

devoured your prophets <u>24\_JER\_02\_30</u> # In vain have I smitten your children; they received no correction: your own sword hath devoured your prophets, like a destroying lion.

devoured 10\_28A\_18\_08 # For the battle was there scattered over the face of all the country: and the wood devoured more people that day than the sword devoured.

devoured <u>26\_EZE\_39\_04</u> # Thou shalt fall upon the mountains of Israel, thou, and all thy bands, and the people that [is] with thee: I will give thee unto the ravenous birds of every sort, and [to] the beasts of the field to be devoured.

devourer for your <u>39\_MAL\_03\_11</u># And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts.

devourest up men <u>26\_EZE\_36\_13</u> # Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because they say unto you, Thou [land] devourest up men, and hast bereaved thy nations;

devoureth before them <u>29\_JOE\_02\_03</u> # A fire devoureth before them; and behind them a flame burneth: the land [is] as the garden of Eden before them, and behind them a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing shall escape them.

devoureth both the <u>26\_EZE\_15\_04</u> # Behold, it is cast into the fire for fuel; the fire devoureth both the ends of it, and the midst of it is burned. Is it meet for [any] work?

devoureth iniquity <u>20\_PRO\_19\_28</u># An ungodly witness scorneth judgment: and the mouth of the wicked devoureth iniquity.

devoureth one as <u>10\_2SA\_11\_25</u># Then David said unto the messenger, Thus shalt thou say unto Joab, Let not this thing displease thee, for the sword devoureth one as well as another: make thy battle more strong

against the city, and overthrow it: and encourage thou him.

devoureth round about <u>25\_LAM\_02\_03</u># He hath cut off in [his] fierce anger all the horn of Israel: he hath drawn back his right hand from before the enemy, and he burned against Jacob like a flaming fire, [which] devoureth round about.

devoureth that which 20\_PRO\_20\_25 # [It is] a snare to the man [who] devoureth [that which is] holy, and after vows to make inquiry.

devoureth the man <u>35\_HAB\_01\_13</u># [Thou art] of purer eyes than to behold evil, and canst not look on iniquity: wherefore lookest thou upon them that deal treacherously, [and] holdest thy tongue when the wicked devoureth [the man that is] more righteous than he?

devoureth the stubble <u>23\_ISA\_05\_24</u># Therefore as the fire devoureth the stubble, and the flame consumeth the chaff, [so] their root shall be as rottenness, and their blossom shall go up as dust: because they have cast away the law of the LORD of hosts, and despised the word of the Holy One of Israel.

devoureth the stubble <u>29\_JOE\_02\_05</u># Like the noise of chariots on the tops of mountains shall they leap, like the noise of a flame of fire that devoureth the stubble, as a strong people set in battle array.

devoureth their enemies <u>66\_REV\_11\_05</u># And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

devouring fire on <u>02\_EXO\_24\_17</u> # And the sight of the glory of the LORD [was] like devouring fire on the top of the mount in the eyes of the children of Israel.

devouring fire who <u>23\_ISA\_33\_14</u># The sinners in Zion are afraid; fearfulness hath surprised the hypocrites. Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?

devouring fire with <u>23\_ISA\_30\_30</u> # And the LORD shall cause his glorious voice to be heard, and shall show the lighting down of his arm, with the indignation of [his] anger, and [with] the flame of a devouring fire, [with] scattering, and tempest, and hailstones.

devouring fire <u>23\_ISA\_29\_06</u> # Thou shalt be visited of the LORD of hosts with thunder, and with earthquake, and great noise, with storm and tempest, and the flame of devouring fire.

devouring fire <u>23\_ISA\_30\_27</u> # Behold, the name of the LORD cometh from far, burning [with] his anger, and the burden [thereof is] heavy: his lips are full of indignation, and his tongue as a devouring fire:

devouring words O 19\_PSA\_52\_04 # Thou lovest all devouring words, O [thou] deceitful tongue.
