

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

dig a pit <u>02\_EXO\_21\_33</u> # And if a man shall open a pit, or if a man shall dig a pit, and not cover it, and an ox or an ass fall therein;

dig a pit 18\_JOB\_06\_27 # Yea, ye overwhelm the fatherless, and ye dig [a pit] for your friend.

dig about it <u>42\_LUK\_13\_08</u># And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung [it]:

dig about thee <u>18\_JOB\_11\_18</u># And thou shalt be secure, because there is hope; yea, thou shalt dig [about thee, and] thou shalt take thy rest in safety.

dig brass <u>05\_DEU\_08\_09</u> # A land wherein thou shalt eat bread without scarceness, thou shalt not lack any [thing] in it; a land whose stones [are] iron, and out of whose hills thou mayest dig brass.

dig for it 18\_JOB\_03\_21 # Which long for death, but it [cometh] not; and dig for it more than for hid treasures;

dig into hell <u>30\_AMO\_09\_02</u># Though they dig into hell, thence shall mine hand take them; though they climb up to heaven, thence will I bring them down:

dig now in <u>26\_EZE\_08\_08</u># Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall: and when I had digged in the wall, behold a door.

dig therewith and <u>05\_DEU\_23\_13</u># And thou shalt have a paddle upon thy weapon; and it shall be, when thou wilt ease thyself abroad, thou shalt dig therewith, and shalt turn back and cover that which cometh from thee:

Dig thou through <u>26\_EZE\_12\_05</u> # Dig thou through the wall in their sight, and carry out thereby.

dig through houses <u>18\_JOB\_24\_16</u># In the dark they dig through houses, [which] they had marked for themselves in the daytime: they know not the light.

dig through the <u>26\_EZE\_12\_12</u> # And the prince that [is] among them shall bear upon [his] shoulder in the twilight, and shall go forth: they shall dig through the wall to carry out thereby: he shall cover his face, that he see not the ground with [his] eyes.

dig to beg <u>42\_LUK\_16\_03</u># Then the steward said within himself, What shall I do? for my lord taketh away from me the stewardship: I cannot dig; to beg I am ashamed.

digged a pit 24\_JER\_18\_20 # Shall evil be recompensed for good? for they have digged a pit for my soul. Remember that I stood before thee to speak good for them, [and] to turn away thy wrath from them.

digged a pit 24\_JER\_18\_22 # Let a cry be heard from their houses, when thou shalt bring a troop suddenly upon them: for they have digged a pit to take me, and hid snares for my feet.

digged a pit 19\_PSA\_57\_06 # They have prepared a net for my steps; my soul is bowed down: they have digged a pit before me, into the midst whereof they are fallen [themselves]. Selah.

digged a place 41 MAR\_12\_01 # And he began to speak unto them by parables. A [certain] man planted a vineyard, and set an hedge about [it], and digged [a place for] the winefat, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and went into a far country.

digged a well <u>01\_GEN\_26\_25</u> # And he builded an altar there, and called upon the name of the LORD, and pitched his tent there: and there Isaac's servants digged a well.

digged a winepress <u>40\_MAT\_21\_33</u># Hear another parable: There was a certain householder, which planted a vineyard, and hedged it round about, and digged a winepress in it, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and went into a far country:

digged again the <u>01\_GEN\_26\_18</u># And Isaac digged again the wells of water, which they had digged in the days of Abraham his father; for the Philistines had stopped them after the death of Abraham: and he called their names after the names by which his father had called them.

digged and drunk 12\_2KI\_19\_24 # I have digged and drunk strange waters, and with the sole of my feet have I dried up all the rivers of besieged places.

digged and drunk <u>23\_ISA\_37\_25</u># I have digged, and drunk water; and with the sole of my feet have I dried up all the rivers of the besieged places.

digged and said <u>01\_GEN\_26\_32</u># And it came to pass the same day, that Isaac's servants came, and told him concerning the well which they had digged, and said unto him, We have found water.

digged and took <u>24\_JER\_13\_07</u># Then I went to Euphrates, and digged, and took the girdle from the place where I had hid it: and, behold, the girdle was marred, it was profitable for nothing.

digged another well <u>01\_GEN\_26\_21</u># And they digged another well, and strove for that also: and he called the name of it Sitnah.

digged another well <u>01\_GEN\_26\_22</u># And he removed from thence, and digged another well; and for that they strove not: and he called the name of it Rehoboth; and he said, For now the LORD hath made room for us, and we shall be fruitful in the land.

digged but there <u>23\_ISA\_05\_06</u> # And I will lay it waste: it shall not be pruned, nor digged; but there shall come up briers and thorns: I will also command the clouds that they rain no rain upon it.

digged deep and <u>42\_LUK\_06\_48</u># He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock.

digged down a <u>01\_GEN\_49\_06</u># O my soul, come not thou into their secret; unto their assembly, mine honour, be not thou united: for in their anger they slew a man, and in their selfwill they digged down a wall.

digged down thine <u>45\_ROM\_11\_03</u># Lord, they have killed thy prophets, and digged down thine altars; and I am left alone, and they seek my life.

digged for me <u>01\_GEN\_50\_05</u> # My father made me swear, saying, Lo, I die: in my grave which I have digged for me in the land of Canaan, there shalt thou bury me. Now therefore let me go up, I pray thee, and bury my father, and I will come again.

digged for my 19 PSA 35 07 # For without cause have they hid for me their net [in] a pit, [which] without cause they have digged for my soul.

digged for the 19 PSA 94 13 # That thou mayest give him rest from the days of adversity, until the pit be digged for the wicked.

digged in the <u>26\_EZE\_08\_08</u># Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall: and when I had digged in the wall, behold a door.

digged in the <u>01\_GEN\_26\_15</u># For all the wells which his father's servants had digged in the days of Abraham his father, the Philistines had stopped them, and filled them with earth.

digged in the <u>01\_GEN\_26\_18</u># And Isaac digged again the wells of water, which they had digged in the days of Abraham his father; for the Philistines had stopped them after the death of Abraham: and he called their names after the names by which his father had called them.

digged in the <u>01\_GEN\_26\_19</u># And Isaac's servants digged in the valley, and found there a well of springing water.

digged in the <u>40\_MAT\_25\_18</u># But he that had received one went and digged in the earth, and hid his lord's money.

digged it and 19\_PSA\_07\_15 # He made a pit, and digged it, and is fallen into the ditch [which] he made.

digged it by <u>04\_NUM\_21\_18</u> # The princes digged the well, the nobles of the people digged it, by [the direction of] the lawgiver, with their staves. And from the wilderness [they went] to Mattanah:

digged many wells <u>14\_2CH\_26\_10</u> # Also he built towers in the desert, and digged many wells: for he had much cattle, both in the low country, and in the plains: husbandmen [also], and vine dressers in the mountains, and in Carmel: for he loved husbandry.

digged pits for 19\_PSA\_119\_85 # The proud have digged pits for me, which [are] not after thy law.

digged round about <u>02\_EXO\_07\_24</u> # And all the Egyptians digged round about the river for water to drink; for they could not drink of the water of the river.

digged the well <u>04\_NUM\_21\_18</u> # The princes digged the well, the nobles of the people digged it, by [the direction of] the lawgiver, with their staves. And from the wilderness [they went] to Mattanah:

digged this well <u>01\_GEN\_21\_30</u> # And he said, For [these] seven ewe lambs shalt thou take of my hand, that they may be a witness unto me, that I have digged this well.

digged through the <u>26\_EZE\_12\_07</u># And I did so as I was commanded: I brought forth my stuff by day, as stuff for captivity, and in the even I digged through the wall with mine hand; I brought [it] forth in the twilight, [and] I bare [it] upon [my] shoulder in their sight.

digged vineyards and <u>16\_NEH\_09\_25</u># And they took strong cities, and a fat land, and possessed houses full of all goods, wells digged, vineyards, and oliveyards, and fruit trees in abundance: so they did eat, and were filled, and became fat, and delighted themselves in thy great goodness.

digged which thou <u>05\_DEU\_06\_11</u># And houses full of all good [things], which thou filledst not, and wells digged, which thou diggedst not, vineyards and olive trees, which thou plantedst not; when thou shalt have eaten and be full;

digged with the <u>23\_ISA\_07\_25</u> # And [on] all hills that shall be digged with the mattock, there shall not come thither the fear of briers and thorns: but it shall be for the sending forth of oxen, and for the treading of lesser cattle.

digged <u>23\_ISA\_51\_01</u># Hearken to me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the LORD: look unto the rock [whence] ye are hewn, and to the hole of the pit [whence] ye are digged.

diggedst not vineyards <u>05\_DEU\_06\_11</u># And houses full of all good [things], which thou filledst not, and wells digged, which thou diggedst not, vineyards and olive trees, which thou plantedst not; when thou shalt have eaten and be full;

diggeth a pit 21\_ECC\_10\_08 # He that diggeth a pit shall fall into it; and whoso breaketh an hedge, a serpent shall bite him.

diggeth a pit 20\_PRO\_26\_27\_# Whoso diggeth a pit shall fall therein: and he that rolleth a stone, it will return upon him.

diggeth up evil 20\_PRO\_16\_27\_# An ungodly man diggeth up evil: and in his lips [there is] as a burning fire.

dignities <u>61\_2PE\_02\_10</u> # But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous [are they], selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities.

dignities <u>65\_JDE\_01\_08</u> # Likewise also these [filthy] dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, and speak evil of dignities.

dignity and the 21\_ECC\_10\_06 # Folly is set in great dignity, and the rich sit in low place.

dignity and the <u>01\_GEN\_49\_03</u> # Reuben, thou [art] my firstborn, my might, and the beginning of my strength, the excellency of dignity, and the excellency of power:

dignity hath been <u>17\_EST\_06\_03</u> # And the king said, What honour and dignity hath been done to Mordecai for this? Then said the king's servants that ministered unto him, There is nothing done for him.

dignity shall proceed <u>35\_HAB\_01\_07</u># They [are] terrible and dreadful: their judgment and their dignity shall proceed of themselves.

indignation against Israel <u>12\_2KI\_03\_27</u> # Then he took his eldest son that should have reigned in his stead, and offered him [for] a burnt offering upon the wall. And there was great indignation against Israel: and they departed from him, and returned to [their own] land.

indignation against Mordecai <u>17\_EST\_05\_09</u># Then went Haman forth that day joyful and with a glad heart: but when Haman saw Mordecai in the king's gate, that he stood not up, nor moved for him, he was full of indignation against Mordecai.

indignation against the <u>27\_DAN\_11\_30</u># For the ships of Chittim shall come against him: therefore he shall be grieved, and return, and have indignation against the holy covenant: so shall he do; he shall even return, and have intelligence with them that forsake the holy covenant.

indignation against the <u>40\_MAT\_20\_24</u># And when the ten heard [it], they were moved with indignation against the two brethren.

indignation and cast <u>05\_DEU\_29\_28</u># And the LORD rooted them out of their land in anger, and in wrath, and in great indignation, and cast them into another land, as [it is] this day.

indignation and he <u>66\_REV\_14\_10</u> # The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

indignation and his 23\_ISA\_30\_27 # Behold, the name of the LORD cometh from far, burning [with] his

anger, and the burden [thereof is] heavy: his lips are full of indignation, and his tongue as a devouring fire:

indignation and mocked <u>16\_NEH\_04\_01</u># But it came to pass, that when Sanballat heard that we builded the wall, he was wroth, and took great indignation, and mocked the Jews.

indignation and thy 19\_PSA\_102\_10 # Because of thine indignation and thy wrath: for thou hast lifted me up, and cast me down.

indignation and trouble <u>19\_PSA\_78\_49</u># He cast upon them the fierceness of his anger, wrath, and indignation, and trouble, by sending evil angels [among them].

indignation and who <u>34\_NAH\_01\_06</u># Who can stand before his indignation? and who can abide in the fierceness of his anger? his fury is poured out like fire, and the rocks are thrown down by him.

indignation and wrath <u>45\_ROM\_02\_08</u> # But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath,

indignation be accomplished <u>27\_DAN\_11\_36</u># And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done.

indignation be overpast 23 ISA 26 20 # Come, my people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee: hide thyself as it were for a little moment, until the indignation be overpast.

indignation because that <u>42\_LUK\_13\_14</u># And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed on the sabbath day, and said unto the people, There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the sabbath day.

indignation even all <u>36\_ZEP\_03\_08</u> # Therefore wait ye upon me, saith the LORD, until the day that I rise up to the prey: for my determination [is] to gather the nations, that I may assemble the kingdoms, to pour upon them mine indignation, [even] all my fierce anger: for all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of my jealousy.

indignation for at <u>27\_DAN\_08\_19</u> # And he said, Behold, I will make thee know what shall be in the last end of the indignation: for at the time appointed the end [shall be].

indignation for ever <u>39\_MAL\_01\_04</u># Whereas Edom saith, We are impoverished, but we will return and build the desolate places; thus saith the LORD of hosts, They shall build, but I will throw down; and they shall call them, The border of wickedness, and, The people against whom the LORD hath indignation for ever.

indignation for this 24\_JER\_50\_25 # The LORD hath opened his armoury, and hath brought forth the weapons of his indignation: for this [is] the work of the Lord GOD of hosts in the land of the Chaldeans.

indignation of his <u>23\_ISA\_30\_30</u> # And the LORD shall cause his glorious voice to be heard, and shall show the lighting down of his arm, with the indignation of [his] anger, and [with] the flame of a devouring fire, [with] scattering, and tempest, and hailstones.

indignation of his <u>25\_LAM\_02\_06</u># And he hath violently taken away his tabernacle, as [if it were of] a garden: he hath destroyed his places of the assembly: the LORD hath caused the solemn feasts and sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, and hath despised in the indignation of his anger the king and the priest.

indignation of the <u>23\_ISA\_34\_02</u># For the indignation of the LORD [is] upon all nations, and [his] fury upon all their armies: he hath utterly destroyed them, he hath delivered them to the slaughter.

indignation of the <u>33\_MIC\_07\_09</u># I will bear the indignation of the LORD, because I have sinned against him, until he plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: he will bring me forth to the light, [and] I shall behold his righteousness.

indignation saying To <u>40\_MAT\_26\_08</u># But when his disciples saw [it], they had indignation, saying, To what purpose [is] this waste?

indignation shall cease <u>23\_ISA\_10\_25</u> # For yet a very little while, and the indignation shall cease, and mine anger in their destruction.

indignation these threescore <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_12</u> # Then the angel of the LORD answered and said, O LORD of hosts, how long wilt thou not have mercy on Jerusalem and on the cities of Judah, against which thou hast had indignation these threescore and ten years?

indignation thou didst <u>35\_HAB\_03\_12</u># Thou didst march through the land in indignation, thou didst thresh the heathen in anger.

indignation to destroy 23\_ISA\_13\_05 # They come from a far country, from the end of heaven, [even] the LORD, and the weapons of his indignation, to destroy the whole land.

indignation toward his <u>23\_ISA\_66\_14</u># And when ye see [this], your heart shall rejoice, and your bones shall flourish like an herb: and the hand of the LORD shall be known toward his servants, and [his] indignation toward his enemies.

indignation upon me <u>18\_JOB\_10\_17</u> # Thou renewest thy witnesses against me, and increasest thine indignation upon me; changes and war [are] against me.

indignation upon thee <u>26\_EZE\_21\_31</u> # And I will pour out mine indignation upon thee, I will blow against thee in the fire of my wrath, and deliver thee into the hand of brutish men, [and] skilful to destroy.

indignation upon them <u>26\_EZE\_22\_31</u> # Therefore have I poured out mine indignation upon them; I have consumed them with the fire of my wrath: their own way have I recompensed upon their heads, saith the Lord GOD.

indignation upon them <u>19\_PSA\_69\_24</u> # Pour out thine indignation upon them, and let thy wrathful anger take hold of them.

indignation which shall <u>58\_HEB\_10\_27</u># But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.

indignation within themselves <u>41\_MAR\_14\_04</u> # And there were some that had indignation within themselves, and said, Why was this waste of the ointment made?

indignation yea what <u>47\_2CO\_07\_11</u># For behold this selfsame thing, that ye sorrowed after a godly sort, what carefulness it wrought in you, yea, [what] clearing of yourselves, yea, [what] indignation, yea, [what] fear, yea, [what] vehement desire, yea, [what] zeal, yea, [what] revenge! In all [things] ye have approved yourselves to be clear in this matter.

indignation 44\_ACT\_05\_17 # Then the high priest rose up, and all they that were with him, [which is the sect of the Sadducees,] and were filled with indignation,

indignation <u>26\_EZE\_22\_24</u> # Son of man, say unto her, Thou [art] the land that is not cleansed, nor rained upon in the day of indignation.

indignation 23\_ISA\_10\_05 # O Assyrian, the rod of mine anger, and the staff in their hand is mine

indignation.

indignation <u>24\_JER\_10\_10</u> # But the LORD [is] the true God, he [is] the living God, and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation.

indignation <u>24\_JER\_15\_17</u> # I sat not in the assembly of the mockers, nor rejoiced; I sat alone because of thy hand: for thou hast filled me with indignation.

pedigrees after their <u>04\_NUM\_01\_18</u># And they assembled all the congregation together on the first [day] of the second month, and they declared their pedigrees after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, from twenty years old and upward, by their polls.
