divine a lie [26 EZE 21 29](#) # Whiles they see vanity unto thee, whiles they divine a lie unto thee, to bring thee upon the necks of [them that are] slain, of the wicked, whose day is come, when their iniquity [shall have] an end.

divine and the [33 MIC 03 06](#) # Therefore night [shall be] unto you, that ye shall not have a vision; and it shall be dark unto you, that ye shall not divine; and the sun shall go down over the prophets, and the day shall be dark over them.

divine divinations for [26 EZE 13 23](#) # Therefore ye shall see no more vanity, nor divine divinations: for I will deliver my people out of your hand: and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD.

divine for money [33 MIC 03 11](#) # The heads thereof judge for reward, and the priests thereof teach for hire, and the prophets thereof divine for money: yet will they lean upon the LORD, and say, [Is] not the LORD among us? none evil can come upon us.

divine lies they [26 EZE 13 09](#) # And mine hand shall be upon the prophets that see vanity, and that divine lies: they shall not be in the assembly of my people, neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel, neither shall they enter into the land of Israel; and ye shall know that I [am] the Lord GOD.

divine nature having [61 2PE 01 04](#) # Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

divine power hath [61 2PE 01 03](#) # According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that [pertain] unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue:

divine sentence is [20 PRO 16 10](#) # A divine sentence [is] in the lips of the king: his mouth transgresseth not in judgment.

divine service and [58 HEB 09 01](#) # Then verily the first [covenant] had also ordinances of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary.

divine unto me [09 ISA 28 08](#) # And Saul disguised himself, and put on other raiment, and he went, and two men with him, and they came to the woman by night: and he said, I pray thee, divine unto me by the familiar spirit, and bring me [him] up, whom I shall name unto thee.

divine [01 GEN 44 15](#) # And Joseph said unto them, What deed [is] this that ye have done? wot ye not that such a man as I can certainly divine?

diviners but as [05 DEU 18 14](#) # For these nations, which thou shalt possess, hearkened unto observers of times, and unto diviners: but as for thee, the LORD thy God hath not suffered thee so [to do].

diviners confounded yea [33 MIC 03 07](#) # Then shall the seers be ashamed, and the diviners confounded: yea, they shall all cover their lips; for [there is] no answer of God.

diviners have seen [38 ZEC 10 02](#) # For the idols have spoken vanity, and the diviners have seen a lie, and have told false dreams; they comfort in vain: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because [there was] no shepherd.

diviners mad that [23 ISA 44 25](#) # That frustrateth the tokens of the liars, and maketh diviners mad; that turneth wise [men] backward, and maketh their knowledge foolish;

diviners nor to [24 JER 27 09](#) # Therefore hearken not ye to your prophets, nor to your diviners, nor to your dreamers, nor to your enchanters, nor to your sorcerers, which speak unto you, saying, Ye shall not serve the king of Babylon:

diviners saying What [09 ISA 06 02](#) # And the Philistines called for the priests and the diviners, saying, What shall we do to the ark of the LORD? tell us wherewith we shall send it to his place.

diviners that be [24 JER 29 08](#) # For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Let not your prophets and your diviners, that [be] in the midst of you, deceive you, neither hearken to your dreams which ye cause to be dreamed.

divineth ye have [01 GEN 44 05](#) # [Is] not this [it] in which my lord drinketh, and whereby indeed he divineth? ye have done evil in so doing.
