

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

dry and drieth <u>34\_NAH\_01\_04</u># He rebuketh the sea, and maketh it dry, and drieth up all the rivers: Bashan languisheth, and Carmel, and the flower of Lebanon languisheth.

dry and his <u>28\_HOS\_13\_15</u># Though he be fruitful among [his] brethren, an east wind shall come, the wind of the LORD shall come up from the wilderness, and his spring shall become dry, and his fountain shall be dried up: he shall spoil the treasure of all pleasant vessels.

dry and I 23\_ISA\_44\_27 # That saith to the deep, Be dry, and I will dry up thy rivers:

dry and it <u>06\_JOS\_09\_12</u># This our bread we took hot [for] our provision out of our houses on the day we came forth to go unto you; but now, behold, it is dry, and it is mouldy:

dry and mouldy <u>06\_JOS\_09\_05</u># And old shoes and clouted upon their feet, and old garments upon them; and all the bread of their provision was dry [and] mouldy.

dry and sell <u>26\_EZE\_30\_12</u># And I will make the rivers dry, and sell the land into the hand of the wicked: and I will make the land waste, and all that is therein, by the hand of strangers: I the LORD have spoken [it].

dry and thirsty 26\_EZE\_19\_13 # And now she [is] planted in the wilderness, in a dry and thirsty ground.

dry and thirsty 19 PSA 63 01 # A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah. O God, thou [art] my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;

dry bones hear <u>26\_EZE\_37\_04</u> # Again he said unto me, Prophesy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.

dry breasts <u>28\_HOS\_09\_14</u> # Give them, O LORD: what wilt thou give? give them a miscarrying womb and dry breasts.

dry ground and <u>02\_EXO\_14\_22</u> # And the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea upon the dry [ground]: and the waters [were] a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left.

dry ground he <u>23\_ISA\_53\_02</u># For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, [there is] no beauty that we should desire him.

dry ground I <u>23\_ISA\_44\_03</u> # For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring:

dry ground in <u>06\_JOS\_03\_17</u># And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan.

dry ground into 19\_PSA\_107\_35 # He turneth the wilderness into a standing water, and dry ground into watersprings.

dry ground through <u>02\_EXO\_14\_16</u># But lift thou up thy rod, and stretch out thine hand over the sea, and divide it: and the children of Israel shall go on dry [ground] through the midst of the sea.

dry ground until <u>06\_JOS\_03\_17</u># And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan.

dry ground 12\_2KI\_02\_08 # And Elijah took his mantle, and wrapped [it] together, and smote the waters, and they were divided hither and thither, so that they two went over on dry ground.

dry ground 19\_PSA\_107\_33 # He turneth rivers into a wilderness, and the watersprings into dry ground;

dry land and <u>02 EXO 04 09 #</u> And it shall come to pass, if they will not believe also these two signs, neither hearken unto thy voice, that thou shalt take of the water of the river, and pour [it] upon the dry [land]: and the water which thou takest out of the river shall become blood upon the dry [land].

dry land and <u>02\_EXO\_14\_21</u># And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go [back] by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry [land], and the waters were divided.

dry land and <u>28\_HOS\_02\_03</u> # Lest I strip her naked, and set her as in the day that she was born, and make her as a wilderness, and set her like a dry land, and slay her with thirst.

dry land and <u>24\_JER\_50\_12</u># Your mother shall be sore confounded; she that bare you shall be ashamed: behold, the hindermost of the nations [shall be] a wilderness, a dry land, and a desert.

dry land and <u>24\_JER\_51\_43</u># Her cities are a desolation, a dry land, and a wilderness, a land wherein no man dwelleth, neither doth [any] son of man pass thereby.

dry land and <u>16\_NEH\_09\_11</u># And thou didst divide the sea before them, so that they went through the midst of the sea on the dry land; and their persecutors thou threwest into the deeps, as a stone into the mighty waters.

dry land appear <u>01\_GEN\_01\_09</u># And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry [land] appear: and it was so.

dry land died <u>01\_GEN\_07\_22</u> # All in whose nostrils [was] the breath of life, of all that [was] in the dry [land], died.

dry land Earth <u>01\_GEN\_01\_10</u> # And God called the dry [land] Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas: and God saw that [it was] good.

dry land in <u>02\_EXO\_14\_29</u># But the children of Israel walked upon dry [land] in the midst of the sea; and the waters [were] a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left.

dry land in <u>02\_EXO\_15\_19</u># For the horse of Pharaoh went in with his chariots and with his horsemen into the sea, and the LORD brought again the waters of the sea upon them; but the children of Israel went on dry [land] in the midst of the sea.

dry land springs <u>23\_ISA\_41\_18</u> # I will open rivers in high places, and fountains in the midst of the valleys: I will make the wilderness a pool of water, and the dry land springs of water.

dry land that <u>06\_JOS\_04\_18</u># And it came to pass, when the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD were come up out of the midst of Jordan, [and] the soles of the priests' feet were lifted up unto the dry land, that the waters of Jordan returned unto their place, and flowed over all his banks, as [they did]

before.

dry land they <u>19\_PSA\_66\_06</u># He turned the sea into dry [land]: they went through the flood on foot: there did we rejoice in him.

dry land which <u>58\_HEB\_11\_29</u># By faith they passed through the Red sea as by dry [land]: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned.

dry land <u>02\_EXO\_04\_09</u> # And it shall come to pass, if they will not believe also these two signs, neither hearken unto thy voice, that thou shalt take of the water of the river, and pour [it] upon the dry [land]: and the water which thou takest out of the river shall become blood upon the dry [land].

dry land <u>37\_HAG\_02\_06</u># For thus saith the LORD of hosts; Yet once, it [is] a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry [land];

dry land <u>32\_JON\_01\_09</u># And he said unto them, I [am] an Hebrew; and I fear the LORD, the God of heaven, which hath made the sea and the dry [land].

dry land <u>32\_JON\_02\_10</u> # And the LORD spake unto the fish, and it vomited out Jonah upon the dry [land].

dry land <u>06\_JOS\_04\_22</u># Then ye shall let your children know, saying, Israel came over this Jordan on dry land.

dry land 19\_PSA\_68\_06 # God setteth the solitary in families: he bringeth out those which are bound with chains: but the rebellious dwell in a dry [land].

dry land 19\_PSA\_95\_05 # The sea [is] his, and he made it: and his hands formed the dry [land].

dry like a <u>36\_ZEP\_02\_13</u># And he will stretch out his hand against the north, and destroy Assyria; and will make Nineveh a desolation, [and] dry like a wilderness.

dry morsel and <u>20\_PRO\_17\_01</u># Better [is] a dry morsel, and quietness therewith, than an house full of sacrifices [with] strife.

dry only upon <u>07\_JUD\_06\_39</u> # And Gideon said unto God, Let not thine anger be hot against me, and I will speak but this once: let me prove, I pray thee, but this once with the fleece; let it now be dry only upon the fleece, and upon all the ground let there be dew.

dry place as 23\_ISA\_32\_02 # And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land.

dry place even <u>23\_ISA\_25\_05</u># Thou shalt bring down the noise of strangers, as the heat in a dry place; [even] the heat with the shadow of a cloud: the branch of the terrible ones shall be brought low.

dry places like <u>19\_PSA\_105\_41</u># He opened the rock, and the waters gushed out; they ran in the dry places [like] a river.

dry places seeking <u>42\_LUK\_11\_24</u># When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out.

dry places seeking <u>40\_MAT\_12\_43</u># When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none.

dry scall even 03\_LEV\_13\_30 # Then the priest shall see the plague: and, behold, if it [be] in sight deeper

than the skin; [and there be] in it a yellow thin hair; then the priest shall pronounce him unclean: it [is] a dry scall, [even] a leprosy upon the head or beard.

dry shall all <u>03\_LEV\_07\_10</u> # And every meat offering, mingled with oil, and dry, shall all the sons of Aaron have, one [as much] as another.

dry stubble <u>18\_JOB\_13\_25</u># Wilt thou break a leaf driven to and fro? and wilt thou pursue the dry stubble?

dry tree the <u>26\_EZE\_20\_47</u># And say to the forest of the south, Hear the word of the LORD; Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I will kindle a fire in thee, and it shall devour every green tree in thee, and every dry tree: the flaming flame shall not be quenched, and all faces from the south to the north shall be burned therein.

dry tree to <u>26\_EZE\_17\_24</u># And all the trees of the field shall know that I the LORD have brought down the high tree, have exalted the low tree, have dried up the green tree, and have made the dry tree to flourish: I the LORD have spoken and have done [it].

dry tree 23 ISA 56 03 # Neither let the son of the stranger, that hath joined himself to the LORD, speak, saying, The LORD hath utterly separated me from his people: neither let the eunuch say, Behold, I [am] a dry tree.

dry up all <u>23\_ISA\_42\_15</u># I will make waste mountains and hills, and dry up all their herbs; and I will make the rivers islands, and I will dry up the pools.

dry up also <u>18\_JOB\_12\_15</u> # Behold, he withholdeth the waters, and they dry up: also he sendeth them out, and they overturn the earth.

dry up and 38\_ZEC\_10\_11# And he shall pass through the sea with affliction, and shall smite the waves in the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall dry up: and the pride of Assyria shall be brought down, and the sceptre of Egypt shall depart away.

dry up her <u>24\_JER\_51\_36</u> # Therefore thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will plead thy cause, and take vengeance for thee; and I will dry up her sea, and make her springs dry.

dry up his <u>18\_JOB\_15\_30</u># He shall not depart out of darkness; the flame shall dry up his branches, and by the breath of his mouth shall he go away.

dry up the <u>23\_ISA\_42\_15</u># I will make waste mountains and hills, and dry up all their herbs; and I will make the rivers islands, and I will dry up the pools.

dry up the <u>23\_ISA\_50\_02</u> # Wherefore, when I came, [was there] no man? when I called, [was there] none to answer? Is my hand shortened at all, that it cannot redeem? or have I no power to deliver? behold, at my rebuke I dry up the sea, I make the rivers a wilderness: their fish stinketh, because [there is] no water, and dieth for thirst.

dry up thy 23\_ISA\_44\_27 # That saith to the deep, Be dry, and I will dry up thy rivers:

dry upon all <u>07\_JUD\_06\_37</u> # Behold, I will put a fleece of wool in the floor; [and] if the dew be on the fleece only, and [it be] dry upon all the earth [beside], then shall I know that thou wilt save Israel by mine hand, as thou hast said.

dry upon the <u>07\_JUD\_06\_40</u># And God did so that night: for it was dry upon the fleece only, and there was dew on all the ground.

dry wind of 24 JER 04 11 # At that time shall it be said to this people and to Jerusalem, A dry wind of the high places in the wilderness toward the daughter of my people, not to fan, nor to cleanse,

dry <u>26\_EZE\_37\_02</u> # And caused me to pass by them round about: and, behold, [there were] very many in the open valley; and, lo, [they were] very dry.

dry <u>01\_GEN\_08\_13</u> # And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the first [month], the first [day] of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry.

dry <u>24\_JER\_51\_36</u># Therefore thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will plead thy cause, and take vengeance for thee; and I will dry up her sea, and make her springs dry.

dry 42\_LUK\_23\_31\_# For if they do these things in a green tree, what shall be done in the dry?

dry <u>34\_NAH\_01\_10</u># For while [they be] folden together [as] thorns, and while they are drunken [as] drunkards, they shall be devoured as stubble fully dry.

dryshod <u>23\_ISA\_11\_15</u># And the LORD shall utterly destroy the tongue of the Egyptian sea; and with his mighty wind shall he shake his hand over the river, and shall smite it in the seven streams, and make [men] go over dryshod.

husbandry ye are 46\_1CO\_03\_09 # For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, [ye are] God's building.

husbandry <u>14\_2CH\_26\_10</u># Also he built towers in the desert, and digged many wells: for he had much cattle, both in the low country, and in the plains: husbandmen [also], and vine dressers in the mountains, and in Carmel: for he loved husbandry.

sundry times and <u>58\_HEB\_01\_01</u># God, who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets,
