Ephesus and called [44 ACT 20 17](#) # And from Miletus he sent to Ephesus, and called the elders of the church.

Ephesus and fear [44 ACT 19 17](#) # And this was known to all the Jews and Greeks also dwelling at Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified.

Ephesus and finding [44 ACT 19 01](#) # And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and finding certain disciples,

Ephesus and left [44 ACT 18 19](#) # And he came to Ephesus, and left them there: but he himself entered into the synagogue, and reasoned with the Jews.

Ephesus and to [49 EPH 01 01](#) # Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful in Christ Jesus:

Ephesus and unto [66 REV 01 11](#) # Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send [it] unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

Ephesus because he [44 ACT 20 16](#) # For Paul had determined to sail by Ephesus, because he would not spend the time in Asia: for he hasted, if it were possible for him, to be at Jerusalem the day of Pentecost.

Ephesus but almost [44 ACT 19 26](#) # Moreover ye see and hear, that not alone at Ephesus, but almost throughout all Asia, this Paul hath persuaded and turned away much people, saying that they be no gods, which are made with hands:

Ephesus thou knowest [55 2TI 01 18](#) # The Lord grant unto him that he may find mercy of the Lord in that day: and in how many things he ministered unto me at Ephesus, thou knowest very well.

Ephesus until Pentecost [46 1CO 16 08](#) # But I will tarry at Ephesus until Pentecost.

Ephesus what advantageth [46 1CO 15 32](#) # If after the manner of men I have fought with beasts at Ephesus, what advantageth it me, if the dead rise not? let us eat and drink; for to morrow we die.

Ephesus what man [44 ACT 19 35](#) # And when the townclerk had appeased the people, he said, [Ye] men of Ephesus, what man is there that knoweth not how that the city of the Ephesians is a worshipper of the great goddess Diana, and of the [image] which fell down from Jupiter?

Ephesus when I [54 1TI 01 03](#) # As I besought thee to abide still at Ephesus, when I went into Macedonia, that thou mightest charge some that they teach no other doctrine,

Ephesus write These [66 REV 02 01](#) # Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;

Ephesus [55 2TI 04 12](#) # And Tychicus have I sent to Ephesus.

Ephesus [44 ACT 18 21](#) # But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

Ephesus [44 ACT 18 24](#) # And a certain Jew named Apollos, born at Alexandria, an eloquent man, [and] mighty in the scriptures, came to Ephesus.
