embrace a son [12 2KI 04 16](#) # And he said, About this season, according to the time of life, thou shalt embrace a son. And she said, Nay, my lord, [thou] man of God, do not lie unto thine handmaid.

embrace and a [21 ECC 03 05](#) # A time to cast away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing;

embrace dunghills [25 LAM 04 05](#) # They that did feed delicately are desolate in the streets: they that were brought up in scarlet embrace dunghills.

embrace her [20 PRO 04 08](#) # Exalt her, and she shall promote thee: she shall bring thee to honour, when thou dost embrace her.

embrace me [22 SON 02 06](#) # His left hand [is] under my head, and his right hand doth embrace me.

embrace me [22 SON 08 03](#) # His left hand [should be] under my head, and his right hand should embrace me.

embrace the bosom [20 PRO 05 20](#) # And why wilt thou, my son, be ravished with a strange woman, and embrace the bosom of a stranger?

embrace the rock [18 JOB 24 08](#) # They are wet with the showers of the mountains, and embrace the rock for want of a shelter.

embraced him and [01 GEN 29 13](#) # And it came to pass, when Laban heard the tidings of Jacob his sister's son, that he ran to meet him, and embraced him, and kissed him, and brought him to his house. And he told Laban all these things.

embraced him and [01 GEN 33 04](#) # And Esau ran to meet him, and embraced him, and fell on his neck, and kissed him: and they wept.

embraced them and [44 ACT 20 01](#) # And after the uproar was ceased, Paul called unto [him] the disciples, and embraced [them], and departed for to go into Macedonia.

embraced them and [58 HEB 11 13](#) # These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of [them], and embraced [them], and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.
