grape and the 24\_JER\_31\_29 # In those days they shall say no more, The fathers have eaten a sour grape, and the children's teeth are set on edge.

grape appear and 22\_SON\_07\_12 # Let us get up early to the vineyards; let us see if the vine flourish, [whether] the tender grape appear, [and] the pomegranates bud forth: there will I give thee my loves.

grape as the <u>18\_JOB\_15\_33</u># He shall shake off his unripe grape as the vine, and shall cast off his flower as the olive.

grape give a 22\_SON\_02\_13 # The fig tree putteth forth her green figs, and the vines [with] the tender grape give a [good] smell. Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away.

grape his teeth <u>24\_JER\_31\_30</u># But every one shall die for his own iniquity: every man that eateth the sour grape, his teeth shall be set on edge.

grape is ripening 23 ISA 18\_05 # For afore the harvest, when the bud is perfect, and the sour grape is ripening in the flower, he shall both cut off the sprigs with pruning hooks, and take away [and] cut down the branches.

grape of thy <u>03\_LEV\_19\_10</u># And thou shalt not glean thy vineyard, neither shalt thou gather [every] grape of thy vineyard; thou shalt leave them for the poor and stranger: I [am] the LORD your God.

grape <u>05\_DEU\_32\_14</u># Butter of kine, and milk of sheep, with fat of lambs, and rams of the breed of Bashan, and goats, with the fat of kidneys of wheat; and thou didst drink the pure blood of the grape.

grapegatherer into the <u>24\_JER\_06\_09</u> # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, They shall thoroughly glean the remnant of Israel as a vine: turn back thine hand as a grapegatherer into the baskets.

grapegatherers came to <u>31\_OBA\_01\_05</u># If thieves came to thee, if robbers by night, [how art thou cut off!] would they not have stolen till they had enough? if the grapegatherers came to thee, would they not leave [some] grapes?

grapegatherers come to <u>24\_JER\_49\_09</u> # If grapegatherers come to thee, would they not leave [some] gleaning grapes? if thieves by night, they will destroy till they have enough.

grapegleanings of the <u>33\_MIC\_07\_01</u> # Woe is me! for I am as when they have gathered the summer fruits, as the grapegleanings of the vintage: [there is] no cluster to eat: my soul desired the firstripe fruit.

grapes against all <u>24\_JER\_25\_30</u> # Therefore prophesy thou against them all these words, and say unto them, The LORD shall roar from on high, and utter his voice from his holy habitation; he shall mightily roar upon his habitation; he shall give a shout, as they that tread [the grapes], against all the inhabitants of the earth.

grapes and figs <u>16\_NEH\_13\_15</u># In those days saw I in Judah [some] treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bringing in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all [manner of] burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I testified [against them] in the day wherein they sold victuals.

grapes and it <u>23 ISA 05 02</u> # And he fenced it, and gathered out the stones thereof, and planted it with the choicest vine, and built a tower in the midst of it, and also made a winepress therein: and he looked that it should bring forth grapes, and it brought forth wild grapes.

grapes and made <u>07\_JUD\_09\_27</u># And they went out into the fields, and gathered their vineyards, and trode [the grapes], and made merry, and went into the house of their god, and did eat and drink, and cursed Abimelech.

grapes and pressed <u>01\_GEN\_40\_11</u># And Pharaoh's cup [was] in my hand: and I took the grapes, and pressed them into Pharaoh's cup, and I gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand.

grapes and the <u>26\_EZE\_18\_02</u># What mean ye, that ye use this proverb concerning the land of Israel, saying, The fathers have eaten sour grapes, and the children's teeth are set on edge?

grapes and they <u>04\_NUM\_13\_23</u># And they came unto the brook of Eshcol, and cut down from thence a branch with one cluster of grapes, and they bare it between two upon a staff; and [they brought] of the pomegranates, and of the figs.

grapes are fully <u>66\_REV\_14\_18</u># And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe.

grapes are grapes <u>05\_DEU\_32\_32</u># For their vine [is] of the vine of Sodom, and of the fields of Gomorrah: their grapes [are] grapes of gall, their clusters [are] bitter:

grapes him that <u>30\_AMO\_09\_13</u># Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that soweth seed; and the mountains shall drop sweet wine, and all the hills shall melt.

grapes if thieves 24\_JER\_49\_09 # If grapegatherers come to thee, would they not leave [some] gleaning grapes? if thieves by night, they will destroy till they have enough.

grapes in it <u>03\_LEV\_25\_11</u># A jubilee shall that fiftieth year be unto you: ye shall not sow, neither reap that which groweth of itself in it, nor gather [the grapes] in it of thy vine undressed.

grapes in the <u>28\_HOS\_09\_10</u># I found Israel like grapes in the wilderness; I saw your fathers as the firstripe in the fig tree at her first time: [but] they went to Baalpeor, and separated themselves unto [that] shame; and [their] abominations were according as they loved.

grapes nor eat <u>04\_NUM\_06\_03</u> # He shall separate [himself] from wine and strong drink, and shall drink no vinegar of wine, or vinegar of strong drink, neither shall he drink any liquor of grapes, nor eat moist grapes, or dried.

grapes of Ephraim <u>07\_JUD\_08\_02</u> # And he said unto them, What have I done now in comparison of you? [Is] not the gleaning of the grapes of Ephraim better than the vintage of Abiezer?

grapes of gall <u>05\_DEU\_32\_32</u> # For their vine [is] of the vine of Sodom, and of the fields of Gomorrah: their grapes [are] grapes of gall, their clusters [are] bitter:

grapes of thorns <u>40\_MAT\_07\_16</u># Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?

grapes of thy <u>05\_DEU\_24\_21</u># When thou gatherest the grapes of thy vineyard, thou shalt not glean [it] afterward: it shall be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow.

grapes of thy <u>03\_LEV\_25\_05</u># That which groweth of its own accord of thy harvest thou shalt not reap, neither gather the grapes of thy vine undressed: [for] it is a year of rest unto the land.

grapes on the <u>24\_JER\_08\_13</u> # I will surely consume them, saith the LORD: [there shall be] no grapes on the vine, nor figs on the fig tree, and the leaf shall fade; and [the things that] I have given them shall pass away from them.

grapes or dried <u>04\_NUM\_06\_03</u> # He shall separate [himself] from wine and strong drink, and shall drink no vinegar of wine, or vinegar of strong drink, neither shall he drink any liquor of grapes, nor eat moist grapes, or dried.

grapes shall be <u>23\_ISA\_17\_06</u># Yet gleaning grapes shall be left in it, as the shaking of an olive tree, two [or] three berries in the top of the uppermost bough, four [or] five in the outmost fruitful branches thereof, saith the LORD God of Israel.

grapes thereof <u>05\_DEU\_28\_30</u> # Thou shalt betroth a wife, and another man shall lie with her: thou shalt build an house, and thou shalt not dwell therein: thou shalt plant a vineyard, and shalt not gather the grapes thereof.

grapes thy fill <u>05\_DEU\_23\_24</u> # When thou comest into thy neighbour's vineyard, then thou mayest eat grapes thy fill at thine own pleasure; but thou shalt not put [any] in thy vessel.

grapes when the <u>23\_ISA\_24\_13</u># When thus it shall be in the midst of the land among the people, [there shall be] as the shaking of an olive tree, [and] as the gleaning grapes when the vintage is done.

grapes which the <u>04\_NUM\_13\_24</u># The place was called the brook Eshcol, because of the cluster of grapes which the children of Israel cut down from thence.

grapes <u>01\_GEN\_40\_10</u> # And in the vine [were] three branches: and it [was] as though it budded, [and] her blossoms shot forth; and the clusters thereof brought forth ripe grapes:

grapes <u>01\_GEN\_49\_11</u># Binding his foal unto the vine, and his ass's colt unto the choice vine; he washed his garments in wine, and his clothes in the blood of grapes:

grapes <u>23\_ISA\_05\_02</u> # And he fenced it, and gathered out the stones thereof, and planted it with the choicest vine, and built a tower in the midst of it, and also made a winepress therein: and he looked that it should bring forth grapes, and it brought forth wild grapes.

grapes <u>23\_ISA\_05\_04</u># What could have been done more to my vineyard, that I have not done in it? wherefore, when I looked that it should bring forth grapes, brought it forth wild grapes?

grapes <u>42\_LUK\_06\_44</u> # For every tree is known by his own fruit. For of thorns men do not gather figs, nor of a bramble bush gather they grapes.

grapes <u>04\_NUM\_13\_20</u> # And what the land [is], whether it [be] fat or lean, whether there be wood therein, or not. And be ye of good courage, and bring of the fruit of the land. Now the time [was] the time of the firstripe grapes.

grapes 31\_OBA\_01\_05 # If thieves came to thee, if robbers by night, [how art thou cut off!] would they not

have stolen till they had enough? if the grapegatherers came to thee, would they not leave [some] grapes?

grapes  $\underline{^{22} SON_{02}_{15}}$ # Take us the foxes, the little foxes, that spoil the vines: for our vines [have] tender grapes.

grapes 22\_SON\_07\_07\_# This thy stature is like to a palm tree, and thy breasts to clusters [of grapes].
