humble and to <u>23\_ISA\_57\_15</u># For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name [is] Holy; I dwell in the high and holy [place], with him also [that is] of a contrite and humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.

humble himself as <u>40\_MAT\_18\_04</u># Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

humble himself shall <u>40\_MAT\_23\_12</u># And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.

humble in spirit <u>20\_PRO\_29\_23</u># A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the humble in spirit.

humble me among <u>47\_2CO\_12\_21</u> # [And] lest, when I come again, my God will humble me among you, and [that] I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed.

humble person 18\_JOB\_22\_29 # When [men] are cast down, then thou shalt say, [There is] lifting up; and he shall save the humble person.

humble shall hear 19 PSA 34 02 # My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the humble shall hear [thereof], and be glad.

humble shall see 19\_PSA\_69\_32 # The humble shall see [this, and] be glad: and your heart shall live that seek God.

humble spirit with 20\_PRO\_16\_19 # Better [it is to be] of an humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud.

humble thee and <u>05\_DEU\_08\_02</u> # And thou shalt remember all the way which the LORD thy God led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to humble thee, [and] to prove thee, to know what [was] in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

humble thee and <u>05\_DEU\_08\_16</u># Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end;

humble themselves and <u>14\_2CH\_07\_14</u># If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

humble thou wilt 19\_PSA\_10\_17 # LORD, thou hast heard the desire of the humble: thou wilt prepare their heart, thou wilt cause thine ear to hear:

humble thyself and 20\_PRO\_06\_03 # Do this now, my son, and deliver thyself, when thou art come into the

hand of thy friend; go, humble thyself, and make sure thy friend.

humble thyself before 14\_2CH\_34\_27 # Because thine heart was tender, and thou didst humble thyself before God, when thou heardest his words against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, and humbledst thyself before me, and didst rend thy clothes, and weep before me; I have even heard [thee] also, saith the LORD.

humble thyself before <u>02\_EXO\_10\_03</u># And Moses and Aaron came in unto Pharaoh, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD God of the Hebrews, How long wilt thou refuse to humble thyself before me? let my people go, that they may serve me.

humble ye them <u>07\_JUD\_19\_24</u># Behold, [here is] my daughter a maiden, and his concubine; them I will bring out now, and humble ye them, and do with them what seemeth good unto you: but unto this man do not so vile a thing.

Humble yourselves in 59\_JAM\_04\_10 # Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.

Humble yourselves sit <u>24\_JER\_13\_18</u> # Say unto the king and to the queen, Humble yourselves, sit down: for your principalities shall come down, [even] the crown of your glory.

Humble yourselves therefore 60\_1PE\_05\_06 # Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that he may exalt you in due time:

humble <u>60\_1PE\_05\_05</u> # Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all [of you] be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

humble <u>59\_JAM\_04\_06</u> # But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the humble.

humble 19\_PSA\_09\_12 # When he maketh inquisition for blood, he remembereth them: he forgetteth not the cry of the humble.

humble 19\_PSA\_10\_12 # Arise, O LORD; O God, lift up thine hand: forget not the humble.

humbled and the 23\_ISA\_02\_11# The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day.

humbled and the 23\_ISA\_05\_15 # And the mean man shall be brought down, and the mighty man shall be humbled, and the eyes of the lofty shall be humbled:

humbled and they <u>03\_LEV\_26\_41</u> # And [that] I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity:

humbled behold they 14\_2CH\_33\_19 # His prayer also, and [how God] was entreated of him, and all his sins, and his trespass, and the places wherein he built high places, and set up groves and graven images, before he was humbled: behold, they [are] written among the sayings of the seers.

humbled even unto <u>24\_JER\_44\_10</u> # They are not humbled [even] unto this day, neither have they feared, nor walked in my law, nor in my statutes, that I set before you and before your fathers.

humbled her he <u>05\_DEU\_22\_29</u># Then the man that lay with her shall give unto the damsel's father fifty [shekels] of silver, and she shall be his wife; because he hath humbled her, he may not put her away all his days.

humbled her that <u>26\_EZE\_22\_10</u># In thee have they discovered their fathers' nakedness: in thee have they humbled her that was set apart for pollution.

humbled her <u>05\_DEU\_21\_14</u># And it shall be, if thou have no delight in her, then thou shalt let her go whither she will; but thou shalt not sell her at all for money, thou shalt not make merchandise of her, because thou hast humbled her.

humbled himself and <u>50\_PHP\_02\_08</u># And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

humbled himself but 14\_2CH\_33\_23 # And humbled not himself before the LORD, as Manasseh his father had humbled himself; but Amon trespassed more and more.

humbled himself for <u>14\_2CH\_32\_26</u> # Notwithstanding Hezekiah humbled himself for the pride of his heart, [both] he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD came not upon them in the days of Hezekiah.

humbled himself greatly 14\_2CH\_33\_12 # And when he was in affliction, he besought the LORD his God, and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers,

humbled himself the <u>14\_2CH\_12\_12</u> # And when he humbled himself, the wrath of the LORD turned from him, that he would not destroy [him] altogether: and also in Judah things went well.

humbled his neighbour's <u>05\_DEU\_22\_24</u># Then ye shall bring them both out unto the gate of that city, and ye shall stone them with stones that they die; the damsel, because she cried not, [being] in the city; and the man, because he hath humbled his neighbour's wife: so thou shalt put away evil from among you.

humbled his sister <u>26\_EZE\_22\_11</u># And one hath committed abomination with his neighbour's wife; and another hath lewdly defiled his daughter in law; and another in thee hath humbled his sister, his father's daughter.

humbled in me 25 LAM 03 20 # My soul hath [them] still in remembrance, and is humbled in me.

humbled my soul <u>19\_PSA\_35\_13</u># But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing [was] sackcloth: I humbled my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom.

humbled not himself <u>14\_2CH\_33\_23</u> # And humbled not himself before the LORD, as Manasseh his father had humbled himself; but Amon trespassed more and more.

humbled not himself <u>14\_2CH\_36\_12</u> # And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD his God, [and] humbled not himself before Jeremiah the prophet [speaking] from the mouth of the LORD.

humbled thee and <u>05\_DEU\_08\_03</u># And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every [word] that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live.

humbled themselves and 14\_2CH\_12\_06 # Whereupon the princes of Israel and the king humbled themselves; and they said, The LORD [is] righteous.

humbled themselves and <u>14\_2CH\_30\_11</u># Nevertheless divers of Asher and Manasseh and of Zebulun humbled themselves, and came to Jerusalem.
