hundred measures of <u>42\_LUK\_16\_06</u># And he said, An hundred measures of oil. And he said unto him, Take thy bill, and sit down quickly, and write fifty.

hundred measures of <u>42\_LUK\_16\_07</u> # Then said he to another, And how much owest thou? And he said, An hundred measures of wheat. And he said unto him, Take thy bill, and write fourscore.

hundred measures <u>26\_EZE\_48\_30</u># And these [are] the goings out of the city on the north side, four thousand and five hundred measures.

hundred men all <u>07\_JUD\_20\_35</u> # And the LORD smote Benjamin before Israel: and the children of Israel destroyed of the Benjamites that day twenty and five thousand and an hundred men: all these drew the sword.
