Isaiah Go forth [23 ISA 07 03](#) # Then said the LORD unto Isaiah, Go forth now to meet Ahaz, thou, and Shearjashub thy son, at the end of the conduit of the upper pool in the highway of the fuller's field;

Isaiah Good is [12 2KI 20 19](#) # Then said Hezekiah unto Isaiah, Good [is] the word of the LORD which thou hast spoken. And he said, [Is it] not [good], if peace and truth be in my days?

Isaiah Good is [23 ISA 39 08](#) # Then said Hezekiah to Isaiah, Good [is] the word of the LORD which thou hast spoken. He said moreover, For there shall be peace and truth in my days.

Isaiah had said [23 ISA 38 21](#) # For Isaiah had said, Let them take a lump of figs, and lay [it] for a plaster upon the boil, and he shall recover.

Isaiah hath walked [23 ISA 20 03](#) # And the LORD said, Like as my servant Isaiah hath walked naked and barefoot three years [for] a sign and wonder upon Egypt and upon Ethiopia;

Isaiah said Take [12 2KI 20 07](#) # And Isaiah said, Take a lump of figs. And they took and laid [it] on the boil, and he recovered.

Isaiah said This [12 2KI 20 09](#) # And Isaiah said, This sign shalt thou have of the LORD, that the LORD will do the thing that he hath spoken: shall the shadow go forward ten degrees, or go back ten degrees?

Isaiah said unto [12 2KI 19 06](#) # And Isaiah said unto them, Thus shall ye say to your master, Thus saith the LORD, Be not afraid of the words which thou hast heard, with which the servants of the king of Assyria have blasphemed me.

Isaiah said unto [12 2KI 20 16](#) # And Isaiah said unto Hezekiah, Hear the word of the LORD.

Isaiah said unto [23 ISA 37 06](#) # And Isaiah said unto them, Thus shall ye say unto your master, Thus saith the LORD, Be not afraid of the words that thou hast heard, wherewith the servants of the king of Assyria have blasphemed me.

Isaiah saying [23 ISA 38 04](#) # Then came the word of the LORD to Isaiah, saying,

Isaiah the prophet [14 2CH 26 22](#) # Now the rest of the acts of Uzziah, first and last, did Isaiah the prophet, the son of Amoz, write.

Isaiah the prophet [14 2CH 32 32](#) # Now the rest of the acts of Hezekiah, and his goodness, behold, they [are] written in the vision of Isaiah the prophet, the son of Amoz, [and] in the book of the kings of Judah and Israel.

Isaiah the prophet [12 2KI 19 02](#) # And he sent Eliakim, which [was] over the household, and Shebna the scribe, and the elders of the priests, covered with sackcloth, to Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz.

Isaiah the prophet [12 2KI 20 11](#) # And Isaiah the prophet cried unto the LORD: and he brought the shadow ten degrees backward, by which it had gone down in the dial of Ahaz.

Isaiah the prophet [12 2KI 20 14](#) # Then came Isaiah the prophet unto king Hezekiah, and said unto him, What said these men? and from whence came they unto thee? And Hezekiah said, They are come from a far country, [even] from Babylon.

Isaiah the prophet [23 ISA 37 02](#) # And he sent Eliakim, who [was] over the household, and Shebna the scribe, and the elders of the priests covered with sackcloth, unto Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz.

Isaiah the prophet [23 ISA 38 01](#) # In those days was Hezekiah sick unto death. And Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz came unto him, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Set thine house in order: for thou shalt die, and not live.

Isaiah the prophet [23 ISA 39 03](#) # Then came Isaiah the prophet unto king Hezekiah, and said unto him, What said these men? and from whence came they unto thee? And Hezekiah said, They are come from a far country unto me, [even] from Babylon.

Isaiah the son [14 2CH 32 20](#) # And for this [cause] Hezekiah the king, and the prophet Isaiah the son of Amoz, prayed and cried to heaven.

Isaiah the son [12 2KI 19 20](#) # Then Isaiah the son of Amoz sent to Hezekiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, [That] which thou hast prayed to me against Sennacherib king of Assyria I have heard.

Isaiah the son [12 2KI 20 01](#) # In those days was Hezekiah sick unto death. And the prophet Isaiah the son of Amoz came to him, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Set thine house in order; for thou shalt die, and not live.

Isaiah the son [23 ISA 01 01](#) # The vision of Isaiah the son of Amoz, which he saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem in the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, [and] Hezekiah, kings of Judah.

Isaiah the son [23 ISA 02 01](#) # The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.

Isaiah the son [23 ISA 13 01](#) # The burden of Babylon, which Isaiah the son of Amoz did see.

Isaiah the son [23 ISA 20 02](#) # At the same time spake the LORD by Isaiah the son of Amoz, saying, Go and loose the sackcloth from off thy loins, and put off thy shoe from thy foot. And he did so, walking naked and barefoot.

Isaiah the son [23 ISA 37 21](#) # Then Isaiah the son of Amoz sent unto Hezekiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Whereas thou hast prayed to me against Sennacherib king of Assyria:
